ABOUT LAST NIGHT: The Wisconsin Timber Rattlers beat the Quad Cities River Bandits 3-2 at Modern Woodmen Park. Antonio Piñero's two-out, two-run single in the top of the sixth capped a three-run rally and erased a 2-0 deficit. Zach Mort, Robbie Baker, and James Meeker combined to hold the Bandits to two runs on four hits for Wisconsin's fourth win in the series. DON'T MESS WITH THE ZAVIER: Zavier Warren went 1-for-3 with two walks and a run scored last night. He is 11-for-21 with four doubles, four walks, two triples, three homers, eight runs scored, and ten RBI in the first five games of the series

DON'T YOU FORGET ABOUT ME: Piñero had two more hits last night. Piñero is 10-for-18 in this series ON THE SPOT: Mort allowed two runs on four hits with no walks and five strikeouts over six innings for a quality start and a win in a spot start for the Rattlers. MEEK INHERITS THE EARTH: Meeker entered for the ninth inning and gave up a leadoff walk before retiring the next three batters, including two via strikeout for his eighth save of the season. In nine relief appearances against the River Bandits this season. Meeker is 1-0 with seven saves in seven save opportunities. Meeker has allowed one run on four hits with five walks and five strikeouts over 10-1/3 innings against Quad Cities in 2022.

CLOSE SHAVES: The Timber Rattlers and 19-4 in 23 games against the River Bandits this season. Nine of the games between Wisconsin and Quad Cities have been decided by one run with the Rattlers going 8-1 in those one-run games.

ABOUT QUAD CITIES: The River Bandits are the Midwest League affiliate of the Kansas City Royals. The current version of Davenport Professional Baseball club started in 1960 as the Midwest League affiliate of the Milwaukee Braves. Quad Cities has affiliated with several MLB teams: The California Angels (1962-1978 and 1985-1992), the Chicago Cubs (1979-1984), the Houston Astros (1993-1998 and 2013-2019), the Minnesota Twins (1999-2004), and the St. Louis Cardinals (2005-2012). The team became the Quad City River Bandits in 1992. They changed their name to the Swing of the Quad Cities from 2004 through 2007 before changing to Quad Cities River Bandits in 2008. Quad Cities won Midwest League pennants in 1968, 1971, 1979, 1990, 2011, 2013, and 2017. They were the High-A Central League champions in 2021. Notable alumni of Quad Cities: Carlos Correa, Joe Mauer, Josh Hader, Billy Wagner, Shawon Dunston, Justin Morneau, and Brett Phillips.

ABOUT THE ROYALS: The Kansas City Royals have been Quad Cities' parent club since 2021. They left the Midwest league and an affiliation with Kane County at the end of the 2012 season. The Royals had previously been in the Midwest League with Waterloo from 1969-1976, Appleton (1987-1992), Rockford (1993-94), Springfield (1995), Lansing (1996-1998), Burlington (2001-2010), and Kane County (2011-2012)

PROSPECTING IN THE SERIES: MLB Pipeline puts six active Rattlers on their list of Brewers Top 30 Prospects: Jackson Chourio (#1), Eduardo García (#14), Joe Gray Jr. (#15), Russell Smith (#17), Zavier Warren (#18), and Taylor Floyd (#24). Tyler Black (#7) and Carlos Rodríguez (#22) are on the Wisconsin injured list. MLB Pipeline has five current River Bandits on their Top 30 list of Royals prospects: Beck Way (#12), Peyton Wilson (#13), Luca Tresh (#24), Diego Hernandez (#29), and Chandler Champlain (#30).

# PITCHING MATCHUP

#### WISCONSIN STARTING PITCHER:

RHP JUSTIN BULLOCK: Selected by the Brewers in the 16<sup>th</sup> round of the 2017 draft out of South Granville (NC) High School.

HE'S A PLAYER: Bullock was named the North Carolina Baseball Coaches Association 2A Player of the Year in 2017. He was 11-1 with a 0.55ERA and 124 strikeouts in 63-2/3 innings pitched on the mound. Bullock also hit .476 with eleven homers and 46RBI. Bullock signed with the Brewers over a commitment to North Carolina State University.

**EARLY PRO CAREER:** Bullock went 1-0 with a 3.09ERA in six games – one start – for the AZL Brewers after signing with Milwaukee in 2017. Then, Bullock made 13 starts for Helena in 2018 and finished fourth in the Pioneer League in strikeouts with 66.

**CAROLINA ON MY MIND:** Bullock started the 2021 season with the Carolina Mudcats in the Low-A East. He was 1-1 in four starts with a 1.42 ERA. He walked five and struck out 27 over 19 innings pitched with the Mudcats this season. He finished on a 15-2/3 inning scoreless streak.

**TIME WITH THE TIMBER RATTLERS:** Bullock was 2-2 with a 7.78 ERA, 14 walks and 20 strikeouts over 19-2/3 innings in seven games – three starts – for Wisconsin in 2019 before he left a game on May 9 with a season-ending injury. Bullock returned to the Rattlers in 2021 and was 5-2 in eight starts before he was bumped up to Biloxi.

**SOUTHERN MAN:** Bullock went 2-5 in eight starts at Biloxi to end the 2021 season. He was 0-2 in nine starts with the Shuckers in 2022 before returning to the Timber Rattlers on July 4.

**AWARD WINNING:** Bullock was the High-A Central League's pitcher of the month for June. He was 3-1 with a 3.00 ERA in four starts with Wisconsin. Bullock walked one and struck out 23 over 24 innings during the month.

**LAST START:** Bullock beat Quad Cities on August 2 in game one of this series. He allowed two hits, walked one, and struck out four over six scoreless innings.

VS. QUAD CITIES (2021): Bullock was 0-2 in two starts against the River Bandits last season. He lost on <u>June 16</u> at Quad Cities and at home on <u>July 9</u>. Bullock allowed nine runs on fifteen hits with three walks and nine strikeouts over 11-1/3 innings pitched against the Bandits last year.

#### **QUAD CITIES SCHEDULED STARTING PITCHER:**

RHP BECK WAY: The Kansas City Royals acquired Way in a trade with the New York Yankees on July 27, 2022. Kansas City sent Andrew Benintendi to New York in exchange for Way, Chandler Champlain, and TJ Sikkema. Way is now the #12 prospect in the Royals system according to MLB Pipeline.

THIS IS THE WAY: The Yankees selected Way in the fourth round of the 2020 draft out of Northwest Florida State. Way had been 5-0 with a 0.67 ERA in seven games for the Raiders in the COVID-19 shortened season prior to the draft.

A YEAR IN THE ABBEY: Way made nineteen relief appearances for Belmont Abbey in 2018 and was 0-1 with two saves prior to transferring to Northwest Florida. He also appeared in eleven games for Cotuit in the Cape Cod League during the summer of 2019.

**HE WAS A YANKEE:** Way split time between Tampa and Hudson Valley in the Yankees system in 2021 and was 4-3 in nineteen games – eighteen starts – with a 3.98 ERA and 83 strikeouts in 63-1/3 innings. Way pitched for Hudson Valley in 2022 before the trade and was 5-5 with a 3.73 ERA and 80 strikeouts over 72-1/3 innings.

**LAST START:** Way lost to the <u>Timber Rattlers on August 2</u> in game one of this series. He allowed five runs on five hits with three walks and six strikeouts over 4-2/3 innings in the game.

VS. WISCONSIN: Way's start against the Timber Rattlers on August 2 was the first time he pitched against Wisconsin. That game was also the first time he faced an affiliate of the Milwaukee Brewers.
