ABOUT LAST NIGHT: The Wisconsin Timber Rattlers beat the Quad Cities River Bandits 8-7. Wisconsin withstood four solo homers by Quad Cities and rallied from a 7-4 deficit with four runs in the top of the eighth. Cam Robinson pitched two scoreless innings with four strikeouts to close out the game.

**BLACKOUT:** Tyler Black went 1-for-4 with an RBI single and a hit batsman last night. Black has been Wisconsin's lead-off batter in the last seven games. He has been on base sixteen times and scored eight runs in his seven games as the lead-off hitter. Black is 8-for-20 with ten RBI in the series at Quad Cities.

**FEELING 22:** Tristan Peters doubled in the first inning last night to move his current on-base streak to 22 games. He has an OPS of .949 with twelve walks, sixteen runs scored, and thirteen RBI during the streak. Peters has the longest active on-base streak in the Midwest League.

**DOUBLE TROUBLE:** Ashton McGee tied the game 7-7 with a two-run double in the top of the eighth. The rally was set up by a lead-off double from Zavier Warren. Warren had two doubles and three hits last night. McGee had three RBI last night.

GRAY DAY: Last night, Joe Gray Jr was not in the starting lineup for the first time this season. He had to come into the game defensively in the bottom of the second after Micah Bello was hit by a pitch in the top of the second and had to leave the game. Gray wound up 0-for-1 with a walk and a run scored in the fifth inning and drove in the go-ahead run in the top of the eighth with a sacrifice fly.

**DANGER ZONE:** Robinson leads the Midwest League in saves with seven. He has a two-inning save in his last four appearances with one hit, no runs, and ten strikeouts over eight innings.

**DEEP END:** The River Bandits have hit 21 of their 35 home runs hits season in eleven games against the Timber Rattlers. Wisconsin is 9-2 against Quad Cities.

ABOUT QUAD CITIES: The River Bandits are the Midwest League affiliate of the Kansas City Royals. The current version of Davenport Professional Baseball club started in 1960 as the Midwest League affiliate of the Milwaukee Braves. Quad Cities has affiliated with several MLB teams: The California Angels (1962-1978 and 1985-1992), the Chicago Cubs (1979-1984), the Houston Astros (1993-1998 and 2013-2019), the Minnesota Twins (1999-2004), and the St. Louis Cardinals (2005-2012). The team became the Quad City River Bandits in 1992. They changed their name to the Swing of the Quad Cities from 2004 through 2007 before changing to Quad Cities River Bandits in 2008. Quad Cities won Midwest League pennants in 1968, 1971, 1979, 1990, 2011, 2013, and 2017. They were the High-A Central League champions in 2021. Notable alumni of Quad Cities: Carlos Correa, Joe Mauer, Josh Hader, Billy Wagner, Shawon Dunston, Justin Morneau, and Brett Phillips.

ABOUT THE ROYALS: The Kansas City Royals have been Quad Cities' parent club since 2021. They left the Midwest league and an affiliation with Kane County at the end of the 2012 season. The Royals had previously been in the Midwest League with Waterloo from 1969-1976, Appleton (1987-1992), Rockford (1993-94), Springfield (1995), Lansing (1996-1998), Burlington (2001-2010), and Kane County (2011-2012).

PROSPECTING IN THE SERIES: <u>MLB Pipeline</u> puts seven Rattlers on their list of Brewers Top 30 Prospects: Tyler Black (#6), Joe Gray Jr. (#13), Antoine Kelly (#14), Russell Smith (#16), Zavier Warren (#17), Carlos Rodríguez (#21), and Cam Robinson (#26). <u>MLB Pipeline</u> has five current River Bandits on their Top 30 list of Kansas City Royals prospects: Peyton Wilson (#14), Noah Murdock (#23), Luca Tresh (#26), Tyler Gentry (#27), and Christian Chamberlain (#30).

# WISCONSIN STARTING PITCHER:

**LHP BRANDON KNARR:** The Brewers signed Knarr as a non-drafted free agent out of the University of Tampa on July 17, 2020.

**GOLDEN DOME:** Knarr pitched at Notre Dame as a freshman and appeared in twelve games.

**TO FLORIDA:** Knarr spent his sophomore season at the College of Central Florida. He was 6-1 with 86 strikeouts and an ERA of 4.66 over 65-2/3 innings in sixteen games – thirteen starts.

**TAMPA, TOO:** Knarr transferred to the University of Tampa for the 2019-2020 season and was 4-1 with 64 strikeouts and a 2.55 ERA over 35-1/3 innings pitched in six starts before the shutdown.

**IN THE MUD:** Knarr started the 2021 season with the Carolina Mudcats. He was 7-2 with 103 strikeouts over 75 innings and an ERA of 3.84 in sixteen games – thirteen starts – before his promotion to Wisconsin on August 17.

**AS A RATTLER LAST YEAR:** Knarr made five starts with Wisconsin at the end of the 2021 season. He went 1-1 with fourteen walks, 25 strikeouts, and fifteen earned runs allowed over 22-1/3 innings.

**LAST START:** Knarr was the winning pitcher at Quad Cities on May 10 in game one of this series. He allowed two runs on five hits with a walk and five strikeouts over five innings.

VS. QUAD CITIES (2022): Knarr also <u>beat Quad Cities on April 23 at home</u>. He allowed two runs on five hits, including two solo home runs, with a walk and seven strikeouts over 5-2/3 innings.

#### QUAD CITIES STARTING PITCHER:

RHP ANDERSON PAULINO: The Royals signed Paulino as an International Free Agent on August 22, 2017 out of the Dominican Republic.

**ON THE ISLAND:** Paulino made his professional debut in the Dominican Summer League in 2018 and was 1-3 with a 7.47 ERA over eight games – two starts. He walked eleven and struck out eleven in 15-2/3 innings.

**SURPRISE:** Paulino was in the Arizona League in 2019 and was 3-0 with a 4.90 ERA in fourteen games – ten starts. He walked 24 and struck out 44 in 60-2/3 innings for the AZL Royals.

COLUMBIA TO DAVENPORT: Paulino appeared in 21 games – eleven starts – for the Columbia Fireflies last season before a bump up to Quad Cities where he appeared in three games – one start. Paulino was 7-7 with a 4.57 ERA and 86 strikeouts over 86-2/3 innings pitched in 2021. He went 1-1 for the River Bandits. Paulino also made one playoff appearance for Quad Cities last year and worked two scoreless innings against Cedar Rapids in the High-A Central League Championship Series.

LAST APPEARANCE: Paulino lost to the <u>Timber Rattlers in a relief role on May 11 at home</u>. He allowed a run on two hits over three innings with a walk and no strikeouts.

**LAST START:** Paulino lost <u>at Cedar Rapids on May 5</u>. He allowed four runs – three earned – on six hits with a walk and two strikeouts over 3-1/3 innings.

VS. WISCONSIN (2022): Paulino is 0-2 in two appearances – one start – against the Rattlers this season. He was the starting pitcher in game two of a doubleheader on April 23 at Wisconsin and the reliever on May 11. He has allowed six runs on eleven hits with one walk and three strikeouts over 7-1/3 innings versus Wisconsin this year.
