ABOUT LAST GAME

South Bend saw their 3-game winning streak come to an end in a 3-2 final on Thursday night, in which the Cubs did hold a small lead at 2-1 after 6 innings. Wisconsin stormed back with two runs in the 7th, and broke their 3-game losing skid. It was the first game South Bend had lost this year when Nick Dean pitches, and are 6-1 in those games now on the campaign.

SETTING THE TABLE

Lead-off man Brett Bateman is batting .316 over his last 5 games, pushing his season average back above the .300 mark now at .305. Also in his last 5, Bateman has three walks to just one strikeout.

ED'S ROLLING

With 2 more hits on Thursday night, Ed Howard is batting .323 in the month of June, and the average in his last 25 games is at .356. The former Cubs first-round pick out of Mount Carmel High School in Chicago missed nearly all of 2022 and most of 2023 with a hip injury.

GOING STREAKING

Pedro Ramirez' longest active on-base streak in High-A at 27 games (T-3rd in MiLB) ended last Wednesday. He singled in the 5th inning on Tuesday to extend the longest on-base streak since South Bend became a Cubs affiliate in 2015. The all-time South Bend record was set in 2014 by Andrew Velazquez at a whopping 74 games. With a base hit on Wednesday, Parker Chavers has now been on base in 23 straight.

GRAY VS THE RATTLETS PT. 3

Left-hander Drew Gray will make his 3rd start of the season against the Wisconsin Timber Rattlers, after losing versus Wisconsin in April, and taking a no-decision in May. Over his last two starts, Gray has combined for 11 walks, and has 42 walks to 45 strikeouts on the season.

HOME RUN BALL KEY

In 23 of South Bend's 31 wins this year, they have hit at least one home run. Only 8 times this season have the Cubs won a game without a home run.

BIG LEAGUE EXPERIENCE

Each member of the South Bend Cubs coaching staff brings with them a unique level of Big League ties. Manager Nick Lovullo's dad, Torey, is the manager of the Arizona Diamondbacks. Bench coach Kyle Moore managed in the Orioles organization at Single-A and Double-A, and had players like Jackson Holiday, Gunnar Henderson, and Adley Rutschman. Then, both pitching coach Bruce Billings (Rockies, Yankees, A's) and hitting coach Nate Spears (Red Sox) have Big League playing experience.

HAPP ATTACK

2015 South Bend Cub Ian Happ crushed a go-ahead 2-run homer in the 10th inning Thursday in San Francisco, leading the Cubs to a 5-3 win. Chicago now heads to Milwaukee to battle the parent club of the Timber Rattlers, the Brewers. Happ will be at Four Winds Field for an appearance on Monday night, and he will join the broadcast on Marquee Sports Network for an inning.

LET'S PLAY 2

South Bend will play their second doubleheader of 2024 on Saturday, with the last also coming against Wisconsin on April 12. The Rattlers won Game 1 1-0 against Drew Gray, and South Bend took Game 2 2-1.

- A 17-game hitting streak that came to an end on May 3, Rojas tied the South Bend Cubs record for a hit streak with Eloy Jimenez (2016), Roberto Caro (2018), and Yohendrick Pinango (2022), Pinango then tied it again and ended his 17-gamer on May 12
- Infielder Pedro Ramirez had a 25-48 stretch at the plate (.520) to begin the month of May.

-June 7 the Cubs got their first walkoff HR in exactly 23 months, and first walkoff of 2024 with a Brian Kalmer 2R-HR in the 10th to beat West Michigan 4-2.

CUBS #10 PROSPECT

At Peoria: Worked just 0.1 of an inning in game 2 of a doubleheader last Friday at Peoria. Walked the first 5 batters, then struck out Joshua Baez, only to walk the next batter and see his night end. Cubs lost 9-2. The Chiefs sent 10 batters to the plate in the 1st inning and the first 9 didn't put the ball in play (7 BB, 2 K). He thre 37 pitches (12 strikes).

Had allowed exactly 1 hit in each of his first 4 starts of 2024... Tied career high with 5 walks in 2 IP at Beloit on April 19... Walked at least 3 in each April start

2023

- Returning from Tommy John surgery, Gray was activated in the ACL in early June and made 3 starts, his first outings since 2021, before promotion to Low-A Myrtle Beach on June 24
- With the Pelicans across 11 starts he put up a 4.23 ERA in just 27.2 innings, never seeing the 4th inning in a game
- Carolina League hitters only his .196 against him and in those 27.2 IP he struck out 45 (but walked 23)
- Finished the season as the Carolina League Pitcher of the Month for September, striking out 12 batters in 2 starts and allowing a BAA of .056.

ADDITIONAL CAREER NOTES/HIGH SCHOOL

- The top lefty prospect in the Cubs system that's not in the bigs (behind #8 Jordan Wicks, #15 Luke Little) to begin 2024
- Formerly the top prospect in Illinois at Belleville East High School before transferring to IMG Academy for his senior year
- In 2021 he debuted with just 4 innings in the ACL, and then didn't pitch again until the middle of last season after Tommy John surgery in February 2022
- 2024 is his 4th year since being drafted, and his 3rd pro season, but entering the year he's only thron 38 innings total
- In the 2021 MLB Draft his stock took a hit following control problems at IMG and rumors of arm issues (MLB.com)

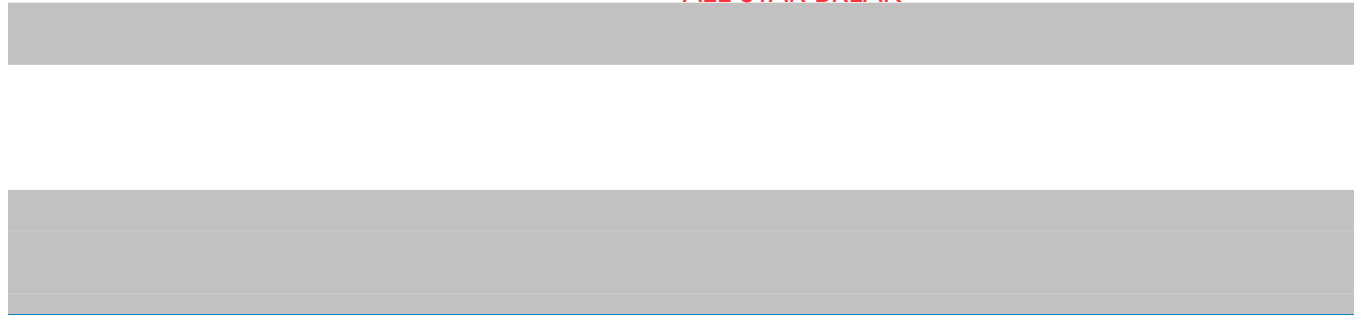
