Hendry Mendez homered and Eduarqui Fernández had a two-run triple to lead the Wisconsin offense. HOUDINI WOULD BE PROUD: The Sky Carp had runners at second and third with no outs in the bottom

of the first inning and Peterson escaped the inning with no damage. Zach Zubia had a lead-off double in the fourth and was stranded there. The Sky Carp had consecutive, two-out singles in the fifth inning before Peterson got the final out. Beloit went 0-for-7 with runners in scoring position against Peterson, who picked up his second consecutive win.

DOING WORK: Merkel has pitched in two straight games. He tossed a scoreless inning on Sunday against Quad Cities and three scoreless innings with three strikeouts last night.

BACK IN FORM: Smith pitched a perfect ninth inning with two strikeouts to finish the game. Smith, who had allowed a run in his last three appearances, has nine scoreless appearances in his fourteen games as a Rattler.

ABOUT BELOIT: The Beloit Sky Carp changed their name from Snappers after the 2021 season. This is Beloit's third season as an affiliate of the Miami Marlins. Beloit started as the Beloit Brewers in 1982 as the Midwest League affiliate of Milwaukee. They changed their name to the Beloit Snappers for the 1995 season. The Snappers affiliation with Milwaukee ended after the 2004 season They were affiliated with the Minnesota Twins (2005-2012) and the Oakland Athletics (2013-2019) over their final seasons in the Midwest League. The Snappers said "Goodbye" to Pohlman Field on July 11, 2021 and moved into ABC Supply Stadium on August 3, 2021. Billy Gardner Jr is in his first season as the manager of the Sky Carp

ABOUT THE MARLINS: The Florida/Miami Marlins have lots of history in the Midwest League. The Marlins' first Low-A affiliate was the Kane County Cougars from 1993 through 2002. Josh Beckett, Adrian Gonzalez, Dontrelle Willis, Miguel Cabrera, and former Timber Rattlers manager Matt Erickson all played for the Cougars in that timespan The Marlins returned to the Midwest League in in 2019 to affiliate with the Clinton LumberKings. The Marlins landed in Beloit after MLB reset the affiliations for 2021

PITCHING MATCHUP

WISCONSIN SCHEDULED STARTING PITCHER:

RHP CAMERON WAGONER: Selected by Milwaukee in the eleventh round of the 2022 draft out of Eastern Michigan University.

EASTERN NOTES: Wagoner did not pitch collegiately in 2022. He made six relief appearances during the abbreviated 2020 season and 18 appearances – three starts – in 2021. He was 2-4 with a 4.42 ERA and 67 strikeouts over 57 innings during his two college seasons.

HOW DID YOU SPEND YOUR SUMMERS? Wagoner played for Greeneville in the Appalachian League in 2021 and was with both Wareham and Cotuit in the Cape Cod League in 2022. He was 2-3 with a 4.97 ERA in nineteen games – two starts – and 57 strikeouts over 38 innings pitched in those summer leagues.

AS A PRO: Wagoner made four appearances – two starts – for the ACL Brewers Gold after signing with Milwaukee. He was 1-0 and had eight strikeouts in eight innings in the ACL.

DOWN UNDER: Wagoner pitched for the Brisbane Bandits of the Australian Baseball League during the Winter of 2022-23. He made ten starts during the regular season of the ABL and was 3-1 with a 3.26 ERA and 43 strikeouts in 47 innings pitched.

LAST START: Wagoner had a no decision against Quad Cities at home on August 23. He allowed a run on two hits with four walks and five strikeouts over five innings. Wagoner had a 2-0 lead when he left the game after giving up a lead-off single in the sixth. The River Bandits scored three runs to take the lead, but the Rattlers would eventually rally for a 10-6 victory.

VS. BELOIT: Wagoner is 0-3 in three starts against the Sky Carp this season. He has allowed ten runs – nine earned – on eighteen hits in thirteen innings versus Beloit this season. Wagoner has walked two and struck out nine in his three starts against the Sky Carp.

BELOIT SCHEDULED STARTING PITCHER:

RHP IKE BUXTON: The Miami Marlins selected Buxton in the fifteenth round of the 2022 draft out of the Lipscomb University.

STARTING OUT IN IDAHO: Buxton began his collegiate career at Boise State University. He was a redshirt in 2019 and made four relief appearances during the shortened 2020 season before transferring to Lipscomb for 2021.

NASHVILLE: Buxton pitched two seasons at Lipscomb. He was 11-8 with a save and a 4.45 ERA in 33 games – 24 starts – in his two seasons for the Bison. In his final season at Lipscomb, Buxton was 7-3 with 66 strikeouts over 74-2/3 innings in fifteen games – fourteen starts.

IT'S COMPLEX: Buxton made three relief appearances with the Marlins affiliate in the FCL after signing with Miami. He walked eight, struck out five, and allowed five runs over 4-2/3 innings as a pro in 2022.

UNDEFEATED IN FLORIDA: Buxton was 4-0 with a 1.62 ERA in twelve games – five starts – with the Jupiter Hammerheads to start the 2023 season. He had walked 25 and struck out 46 in 39 innings before his promotion to Beloit on July 25.

LAST START: Buxton had a no decision against Lake County at home on <u>August 24</u>. He allowed three runs on four hits with three walks and two strikeouts over 3-1/3 innings.

VS. WISCONSIN: Buxton has never faced the Timber Rattlers prior to this evening. Tonight is also the first time he will pitch against an affiliate of the Milwaukee Brewers.
