ABOUT LAST NIGHT: The Great Lakes Loons beat the Wisconsin Timber Rattlers 9-2 at Dow Diamond Great Lakes broke a 1-1 tie with two runs in the bottom of the second, added four runs in the third, and tacked on two more runs in the fifth. Four Great Lakes pitchers combined to strike out seventeen Wisconsin hitters. Starter Sean Linan and reliever Wyatt Crowell both struck out seven in the game. Tayden Hall and Eduardo Garcia hit solo homers for the Timber Rattlers.

PLAYING IN TRAFFIC: Great Lakes left eleven on base and went 2-for-11 with runners on scoring position on Friday night. They had been 8-for-46 with runners in scoring position in the first four games of the series. On Saturday night, the Loons went 6-for-16 with runners in scoring position. They scored their final eight runs with two outs. Kendal George had two-run, two-out singles in the second and fifth innings.

THE FIRST QUARTER: Eduardo Garcia extended his on-base streak to 25 games last night with a hit batsman, a homer, a single, and a stolen base. He is 29-for-94 (.309) with eight homers, nine doubles, twenty RBI. 27 runs, and sixteen stolen bases during the streak. Garcia has an OPS of 1.079 during the streak and is tied with Blake Burke for the longest on-base streak in the Midwest League this season.

IT GOES TO ELEVEN: Garcia's homer was his eleventh of the season. He is tied for second in the league in homers. Josue Briceño leads the league with thirteen

FIRST! Hall's homer in the top of the second inning tied the game 1-1. It was his first home run of the season. **DOWN THE STRETCH THEY COME:** The Rattlers were eliminated from playoff contention last night as

ABOUT GREAT LAKES: The Great Lakes Loons came into existence in 2007 after the Midwest League team left Battle Creek, Michigan at the end of the 2006 season. The team in Battle Creek had been known as the Michigan Battle Cats, Battle Creek Yankees, and the Southwest Michigan Devil Rays. The Loons have been affiliated with the Los Angeles Dodgers since 2007. They have made the Midwest League playoffs nine times since 2007. The Loons won the Midwest League title in 2016 and lost to Cedar Rapids in the Midwest League Championship Series in 2023. Notable Great Lakes alumni include Clayton Kershaw, Kenley Jansen, Nathan Eovaldi, Joc Peterson, Julio Urias, Walker Buehler, and Gavin Lux. Jair Fernandez, who played in 52 games with the Timber Rattlers in 2007, is in his second season as the manager of the Loons.

ABOUT THE DODGERS: The Los Angeles Dodgers were only in the Midwest League for a few seasons prior to affiliating with the Loons. They were in Dubuque in 1967 and in Clinton from 1977 to 1979. Orel Hershiser and Steve Sax were notable Dodgers to play in Clinton.

PROSPECTING IN THE SERIES: MLB Pipeline places five Rattlers on their list of Brewers Top 30 Prospects: Bishop Letson (#14), Blake Burke (#17), Jadher Areinamo (#23), Juan Baez (#26), and Manuel Rodriguez (#29). MLB Pipeline has six Loons on their list of Top 30 Dodgers prospects: Josue De Paula (#2), Zyhir Hope (#3), Kendall George (#12), Eriq Swan (#16), Mike Sirota (#18), and Logan Wagner (#24).

WISCONSIN STARTING PITCHER:

RHP RYAN BIRCHARD: The Milwaukee Brewers selected Birchard in the 5th round of the 2023 draft out of the Niagara County Community College.

PLAYER OF THE YEAR: Birchard was named the Western New York Athletic Conference Player of the Year in 2023. He was 8-0 in ten games – nine starts – with a 1.08 ERA and 95 strikeouts over fifty innings pitched. Birchard was also named a First Team All-NJCAA Division III All-American in 2023.

QUICK TRIP TO TRENTON: Birchard made four appearances – two starts – for Trenton in the MLB Draft League after the end of his college season. He allowed one run, walked one, and struck out sixteen over nine innings before signing with Milwaukee.

DELAYED START: Birchard did not pitch professionally in 2023. He made a start for the Carolina Mudcats on April 6, 2024 (4.0IP, H, R, 0ER, 2BB, 6K) but was placed on the IL after that game. He next pitched with the ACL Brewers on July 16 and July 22. Birchard rejoined Carolina for appearances on July 28 and August 3 before being sent to Wisconsin on August 13.

AS A RATTLER (2024): Birchard made five regular season starts for Wisconsin last season. He was 0-3 with an 8.71 ERA. He walked fourteen and struck out thirteen in 10-1/3 innings with the Timber Rattlers

LAST START: Birchard had a no decision in game one of this series with the Loons on June 10. He allowed two hits, walked six, and struck out six over four scoreless innings.

VS. GREAT LAKES (2024): Birchard had a no decision at Great Lakes on <u>August 24, 2024</u>. He allowed one hit, walked four, and struck out six over three scoreless innings.

GREAT LAKES STARTING PITCHER:

RHP BROOKS AUGER: The Los Angeles Dodgers selected Auger in the sixth round of the 2024 draft out of Mississippi State University.

HAIL STATE: Auger pitched two seasons (2022 and 2024) for the Bulldogs. He missed the 2023 season after surgery to repair a tear in the UCL of his right elbow. In his career at MSU, Auger was 3-2 with two saves and a 3.26 ERA in 36 games – five starts. Auger walked 29 and struck out 77 in his two collegiate seasons.

NO PRO BALL IN 2024: Auger did not pitch professionally. He made his professional debut with the Loons as the starting pitcher on April 5, 2025 against Lake County.

LAST START: Auger lost at South Bend on <u>June 8</u>. He allowed five runs – two earned – on three hits with two hit batsmen, two walks, and no strikeouts over one inning.

VS. WISCONSIN: Auger has never pitched against the Timber Rattlers prior to this afternoon. Today is also the first time he will face an affiliate of the Milwaukee Brewers.
