ABOUT YESTERDAY: The Toledo Mud Hens jumped on top of the Indianapolis Indians in the third inning and never looked back as a pair of solo homers fueled them to a 3-0 victory in a rain-shortened, seven-inning contest on Wednesday afternoon at Fifth Third Field. After a clean two frames from Braxton Ashcraft, Toledo's leadoff hitter, Gage Workman, cranked a 1-0 fastball out to right field to break the scoreless tie. The Mud Hens added a run in the fourth when Jahmai Jones reached on a lead-off double and was brought around to score on an RBI single from Manuel Margot. Toledo delivered their final blow in the sixth with a 420-foot blast from Jace Jung to cap the scoring. Despite Toledo's offense, Ashcraft racked up nine strikeouts across 6.0 innings of work. He was outdueled, however, by Toledo starter Nick Margevicius, who allowed two hits and struck out seven across 6.0 scoreless innings

PEN IS MIGHTY: In May, the Indians bullpen is 7-0 and are pacing Triple-A clubs in ERA (1.87, 14er/67.1ip), WHIP (0.95), opponent's batting average (.193, 46-for-238) and strikeout-to-walk-ratio (4.06, 73 K/18 BB). Nine of the Indians 13 relievers used in the month have a sub-2.00 ERA, including five who have not allowed a run. Indy's bullpen is one of two in Triple-A to have not sustained a loss in May, joining 8-0 Sugar Land. On the season, Indy's bullpen is 16-5, good for a .732 winning percentage which ranks third among Triple-A bullpens.

QUÉ LO QUE: Rehabber Endy Rodríguez tagged a game-tying two-run homer off RHP Aaron Wilkerson in the sixth inning of Sunday's victory vs. Louisville. It was his second two-run homer in as many days, as he clubbed his first off RHP Alan Busenitz in Game 1 of Saturday's doubleheader. He began his rehab assignment on May 14 after being placed on the 10-day injured list on April 15 with a right-hand laceration, sustained when struck by a pitch in the dirt on April 14 vs. Washington.

COOKING THE HENS: Billy Cook cracked a double in yesterday's contest to continue his torrid play against Toledo. Since debuting in Triple-A at the beginning of the 2024 season, Cook ranks second among Triple-A hitters against the Mud Hens (min. 50 PA) in on-base percentage (.444) and OPS (1.111), third in batting average (.333, 17-for-51) and slugging percentage (.667) and is tied for fourth in extra-base hits (10). He's joined by teammate Matt Gorski, who leads Triple-A hitters with 17 extra-base hits against the Mud Hens since 2024 and ranks third in OPS (1.054). As a team since 2024, the Indians rank second among Mud Hens opponents in OPS (.825) and slugging percentage (.458) and third in batting average (.282) and on-base

HE GETS ON (BAE)SE: Ji Hwan Bae is currently riding a 20-game on-base streak dating back to April 13 at Louisville. It's the longest on-base streak by an Indians hitter this season and is tied for the eighth-longest active on-base streak in all of Triple-A. Bae's streak includes a stretch from April 15 to May 6 in which he hit safely in 15 of 17 games. In that stretch, he hit .300 (21-for-70) and tied for the team lead in extra-base hits (6) while scoring 18 runs, which ranked third in all of Triple-A in that span.

CRAFTY Ks: Braxton Ashcraft racked up a Triple-A single game career-high nine strikeouts against Toledo on Wednesday. It was his fifth-straight game with five or more strikeouts, which is the longest streak by an Indians pitcher this season and tied for the fourth-longest active streak in Triple-A. In May, Ashcraft has racked up 29 strikeouts, which is tied with teammate Bubba Chandler and Sugar Land hurler Miguel Ullola for the most in Triple-A. Ashcraft and Chandler are also tied with 56 strikeouts on the season, which ranks third in Triple-A.

TWO MORE BUCCOS ABOARD: In addition to Endy Rodríguez, the Indians roster also boasts two additional major league rehabbers in Dauri Moreta and Nick Gonzales. Gonzales was placed on the 10-day injured list on March 28 with a non-displace left and free friends after hitting a two-run home run in the sixth inning on Opening Day at Miami. He excelled in 94 games with Pittsburgh last season, hitting. 270 (97-for-359) with 19 doubles three triples gaves home group and 40 PDI. March was placed to 194 games with Pittsburgh last season, hitting. 270 (97-for-359) with 19 doubles, three triples, seven home runs and 49 RBI. Moreta was placed on the 60-day injured list on Feb. 16 after undergoing Tommy John surgery and being sidelined for the entire 2024 season. Nearly 14 months after his last professional appearance, the right-hander began a rehab assignment with High-A Bradenton on April 29 and tossed 2.0 scoreless innings in two games. He has since allowed two runs while striking out eight in 5.1 innings (six appearances) with Indv.

TONIGHT'S MATCHUP: The Indianapolis Indians and Toledo Mud Hens are set to make up Tuesday's rainout in a seven-inning doubleheader beginning at 5.35 PM from Fifth Third Field. Indianapolis has swept one doubleheader, lost both in one twin bill and split three so far this season while Toledo has swept a doubleheader and been swept in one. Right-handed pitchers Thomas Harrington and Austin Bergner will face off in Game 1 and left-handed pitcher Nick Dombkowski will take the mound for Indy in Game 2, while Toledo will counter with southpaw Dietrich Enns. Harrington faced Toledo earlier this season on April 17 at Victory Field, striking out four Mud Hens and allowing one run across 3.0 innings of work. In three career starts against Toledo, Harrington has a 4.91 ERA (8er/14.2ip) with 13 strikeouts and a 1.09 WHIP. Dombkowski has pitched one scoreless inning against Toledo in his career and has pitched to a 3.52 ERA (3er/7.2ip) in two starts so far this season. Indy has fared well against both Toledo starters, providing Bergner with a 12.27 ERA (20er/14.2ip) in five starts and Enns with a 4.64 ERA (11er/21.1ip) in four starts.

ON THIS DATE IN 1977: Paul Moskau pitched 7.0 innings of one-hit ball while scattering four walks with five strikeouts in a 3-0 win over Omaha at Bush Stadium. Reliever Joe Henderson finished up the game with 2.0 hitless innings. Ron Oester gave Indy the lead with a solo home run in the second inning, and Arturo DeFreites clubbed a two-run shot in the fifth to cap the scoring.

# **TONIGHT'S PITCHER**

**Thomas Harrington:** The Campbell University alum is currently the Pirates' No. 3 prospect and Minor League Baseball's No. 84 overall prospect according to MLB Pipeline.

**Major League Debut:** Harrington had his contract first selected by Pittsburgh on April 1, 2025 and debuted with a 4.0 inning start the same night at Tampa Bay. Picked up his first career save in his next appearance on April 7 vs. St. Louis.

**Last Outing:** Harrington took the win after tossing 5.2 innings and allowing four runs while striking out eight vs. Lousiville in Game 1 of a doubleheader on May 17. Eight strikeouts marked his most in a Triple-A start.

**Against the Mud Hens:** Harrington has made three career starts against Toledo, pitching to a 4.91 ERA (8er/14.2ip) with 13 strikeouts. He faced the Mud Hens once earlier this season, holding them to one and striking out three across 3.0 innings of work on April 17 at Victory Field.

**Miscellaneous:** Harrington was selected by Pittsburgh in the first round (36th overall) of the 2022 First-Year Player Draft.
