ABOUT LAST NIGHT: [The Quad Cities River Bandits beat the Wisconsin Timber Rattlers 1-0 at Modern Woodmen Park](#). Chris Brito and Carson Roccaforte had back-to-back doubles with two outs in the bottom of the seventh inning to account for the only run of the game.

OPPORTUNITY KNOCKED...TWICE: Wisconsin had runners at first and second with no outs in the top of the sixth after consecutive singles by Blake Burke and Matt Wood. Burke was caught trying to steal third before Eduardo Garcia walked. Then, Daniel Guilarte grounded into a 6-4-3 double play to end the inning. In the top of the ninth, Wood walked and Garcia singled to put two on with no outs against Zachary Cawyer. Guilarte grounded into a force out at third and Cawyer struck out Hedbert Pérez for two outs. Kay-Lan Nicasia drew a walk to load the bases for the Rattlers. Cawyer got the final out when Yhoswar Garcia popped out to first.

RYAN'S NIGHT: Wisconsin starting pitcher Ryan Birchard pitched 3-2/3 scoreless innings, allowed one hit, walked four, and struck out four in his 2025 debut. He retired the first two batters he faced in the bottom of the fourth inning before walking Callan Moss and Bryan Gonzalez. Birchard left the game in favor of Zach Peek at that time.

PEEK PERFORMANCE: Peek got the final out of the bottom of the fourth with a strikeout. Peek has inherited five base runners in his first two games with Wisconsin. He has not allowed any of those inherited runners to score. Peek also worked around Brito reaching on an error to start the bottom of the fifth by retiring the next three Bandits.

ALMOST: Daniel Corniel made his Timber Rattlers debut last night when he entered the game to start the bottom of the sixth. He retired the first five batters he faced. Brito doubled to extend the seventh inning. Then, Roccaforte would double on a 2-2 pitch to drive in Brito for the only run of the game.

ABOUT QUAD CITIES: The River Bandits are the Midwest League affiliate of the Kansas City Royals. The current version of Davenport Professional Baseball club started in 1960 as the Midwest League affiliate of the Milwaukee Braves. Quad Cities has affiliated with several MLB teams: The California Angels (1962-1978 and 1985-1992), the Chicago Cubs (1979-1984), the Houston Astros (1993-1998 and 2013-2019), the Minnesota Twins (1999-2004), and the St. Louis Cardinals (2005-2012). The team became the Quad City River Bandits in 1992. They changed their name to the Swing of the Quad Cities from 2004 through 2007 before changing to Quad Cities River Bandits in 2008. Quad Cities won Midwest League pennants in 1968, 1971, 1979, 1990, 2011, 2013, and 2017. They were the High-A Central League champions in 2021. Notable alumni of Quad Cities: Carlos Correa, Joe Mauer, Josh Hader, Billy Wagner, Shawon Dunston, Justin Morneau, and Brett Phillips.

ABOUT THE ROYALS: The Kansas City Royals have been Quad Cities' parent club since 2021. They left the Midwest league and an affiliation with Kane County at the end of the 2012 season. The Royals had previously been in the Midwest League with Waterloo (1969-1976), Appleton (1987-1992), Rockford (1993-94), Springfield (1995), Lansing (1996-1998), Burlington (2001-2010), and Kane County (2011-2012).

WISCONSIN STARTING PITCHER:

RHP MANUEL RODRIGUEZ: The Milwaukee Brewers signed Rodriguez as an International Free Agent out of Mexico on April 5, 2022.

WHIRLWIND: Rodriguez had a very busy 2022. After signing with Milwaukee in April, he began his professional career in the Dominican Summer League in June and went 1-5 with a 4.54 ERA in twelve games – five starts. Later in the year he pitched for Mexico in the U-18 World Cup of Baseball. Rodriguez went 1-1 in the tournament with a win over Australia and a loss to the Netherlands.

PLAYOFF EXPERIENCE: Rodriguez has pitched in the postseason in each of the last two seasons. He made a relief appearance for the ACL Brewers in the Arizona Complex League Semifinal Game in 2023 and was the starter in Game Two of the Carolina League Playoffs for the Mudcats against Fredericksburg.

CHECK THE RATING: MLB Pipeline moved Rodriguez into their Top 30 list of Brewers Prospects at #30 after Yophery Rodriguez was traded to Boston on April 7, 2025. *Baseball America* lists Rodriguez as the #25 prospect in the Milwaukee System in their 2025 *Prospect Handbook*.

LAST START: Rodriguez struck out eleven in 4-1/3 innings on [April 4](#) at home against the Cedar Rapids Kernels as Wisconsin's starter on Opening Night, 2025. He allowed an unearned run on three hits and a walk to be charged with the loss.

VS. QUAD CITIES: Rodriguez has never faced the River Bandits prior to this evening. He made two starts against Columbia, the Carolina League affiliate of the Kansas City Royals, in 2024. Rodriguez went 1-1 and allowed four runs on nine hits with a walk and nine strikeouts over 11-2/3 innings versus Columbia last season.

INNINGS PITCHED: 7.0 – 5/7/2024 at Fayetteville

STRIKEOUTS: 11 – 4/4/2025 vs. Cedar Rapids

QUAD CITIES STARTING PITCHER:

LHP FRANK MOZZICATO: The Kansas City Royals selected Mozzicato in the first round with the seventh overall pick in the 2021 draft out of East Catholic High School in Manchester, Connecticut. MLB Pipeline ranks Mozzicato as the #4 prospect in the Kansas City system. *Baseball America* places him at #2 in the Royals organization.

HUSKIE-DON'T: Mozzicato signed with the Royals over a commitment to the University of Connecticut.

THAT CHAMPIONSHIP SEASON: Mozzicato was 9-0 with a 0.16 ERA and 135 strikeouts in 55-2/3 innings pitched to help lead East Catholic to a Class M State Title in Connecticut for his senior season.

GETTING STARTED: Mozzicato did not pitch professionally in 2021. He made his professional debut with the Columbia Fireflies in the 2022 season and was 2-6 with a 4.30 ERA and 89 strikeouts over 69 innings pitched in nineteen starts for the Fireflies. Mozzicato returned to Columbia to start the 2023 season and was 2-5 with a 3.04 ERA and 85 strikeouts in 56-1/3 innings over twelve starts before being promoted to Quad Cities on July 2, 2023.

AS A BANDIT: Mozzicato was 0-4 with a 7.12 ERA in nine starts with Quad Cities after his promotion in 2023. He walked 33 and struck out 45 over 36-2/3 innings pitched. He returned to the Bandits in 2024 and went 5-10 with a 3.45 ERA and 91 strikeouts over 101-2/3 innings over 22 starts.

LAST START: Mozzicato won game one of the doubleheader at Peoria on [April 5](#) in the 2025 opener. He allowed a run on a hit with three walks and three strikeouts.

VS. WISCONSIN (2024): Mozzicato was 2-1 in four starts against the Timber Rattlers last season. He allowed eight runs on ten hits with nine walks and thirteen strikeouts over 16-2/3 innings.
