ABOUT LAST NIGHT: The Wisconsin Timber Ratters beat the Cedar Rapids Kernels 2-1 at Rise 2 Greatne Field. Felix Valerio hit a two-run home run in the top of the eighth inning to erase a 1-0 deficit. The Rattlers had not led in a game from the end of their win over Quad Cities on August 27 until that home run by Valerio. Last night's win ended Wisconsin's seasonhigh five-game losing streak.

CRUZ CONTROL: Stiven Cruz allowed an unearned run over six innings for a quality start last night in his longest appearance of the season for Wisconsin. HELPING HAND: Wisconsin left fielder Hedbert Pérez threw out Rixon Wingrove at second base for the first out in the bottom of the ninth as Wingrove tried to stretch a single into a double. Pérez has four outfield assists in fifteen games with Wisconsin this season. SAVINGS PLAN: Aaron Rund, the beneficiary of the outfield assist by Pérez to open the bottom of the ninth, struck out the next two batters to close out the game and earn his eighth save of the season.

ABOUT CEDAR RAPIDS: The current franchise began its existence in 1949 as the Cedar Rapids Rockets, an unaffiliated team in the Central Association. They moved to the Three-I League as the Cedar Rapids Indians as an affiliate of Cleveland in 1950. They were affiliated with the Milwaukee Braves from 1954 through 1962. Cedar Rapids has been called the Braves, Red Raiders, Cardinals, Astros, Giants, and Reds until they became the Kernels in 1993. That was the same year the California Angels became the parent club of the Kernels. That affiliation remained through the 2012 season. Cedar Rapids has been affiliated with the Minnesota Twins since 2013. The Kernels have made the Midwest League playoffs every year they have been affiliated with the Twins, including a Midwest League Championship last season. Notable alumni include Mike Trout, Byron Buxton, and Brewers Pitching Coach Chris Hook. Hall of Famers John McGraw (1891 Canaries), Lou Boudreau (1938 Raiders), Ted Simmons (1967 Cardinals), and Trevor Hoffman (1991 Reds) played for earlier pro teams in Cedar Rapids.

ABOUT THE TWINS: Minnesota has a long history of in the Midwest League. They started out with Wisconsin Rapids (1964-1983) and moved to Kenosha (1984-1992) and to Fort Wayne (1993-1998) as the franchise moved around the league. Minnesota has also been with Quad Cities (1999-2004) and Beloit (2005-2012) before their current affiliation with Cedar Rapids Kernels started in

PROSPECTING IN THE SERIES: MLB Pipeline places four active Rattlers on their list of Brewers Top 30 Prospects: Cooper Pratt (#2), Luke Adams (#8), Luis Lara (#16), and Jadher Areinamo (#21). Blake Burke (#15) is currently on the IL. MLB Pipeline has five active Kernels on their list of Minnesota prospects: Walker Jenkins (#1), Kaelen Culpepper (#6), Gabriel Gonzalez (#9), Connor Prielipp (#22), and Rubel Cespedes (#24). Rayne Doncon (#19) and Danny DeAndrade (#23) are currently on the IL.

THAT CHAMPIONSHIP SEASON: Cedar Rapids is the reigning Midwest League Champion. The Kernels beat the Peoria Chiefs in Game Three of the best-of-three Western Division Finals and the Great Lakes Loons in Game Three of the best-of-three Championship Series to claim their first Midwest League pennant since 1994. The Kernels were 82-50 during the 2023 regular season to finish last year with the best record in the Midwest League.

# PITCHING MATCHUP

### WISCONSIN STARTING PITCHER:

RHP ALEXANDER CORNIELLE: Milwaukee signed Cornielle as an International Free Agent out of the Dominican Republic on June 15, 2019.

**FAST DEBUT:** Cornielle made his professional debut with one inning of relief against the Cubs #2 affiliate in the Dominican Summer League on August 2, 2019. He allowed one run on no hits with two walks in one inning. Cornielle made three appearances in the DSL in 2019 with no record.

**HIT PLAY:** Cornielle started 2021 with the Brewers Blue affiliate in the Arizona Complex League and was 4-2 in nine games – four starts – with a 4.64 ERA and 50 strikeouts over 33 innings. With Carolina at the end of the season, he was 0-1 in two starts with ten strikeouts in eight innings.

**WEEKLY AWARDS:** Cornielle was named the ACL's Pitcher of the Week on September 6, 2021. He also won the Midwest League Pitcher of the Week Award on September 11, 2023.

**BACK IN 2022:** Cornielle was 9-7 in 22 games – 19 starts – with a 3.19 ERA and 124 strikeouts over 101-2/3 innings pitched for the Carolina Mudcats this season before joining the Timber Rattlers on August 23. He was second in the Carolina League in strikeouts and third in the Carolina League in ERA before his promotion to Wisconsin. Cornielle was 1-0 in three starts with 21 strikeouts over 17-1/3 innings pitched.

**LAST SEASON:** Cornielle was 1-3 in twenty games – eighteen starts – for Wisconsin. He walked 34, struck out 92, and compiled a 4.55 ERA in 89 innings pitched for the Rattlers.

**LAST START:** Cornielle had a no decision against Quad Cities at home on <u>August 27</u>. He allowed one run on four hits with two walks and five strikeouts over four innings.

VS. CEDAR RAPIDS (2024): Cornielle had a no decision at home against Cedar Rapids on <a href="April 20">April 20</a>. He allowed four runs on three hits with two walks and two strikeouts over 2-2/3 innings.

### CEDAR RAPIDS STARTING PITCHER:

RHP JOHN KLEIN: The Minnesota Twins signed Klein as a non-drafted free agent out of Iowa Central Community College on August 8, 2022

**COMMUNITY:** Klein pitched one season at ICCC and was 6-3 with a 5.12 ERA in thirteen games – twelve starts. He walked 32 and struck out 83 over 63-1/3 innings pitched for the Tritons.

**STARTING OUT SLOW:** Klein made his pro debut with the Florida Complex League in 2022 with two relief appearances. He allowed one hits, walked one, and struck out two over two scoreless innings.

WHAT ABOUT LAST YEAR? Klein began 2023 with the Florida Complex League affiliate of the Twins, was sent to the Fort Myers Mighty Mussels in the Florida State League for one start on July 9, bounced back to the FCL Twins on July 13, and sent back to Fort Myers on July 29. Klein was 0-3 in six starts with an ERA of 5.87 ERA and nine walks with 27 strikeouts over 23 innings in the FCL. He was 2-1 with a 2.97 ERA in six starts with thirteen walks and 30 strikeouts over 30-1/3 innings with Fort Myers before receiving a promotion to Cedar Rapids on September 7. Klein had a no decision in one regular season start and a no decision in a relief appearance during the 2023 playoffs with the Kernels.

**LAST START:** Klein had a no decision at Lake County on <u>August 29</u>. He allowed two runs on five hits with a walk and six strikeouts over four innings.

VS. WISCONSIN (2024): Klein had a no decision at Wisconsin on April 18. He allowed four runs on six hits with no walks and two strikeouts over four innings.
