## INDY BITS

**ABOUT YESTERDAY:** Despite a season-high tying 13-hit effort from the offense, the Indianapolis Indians dropped the first game of an eight-game set to St. Paul on Tuesday afternoon at CHS Field, 16-4. Following an RBI single from Darick Hall to give the Indians an early 1-0 lead in the first inning, St. Paul immediately countered and loaded the bases courtesy of two singles and a walk off starter Carson Fulmer. Junior Severino scratched the first run across for the Saints with a bases-loaded walk before Carson McCusker cranked the first of two Saints grand slams to provide St. Paul a 5-1 lead it would not relinquish. The Saints scored in six of their eight offensive half innings, with the onslaught capped by a Ryan Fitzgerald grand slam in the eighth inning. Ji Hwan Bae and Nick Yorke each recorded three hits in the contest, with this being Bae's second three-hit effort in his last four games. Malcom Nunez and Hall also recorded multi-hit games while Hall combined with Peguero to account for all of Indy's RBI.

**GLITZY GORSKI:** Matt Gorski extended his hitting streak to five games yesterday, going 1-for-5, with his four-game RBI streak and four-game run streak ending. He is hitting .409 (9-for-22) with three doubles, two home runs, seven RBI and seven runs in those five games. After a two-hit performance on Sunday, Gorski tallied three straight multi-hit efforts for the first time since Sept. 9-12, 2023. He has posted a hit in seven of his past eight games and has one-plus hit in 14 of his 18 games on the campaign. He has driven in one-plus run in six of his last eight games and 11 of 18 overall.

**DAR DEVIL:** Darick Hall extended his on-base streak to 10 games yesterday, going 2-for-5 with his first home run of the campaign and two RBI. He is hitting .316 (12-for-38) in those 10 games with two doubles, one home run, five RBI and five walks. This, on the heels of going hitless (0-for-12) and striking out one-plus times in each of his first four games. From game two on April 12 through April 13 at Louisville, he posted back-to-back multi-hit games for the first time since July 24 and 25, 2024, with Lehigh Valley at Rochester.

**BAEWATCH:** Ji Hwan Bae went 3-for-5 with one run and one stolen base in last night's contest, extending his on-base streak to seven games, run streak to four games and stolen base streak to four games. He is hitting .290 (9-for-31) with two doubles, four walks, nine runs and four stolen bases in those seven games. He has stolen a base in four consecutive games for the first time since July 8-14, 2021, with Altoona. His streak of scoring in four straight games is tied for the longest active run in the International League. The four-game stolen base streak is the longest active run in Triple-A and is tied with Columbia's Asbel Gonzalez for the longest active run in the minors. Bae has one-plus hit in five of his past six games and has a pair of three-hit performances in his past four contests.

**PEGGY PROWESS:** Liover Peguero extended his hitting streak to four games, extra-base hit streak to three games, RBI streak to three games and run streak to three games yesterday, going 1-for-4 with his first home run of the campaign and two RBI. He has collected a hit in 14 of 17 games this season, including 12 of his past 13. He has posted multi-hit performances in six of his last 10 contests. He is hitting .390 (16-for-41) in his last 10 games with four doubles, one triple, one home run, 10 RBI, three walks, seven runs, three stolen bases and a 1.042 OPS.

**HOLDY ON REHAB:** Pirates right-hander Colin Holderman continued his rehab assignment yesterday, allowing one run across 0.2 innings. He began the assignment on Saturday, tossing a scoreless seventh inning en route to the Indians fourth straight win. Holderman was placed on the 15-day injured list on April 6 with a right knee strain. In 13 career games with Indianapolis, he is 0-0 with a 5.11 ERA (7er/12.1ip) with 11 hits, four walks, two hit batters and 15 strikeouts. Opponents are hitting .239 (11-for-46) against him in this span. He began the season on Pittsburgh's Opening Day roster, going 0-0 with a 9.64 ERA (5er/4.2ip), four walks and six strikeouts in five games. He has appeared in 127 games for Pittsburgh since 2022, going 4-9 with a 4.04 ERA (55er/122.2ip), 112 hits, 56 walks and 126 strikeouts.

**SOLAKECLIPSE:** Nick Solak extended his International League-leading hitting streak to 12 games on Sunday, reaching base four times in the win. Solak went 3-for-4 with a home run, three RBI, one walk and two runs. It was his first game of the season reaching base four times and he has reached safely three-plus times in a game for the fourth time. Solak has a hit in all of his games this season, batting .391 (18-for-46) with two doubles, three home runs, 11 RBI, four walks, 10 runs, three stolen bases and a 1.061 OPS. He has struck out just seven times on the campaign and only thrice in his past 35 plate appearances. On Wednesday, he posted his first multi-steal game since taking two bags June 18, 2022, with Round Rock vs. Sugar Land. In last week's six-game series vs. Toledo, Solak hit .526 (10-for-19) with one double, one home run, seven RBI, three walks, three stolen bases and five runs against just two strikeouts.

**TODAY'S MATCHUPS:** The Indianapolis Indians continue this week's eight-game series against the St. Paul Saints with the first of two doubleheaders tonight, with first pitch of game one set for 6:00 PM. Game two is set to begin about 30 minutes after the conclusion of tonight's first contest. Friday night, the Indians play their second doubleheader of the series. In game one, Indians right-hander Thomas Harrington is set to make his second start and third appearance of the season. He made his first start with Indy on the campaign on April 17 vs. Toledo, tossing 3.0 innings with three hits, one run, two walks and four strikeouts. Harrington is 2-0 with a 0.75 ERA (1er/12.0ip) in two career starts against the Saints with nine hits, one earned run, two walks and seven strikeouts. He earned the win in his final start of the 2024 season at St. Paul on Sept. 18, allowing one run over 5.0 innings. Opposite Harrington is Saints right-hander Andrew Morris. Morris allowed a career-high seven earned runs in his last start on April 16 at Iowa with nine hits, one walk and six strikeouts. Morris is 0-1 in three career starts against the Indians, posting a 4.50 ERA (7er/14.0ip) with 10 hits, seven walks, one hit batter and 10 strikeouts. Indy does not have an official starter set for a bullpen game in the second contest. Starting for the Saints in game two is right-hander Cory Lewis. Lewis allowed six earned runs and four home runs in his last contest on April 16 at Iowa. Lewis made one career start against the Indians on Sept. 19, 2024 at CHS Field, allowing two earned runs across 5.0 innings.

**ON THIS DATE IN 1902:** In the newly formed American Association, the Indianapolis Indians opened the regular season with a 5-4 win over the Milwaukee Brewers – who were a minor league team at the time – at Washington Park. The team was part of a parade from the Grand Hotel to Washington Park, where a crowd estimated at 4,000 watched the locals earn the hard-fought victory.
