ABOUT SUNDAY: Alika Williams' solo home run in the fourth inning was the deciding run in the Indianapolis Indians 12-4 win over the Iowa Cubs on Sunday afternoon at Principal Park. The Indians secured their second consecutive series win at Iowa since July 23, 2024. Nick Yorke kicked off the scoring for the Indians with a solo home run in the second inning. Following a pair of groundouts, Williams was hit by a pitch. Darick Hall then singled, with Tsung-Che Cheng bringing them both home via his third triple of the campaign. Ronny Simon smacked a double into the gap to plate Cheng, putting Indy up 4-0. Ronny Simon launched his eighth home run of the season, a three-run blast, in the top of the ninth inning. Rafael Flores drove in the 12th run of the game with an RBI single later in the frame. Nick Dombkowski tossed 4.2 innings of one-run ball, his longest professional outing since 6.0 innings on Sept. 7, 2024, with Double-A Altoona at Hartford. Blake Townsend (W, 1-0) earned his first Triple-A win with 2.1 scoreless frames following Dombkowski.

VICTORS VALIANT: The Indians carry a 43-13 record at Victory Field this season. Their 43 home wins are the most among all full-season minor league clubs and their .754 home winning percentage trails only Low-A San Jose (37-11, .771). The Indians home win total matches or surpasses their full-season total in 22 of 27 full seasons in the Victory Field era (since 1996). They have won 15 of their last 18 games at the Vic since June 27 and 33 of their last 41 since May 11. Their home winning percentage is the highest for a Triple-A team to this point in the season since at least 2005 and is on pace to surpass San Antonio (49-21, .700) for the highest home winning percentage by a Triple-A team in a full season in that span. They have not lost more than three consecutive games this season, joining Durham as the only Triple-A clubs to have not done so on the campaign. The Indians have not completed a season without losing three or more games in a row since 2006, when they dropped three straight games seven times that season, compared to two instances for the 2025 Indians.

CHA CHENG: Tsung-Che Cheng (2-for-2, 2 R, 3B, 2 RBI, 2 BB, HBP) reached base safely all five times in Sunday afternoon's contest, doing so for the first time since Sept. 3, 2021 with FCL Pirates Gold at FCL Pirates Black (1 H, 4 BB). Since returning from the injured list on July 1, Cheng is hitting .265 (18-for-68) with 11 runs, five doubles, two triples, one home run, 16 RBI, 8 walks, two stolen bases and a .783 OPS. He has hit safely in 15 of 21 and reached safely in 17 of those 21 in this span. Additionally, he has driven in one-plus run in 11 of those 21.

NICK YORKE CITY: Nick Yorke (3-for-6, HR, 2 RBI) launched his seventh home run of the season in the second inning on Sunday, extending his on-base streak to eight games. In this span since July 19, he is hitting .382 (13-for-34) with five runs, two doubles, one home run, nine RBI, two walks and a .946 OPS in this span. It was his 24th multi-hit game of the campaign, which trails only Nick Solak for the team lead (26), and his fifth three-hit game which trails only Billy Cook's seven three-knock contests.

SUPER SIMON: Ronny Simon (3-for-6, 2B, HR, 5 RBI) posted his fifth three-hit game of the campaign on Sunday afternoon. He capped his day with a three-run homer in the ninth inning, posting five RBI for the first time since May 12, 2022, with High-A Bowling Green vs. Jersey Shore. Simon has reached safely in 41 of 45 games with Indy and hit safely in 35 of those. He extended his hitting streak to a season-high eight games dating back to July 26, hitting .361 (13-for-36) with eight RBI and a .910 OPS in this span.

RIDICULOUS-NICK: Nick Solak (2-for-6) posted his team-leading 26th multi-hit game of the season on Sunday. He extended his on-base streak to 37 games, the longest on-base streak by an International League player this season, and the longest by an Indians player since Chris Richard's 46-game streak from May 13-July 6, 2006. Additionally, it is the fourth Indianapolis on-base streak of 37-plus games since at least 2005, joining Ty Wigginton (41G, 6/24-8/8, 2005), Ronny Paulino (42G, 6/6-7/27, 2005) and Richard. During his streak, Solak ranks among qualified IL hitters in batting average (3rd, .352) on-base percentage (4th, .435) and hits (T-4th, 51) while racking up eight doubles, four homers, 24 RBI, 17 walks to 16 strikeouts and a .925 OPS. On the season, Solak leads the IL in batting average, on-base percentage and OPS.

TONIGHT'S MATCHUP: The Indianapolis Indians begin a six-game series at Victory Field with the Omaha Storm Chasers tonight at 6:35 PM. It is the third and final meeting between the clubs this season and the second at Victory Field, with the Indians taking four of six home games in late June. The Indians lead the season series, 7-5. RHP Bubba Chandler takes the mound for the Indians for MiLB.TV's Free Game of the Day, set to make his league-leading 22nd start of the campaign. Opposite Chandler is LHP Dallas Keuchel, who eyes his fifth start of the season for Omaha. Keuchel was signed by Kansas City on July 9 after being DFA by Milwaukee on July 14. It will mark his first career start against Indy.

LATE NIGHT WITH BUBBA CHANDLER: Bubba Chandler is tied for the International League lead with 106 strikeouts and has eclipsed the 100-K mark for the third consecutive season. He ranks among qualified Triple-A pitchers in strikeouts (2nd, 106), K/9 (3rd, 10.84), opponent OPS (4th, .687), opponent average (6th, .229), MLB Pipeline's No. 5 overall prospect and Pittsburgh's No. 2 has thrown 43 pitches at 100.0-plus mph this season, topping out at 101.7 on June 11 vs. St. Paul. In seven home starts at night this season, he is 3-0 with a 1.01 ERA (4er/35.2ip) and 47 strikeouts.

FRENIEMIES: Cam Devaney takes on his former club, Omaha, for the first time since being traded from Kansas City to Pittsburgh on July 16. He has reached base safely in all 14 games with Indianapolis, hitting .292 (14-for-48) with an .841 OPS. Between Omaha and Indy, he has reached safely in 19 straight since July 1. LHP Evan Sisk, who was traded from Kansas City to Pittsburgh on July 31, is also set to square off with his previous club. Sisk made his Indians debut on Aug. 2 at Iowa, tossing 1.1 scoreless frames with one hit, one walk and three strikeouts.

ON THIS DATE IN 1996: Keith Mitchell launched a one-out, first-inning grand slam — the first in Victory Field history, albeit the Indians played as the road team — and Kirt Ojala tossed a two-hit complete game as the Indians defeated Nashville, 7-2. Mitchell's grand slam was his first of two home runs on the day, and he ended the performance with a team-leading five RBI. The victory was the third time that Ojala went the distance during his 1996 campaign with Indianapolis, as well as being his seventh and final win of the season.

TONIGHT'S PITCHER

Bubba Chandler: Right-hander Bubba Chandler is currently rated the No. 5 overall prospect in Minor League Baseball according to MLB Pipeline and is the Pirates No. 2. In 28 career starts with Indianapolis, Chandler is 9-4 with a 3.04 ERA (43er/127.1ip) and 160 strikeouts. He has struck out eight-plus batters in eight of those starts and six-plus in 16.

Last Outing: Chandler took his fourth loss of the season on July 30 at Iowa, allowing five earned runs across 5.1 innings with two strikeouts.

Against the Storm Chasers: In two career starts against Omaha, both of them earlier this season, Chandler is 1-0 with a 2.16 ERA (2er/8.1ip) and 15 strikeouts. He struck out a season-high nine batters on May 1 at Omaha, earning the win with 5.0 innings of one-run ball.

IL Pitcher of the Month: Chandler was named the 2025 International League April Pitcher of the Month after he led all minor league pitchers with at least 20.0 innings in fewest hits allowed (7) and batting average against (.106, 7-for-66). He is the first Indianapolis Indians pitcher to win a league monthly award since Zach Duke in May 2005. He went 1-0 with a 1.33 ERA (3er/20.1ip), 27 strikeouts and a 0.64 WHIP across five starts in the month. In addition to his minor league leading marks, he led IL pitchers with at least 20.0 innings in WHIP and finished third in ERA.

IL Pitcher of the Week: Chandler was named the International League Pitcher of the Week for Aug. 5-11, 2024, after tossing 7.0 shutout innings with two hits, one walk and six strikeouts while he secured the win.

Miscellaneous: Selected by Pittsburgh in the third round (72nd overall) of the 2021 First-Year Player Draft out of North Oconee (Bogart, GA.) High School. He was selected to the 2024 All-Star Futures Game and struck out Royals prospect Gavin Cross.
