ABOUT LAST NIGHT: The Wisconsin Timber Rattlers beat the Quad Cities River Bandits 6-1 at Modern Woodmen Park. Tyler Woessner allowed one run on one hit over six innings and Joe Gray Jr drove in three runs for the Timber Rattlers.

FIRST! In the first four games of this series, Wisconsin had one base runner in the first inning, a lead-off walk on Tuesday night. In the first inning last night, Eduardo García walked, Gray doubled him home, and Alex Hall added an RBI single for a 2-0 lead.

THREE IS A MAGIC NUMBER: Woessner is 3-0 in three starts for the Timber Rattlers this season. Last night he allowed one run on one hit with two walks and five strikeouts over six innings for his first quality start as a pro. Woessner retired the final ten batters he faced. He has allowed one earned run in each of his three starts this season.

**HALL MONITOR:** Hall's RBI single in the first inning gave him seven RBI in this series.

**3-2-1 CONTACT!** The Timber Rattlers struck out eight times on Saturday. The Rattlers had struck out 55 times in the first four games of the series.

**RUN WILD:** Wisconsin base runners stole four bases last night. Terence Doston and Eric Brown Jr pulled a double steal in the top of the seventh inning and scored on a two-run single by Gray. That hit gave Wisconsin their final two runs of the night.

TWO BY TWO: In both of Wisconsin's wins during this series, the Rattlers pitchers have held Quad Cities to two hits.

STREAK STOPPERS: Woessner, Brannon Jordan, and Justin King kept Gavin Cross and Carter Jensen off base last night. Both River Bandits went 0-for-4 to see their season-opening on-base streak end at twelve games. Cayden Wallace was 0-for-3 but drew a walk on a 3-2 pitch in the bottom of the ninth to move his on-base streak to thirteen games.

**MAKING MOVES:** Pitcher Alexander Cornielle was activated from the Wisconsin Injured List prior to today's game.

ABOUT QUAD CITIES: The River Bandits are the Midwest League affiliate of the Kansas City Royals. The current version of Davenport Professional Baseball club started in 1960 as the Midwest League affiliate of the Milwaukee Braves. Quad Cities has affiliated with several MLB teams: The California Angels (1962-1978 and 1985-1992), the Chicago Cubs (1979-1984), the Houston Astros (1993-1998 and 2013-2019), the Minnesota Twins (1999-2004), and the St. Louis Cardinals (2005-2012). The team became the Quad City River Bandits in 1992. They changed their name to the Swing of the Quad Cities from 2004 through 2007 before changing to Quad Cities River Bandits in 2008. Quad Cities won Midwest League pennants in 1968, 1971, 1979, 1990, 2011, 2013, and 2017. They were the High-A Central League champions in 2021. Notable alumni of Quad Cities: Carlos Correa, Joe Mauer, Josh Hader, Billy Wagner, Shawon Dunston, Justin Morneau, and Brett Phillips.

ABOUT THE ROYALS: The Kansas City Royals have been Quad Cities' parent club since 2021. They left the Midwest league and an affiliation with Kane County at the end of the 2012 season. The Royals had previously been in the Midwest League with Waterloo (1969-1976), Appleton (1987-1992), Rockford (1993-94), Springfield (1995), Lansing (1996-1998), Burlington (2001-2010), and Kane County (2011-2012).

# PITCHING MATCHUP

#### WISCONSIN SCHEDULED STARTING PITCHER:

RHP ALEXANDER CORNIELLE: Milwaukee signed Cornielle as an International Free Agent out of the Dominican Republic on June 15, 2019.

**FAST DEBUT:** Cornielle made his professional debut with one inning of relief against the Cubs #2 affiliate in the Dominican Summer League on August 2, 2019. He allowed one run on no hits with two walks in one inning. Cornielle made three appearances in the DSL in 2019 with no record and one run allowed over four innings.

**HIT PLAY:** Cornielle started the 2021 season with the Brewers Blue affiliate in the Arizona Complex League and was 4-2 in nine games – four starts – with a 4.64 ERA and 50 strikeouts over 33 innings pitched. He was called up to Carolina at the end of the season and was 0-1 in two starts with ten strikeouts in eight innings.

**WEEKLY AWARD:** Cornielle was named the ACL's Pitcher of the Week on September 6, 2021 after his performance against the White Sox on August 31, 2021. He allowed one run on one hit and two walks with six strikeouts over five innings in the game.

FEELING 2022: Cornielle was 9-7 in 22 games – 19 starts – with a 3.19 ERA and 124 strikeouts over 101-2/3 innings pitched for the Carolina Mudcats this season before joining the Timber Rattlers on August 23. He was second in the Carolina League in strikeouts and third in the Carolina League in ERA before his promotion to Wisconsin. Cornielle was 1-0 in three starts with Wisconsin and allowed four runs with six walks and 21 strikeouts over 17-1/3 innings pitched.

**LAST START:** Cornielle had a no decision against <u>Peoria at home on April 12</u>. He allowed two runs on three hits with a walk and four strikeouts over four innings.

VS. QUAD CITIES: Cornielle has never faced the River Bandits prior to this afternoon's game. He made one relief appearance against the Columbia Fireflies, the Carolina League affiliate of the Kansas City Royals, last season. Cornielle picked up the <a href="win in game one of a doubleheader on June 18.2022">win in game one of a doubleheader on June 18.2022</a>. He allowed two runs on three hits with no walks and four strikeouts.

#### QUAD CITIES SCHEDULED STARTING PITCHER:

RHP MASON BARNETT: Selected by the Kansas City Royals in the third round of the 2022 draft out of Auburn University.

**HOLD THAT TIGER:** Barnett made 41 appearances – 20 starts – over three seasons at Auburn. He was 5-7 with a save and a 4.69ERA with 142 strikeouts over 111-1/3 innings pitched during his career. Barnett was 3-3 with a 4.38 ERA and 83 strikeouts over 63-2/3 innings during 19 games – 14 starts – in his final season at Auburn.

**OMAHA! OMAHA!** Barnett's final appearance before the 2022 draft was in the College World Series as the starter against Arkansas in an elimination game on June 21, 2022. Barnett took the loss as he allowed four runs on five hits in 2-2/3 innings. Current Timber Rattler Robert Moore had a two-run double in the top of the third inning to put the Razorbacks up 4-0 and knock Barnett out of the game.

**THE CAPE:** Barnett pitched for Brewster in the Cape Cod League in 2022 and was 1-1 with a 4.95 ERA and 23 strikeouts over 20 innings pitched in five starts.

**RATINGS:** MLB Pipeline ranks Barnett as the #18 prospect in the Royals system. Baseball America has him at #20.

FIRST YEAR AS A PRO: Barnett made a one-inning start with the Royals Arizona Complex League team and three relief appearances for Columbia in the Carolina League after signing with Kansas City. He pitched eight scoreless innings, walked one, and struck out twelve with a 1-0 record during his pro debut.

**LAST START:** Barnett had a no decision at home against the <u>Timber Rattlers on April 18</u>. He allowed one hit with four walks and seven strikeouts over five scoreless innings.

**VS. WISCONSIN**: Barnett had never faced the Timber Rattlers – or a Milwaukee Brewers affiliate – prior to last Tuesday.
