ABOUT LAST NIGHT: [The Wisconsin Timber Rattlers](http://TheWisconsinTimberRattlers.com) [beat the South Bend Cubs 6-2 at Neuroscience Group Field.](http://TheWisconsinTimberRattlers.com)

Jackson Chourio homered and drove in three runs for the Timber Rattlers. Justin Jarvis allowed two unearned runs over six innings for the win. Robbie Baker tossed three perfect innings for the save.

QUALITY IS JOB ONE: Jarvis allowed four hits, walked three, and struck out two for the quality start last night. Jarvis earned his ninth quality start of the season with his performance. He is now the Midwest League leader in strikeouts with 123, one better than Joe Boyle of Dayton. Jarvis is tied for the Midwest League lead in wins with nine and leads all pitchers in the High-A Classification in innings pitched (110.2) and starts (22).

DON'T BLINK: Chourio's home run in the bottom of the first inning had an exit velocity of 107-mph. The homer was his second as a Timber Rattler. Chourio also added an RBI fielder's choice in the sixth inning.

NINE UP, NINE DOWN: Baker took over for Jarvis to start the top of the seventh inning. He struck out two over his three perfect innings for the save. In his last four appearances, Baker has allowed one hit with no walks and eight strikeouts over eight scoreless innings.

HE GOES TO ELEVEN...AGAIN: Xavier Warren went 1-for-5 with an RBI last night to move his hitting streak to eleven games. Warren, who was named MWL Player of the Week on Monday, is 18-for-47 (.383) during the streak. He has six doubles, two triples, four homers, fifteen RBI, and an OPS of 1.282 during this streak. Warren's batting average has gone from .203 on the day the streak started (July 28) to .226 heading into play tonight. He also had an eleven-game hitting from June 22 through July 4. Warren has the two longest hitting streaks on the team this season.

LEADING OFF: Last night marked the first time Darrien Miller was Wisconsin's lead-off hitter in the lineup. He walked three times, reached on an error, scored two runs, and drove in one.

ABOUT SOUTH BEND: The South Bend Cubs started as the South Bend White Sox when the Midwest League added them as an expansion team in 1988. They changed their name to the Silver Hawks for the 1994 season and became an affiliate of the Arizona Diamondbacks in 1997. South Bend became an affiliate of the Chicago Cubs in 2015. South Bend won Midwest League pennants in 1989, 1993, 2005, and 2019. Notable alumni for the South Bend franchise include Mike Cameron, Jose Valverde, Chris Capuano, Mark Reynolds, Justin Upton, Wade Miley, Chase Anderson, Keon Broxton, Gleyber Torres, Ian Happ, and Carlos Gonzalez. Terry Francona was the manager of the South Bend White Sox in 1982.

ABOUT THE CUBS: The Chicago Cubs had several different Midwest League affiliates before settling in South Bend in 2015. They were affiliated with Quincy from 1965 through 1973 before leaving the Midwest League. The Cubs returned to the MWL with an affiliation with Quad Cities from 1979 through 1984, Peoria from 1985 through 1994 and again from 2005 through 2012, Rockford from 1995 through 1998, Lansing from 1999 through 2004, Kane County in 2013 and 2014.

SEASON SO FAR: South Bend finished the first half 34-32. They stumbled to the line as they dropped nine out of twelve games to start June. The Cubs put together a ten-game winning streak as they won the final two games of the first half and the first eight games of the second half and they have ridden that the Western Division lead in the second half standings heading into this series with Wisconsin.

PROSPECTING IN THE SERIES: [MLB Pipeline](http://MLBPipeline.com) puts six active Rattlers on their list of Brewers Top 30 Prospects: Jackson Chourio (#1), Jeferson Quero (#6), Eduardo Garcia (#14), Joe Gray Jr. (#15), Xavier Warren (#18), and Taylor Floyd (#24). Tyler Black (#7), Russell Smith (#17), and Carlos Rodriguez (#22) are on the Wisconsin injured list. PITCHING MATCHUP

WISCONSIN SCHEDULED STARTING PITCHER:

RHP CARLOS RODRIGUEZ: Selected by Milwaukee in the 6th round of the 2021 draft out of Florida SouthWestern State Junior College.

ALL-DADE: Rodríguez was a four-year letter winner at Miami Christian High School. He had a 0.67 ERA in his senior season of high school and was an All-Dade County selection.

BUC SHOTS: Rodríguez went 7-2 with a 2.11 ERA and 62 strikeouts over 47 innings pitched in his only season at Florida SouthWestern State. He was a First Team All-Suncoast Conference selection for his performance for the Buccaneers.

PICKED HIGH: Rodríguez is the highest Florida SouthWestern State draft selection since the baseball program restarted in 2016. He was the highest MLB draft selection from the school since Kerry Ward was a fourth-round pick of the Pittsburgh Pirates in 1993.

SWEET CAROLINA: Rodríguez did not pitch professionally last season. His first action as a pro was this season with the Carolina Mudcats in the Carolina League. Rodríguez was 3-4 with a 3.53ERA in nineteen games – thirteen starts – prior to joining the Timber Rattlers. He had walked 27 and struck out 84 in 71-1/3 innings with the Mudcats.

LAST START: Rodríguez had a no decision in his Timber Rattlers debut on [August 5 at Quad Cities](#). He allowed three hits, walked three, and struck out seven over four scoreless innings.

VS. SOUTH BEND (2022): Rodríguez has never faced the South Bend Cubs prior to this evening. He made a start against Myrtle Beach, the Carolina League affiliate of the Chicago Cubs, on [June 10, 2022](#). Rodríguez allowed one hit, walked three, struck out five, and allowed three runs over four innings to take the loss in that game.

SOUTH BEND SCHEDULED STARTING PITCHER:

RHP LUIS DEVERS: The Chicago Cubs signed Devers as an International Free Agent out of the Dominican Republic on July 19, 2017.

TWO SUMMERS: Devers pitched for Chicago's #2 affiliate in the Dominican Summer League in 2018 and 2019. He was 5-10 with a 2.63 ERA in 28 games – 27 starts. He had 109 strikeouts and 33 walks in 119-2/3 innings in the DSL.

TWO STEPS AT A TIME: Devers started his 2021 season with the ACL Cubs and was 2-4 with a 3.33 ERA and 54 strikeouts over 51-1/3 innings in twelve games – eleven starts – before a promotion to Myrtle Beach at the end of the season. Devers pitched two times in relief for the Pelicans in 2021.

BACK ON THE BEACH: Devers started this season with the Pelicans. He was 9-3 with a 2.58 ERA in fifteen games – fourteen starts. Devers had 75 strikeouts and fourteen walks in 66-1/3 innings before earning a promotion to South Bend on July 4, 2022.

LAST START: Devers had a [no decision at Fort Wayne on August 5](#). He allowed two hits, walked one, and struck out six over five scoreless innings.

VS. WISCONSIN: Devers made his Midwest League debut against Wisconsin [on July 6](#) with three innings of scoreless relief at South Bend. He walked none and struck out three for a no decision. Devers also made a start and picked up the win against the Carolina Mudcats, the Carolina League affiliate of the Milwaukee Brewers on [June 11, 2022](#) for Myrtle Beach. He allowed three hits, walked none, and struck out six over five scoreless innings in the game against the Mudcats.
