ABOUT LAST NIGHT: The Quad Cities River Bandits beat the Wisconsin Timber Rattlers 7-5. The River Bandits broke a 4-4 tie with a run in the seventh and added two runs in the ninth. Eric Brown Jr doubled twice and scored three runs and Robert Moore drove in three runs for Wisconsin.

MOORE, MOORE! Moore a pair of hits - an RBI double in the fifth to tie the game 4-4 and an RBI single in the ninth. Moore is 5-for-12 with four doubles and five RBI in this series. He is tied for the Midwest League lead in doubles with thirteen.

WHAT CAN BROWN DO FOR YOU? Brown is on a seven-game hitting streak and a sixteen-game on base streak. Brown has an OPS of .993, has stolen twelve bases, and has scored thirteen runs during the on base

TWO-OUT TROUBLE: Javier Vaz broke the tie with a two-out, RBI single in the top of the seventh inning. Cayden Wallace gave the River Bandits insurance runs with a two-out, two-run single in the top of the ninth. Opponents are 40-for-144 (.278) with runners in scoring position and two outs against the Rattlers this season. Ben Metzinger and Moore both had two-out, RBI hits with runners in scoring position last night for the Rattles and Wisconsin is 19-for-135 (.141) in that situation for the season.

TRIPLE DECKER: Matt Wood had his first triple as a professional last night. The Rattlers catcher had two hits last night for his first multi-hit game with Wisconsin.

EXTRA MILES: Wisconsin had ten hits last night and six went for extra bases. Eduardo García hit a solo homer. Wood tripled. Brown doubled twice, and Moore and Alex Hall doubled both doubled.

CROSS WORDS: Gavin Cross hit a two-run home run in the top of the fourth inning last night. Cross has homered in three straight games. Four of his five homers this season have been against Wisconsin.

ABOUT QUAD CITIES: The River Bandits are the Midwest League affiliate of the Kansas City Royals. The current version of Davenport Professional Baseball club started in 1960 as the Midwest League affiliate of the Milwaukee Braves. Quad Cities has affiliated with several MLB teams: The California Angels (1962-1978 and 1985-1992), the Chicago Cubs (1979-1984), the Houston Astros (1993-1998 and 2013-2019), the Minnesota Twins (1999-2004), and the St. Louis Cardinals (2005-2012). The team became the Quad City River Bandits in 1992. They changed their name to the Swing of the Quad Cities from 2004 through 2007 before changing to Quad Cities River Bandits in 2008. Quad Cities won Midwest League pennants in 1968, 1971, 1979, 1990, 2011, 2013, and 2017. They were the High-A Central League champions in 2021. Notable alumni of Quad Cities: Carlos Correa, Joe Mauer, Josh Hader, Billy Wagner, Shawon Dunston, Justin Morneau, and Brett Phillips.

ABOUT THE ROYALS: The Kansas City Royals have been Quad Cities' parent club since 2021. They left the Midwest league and an affiliation with Kane County at the end of the 2012 season. The Royals had previously been in the Midwest League with Waterloo (1969-1976), Appleton (1987-1992), Rockford (1993-94), Springfield (1995), Lansing (1996-1998), Burlington (2001-2010), and Kane County (2011-2012).

PROSPECTING IN THE SERIES: MLB Pipeline places five active Rattlers on their list of Brewers Top 30 Prospects: Eric Brown Jr (#6), Robert Moore (#8), Eduardo García (#19), Matthew Wood (#25), and Joseph Hernandez (#26). Hendry Mendez (#15) is currently on Wisconsin's IL. MLB Pipeline has six active River Bandits on their list of Kansas City prospects: Gavin Cross (#1), Cayden Wallace (#5), Carter Jensen (#10), Mason Barnett (#18), Chandler Champlain (#26), and Luinder Avila (#30).

## PITCHING MATCHUP

#### WISCONSIN SCHEDULED STARTING PITCHER:

RHP JOSEPH HERNANDEZ: Acquired by Milwaukee in a trade with the Seattle Mariners on January 7, 2023 in exchange for Justin Topa.

**FROM THE REPUBLIC:** The Mariners originally signed Hernandez as an International Free Agent out of the Dominican Republic on July 2, 2017.

TWO YEARS ON THE ISLAND: Hernandez spent his 2018 and 2019 seasons with the Mariners affiliate in the Dominican Summer League. He was 3-2 with a save and a 4.62 ERA in fifteen games – six starts – in 2018 and went 0-1 in four relief appearances in 2019. He had 28 walks and 47 strikeouts over 45 innings pitched in the DSL.

BACK AT IT: Hernandez spent most of his 2021 season with the Mariners affiliate in the Arizona Complex League. He was 4-0 with a 4.35 ERA in ten games – four starts – with 49 strikeouts over 31 innings. He also made one start for Arkansas, Seattle's Double-A affiliate in the Texas League that season.

**AWARD WINNING:** Hernandez was 9-5 with a 3.39 ERA in 24 games – 22 starts – for the Modesto Nuts, Seattle's affiliate in the California League in 2022. He had 143 strikeouts over 116-2/3 innings pitched and was named the California League Pitcher of the Year.

**LAST START:** Hernandez beat South Bend at home on May 13. He allowed two runs – one earned – on three hits with two walks and five strikeouts over five innings.

VS. QUAD CITIES: Hernandez won at Quad Cities on April 19. He allowed two runs, walked three, and struck out three over six scoreless innings.

## **QUAD CITIES SCHEDULED STARTING PITCHER:**

RHP CHANDLER CHAMPLAIN: The Kansas City Royals acquired Champlain in a trade with the New York Yankees on July 27, 2022. Kansas City sent Andrew Benintendi to New York in exchange for Champlain, Beck Way, and TJ Sikkema.

**LIKE THE LAKE?** The Yankees selected Champlain in the ninth round of the 2021 draft out of the University of Southern California.

**TROJAN HORSE:** Champlain was 4-4 with a 5.06 ERA in fifteen starts in his final season at USC. He walked 22 and struck out 69 over 74-2/3 innings pitched during the 2021 college season. Champlain did not pitch professionally after signing with the Yankees in 2021.

**GONE FISHING:** Champlain made his professional debut with the Tampa Tarpons in the Florida State League this year. He was 2-5 with a 4.30 ERA in sixteen games – fifteen starts. Champlain had 94 strikeouts and twenty walks over 74-1/3 innings pitched with Tampa before the trade.

**DOWN BY THE RIVER:** Champlain was 1-3 with a 9.84 ERA in eight games – seven starts – after joining the River Bandits last season.

**LAST START:** Champlain, the #26 prospect in Kansas City's organization, <u>lost to Cedar Rapids at home on May 12</u>. He allowed a run on four hits with no walks and six strikeouts over six innings.

VS. WISCONSIN: Champlain has faced the Rattlers twice in the past two seasons. He lost to Wisconsin at Modern Woodmen Park on August 3, 2022 in his first start for the River Bandits. He gave up five runs on eight hits, including a homer to Zavier Warren, over 2-2/3 innings. Champlain walked one and struck out five in that game. He also lost to Wisconsin at Modern Woodmen Park on April 22, 2023 when he allowed three runs on four hits with three walks and four strikeouts over 5-2/3 innings.
