ABOUT LAST NIGHT: The West Michigan Whitecaps beat the Wisconsin Timber Rattlers 5-0 at LMCU Ballpark. Keider Montero and four West Michigan relievers held Wisconsin to just two hits in the game. Last night was the eleventh shutout of the season for West Michigan pitchers. It was also the tenth time the Rattlers were shutout this season, including the third time on this road trip. IN THE HIT COLUMN: Zavier Warren and Ethan Murray had back-to-back RBI singles in the top of the fifth inning for Wisconsin's hits. Montero had retired the first fourteen Rattlers he faced in the game until Warren's hit

**LEADING OFF:** West Michigan put their leadoff batter aboard in four innings last night and that leadoff batter scored in all four innings. Wisconsin only put their leadoff batter on base one time in the game.

WHO DID THE DAMAGE? Trei Cruz, Austin Murr, and Jake Holton – the top three hitters in the West Michigan lineup last night – each had two hits. Cruz scored two runs. Murr and Holton both scored a run with Holton driving in a run. Bryant Packard, the cleanup hitter for the Whitecaps, drove in two runs.

ON SECOND THOUGHT: The Rattlers did not have a runner reach third base last night. They had just two runners make it to second. Wisconsin had a total of six base runners with two hits and four walks.

**RUNNING INTO A HOT TEAM:** The Whitecaps were 8-17 after a home loss to Lansing on May 6. They are 37-23 since May 7, including 8-2 in their last ten games.

IN CONTROL: Wisconsin pitchers combined for just one walk last night. Starting pitcher Justin Bullock issued a free pass over five innings. Zach Mort pitched three innings of relief without allowing a walk.

**ERROR-FREE:** Wisconsin did not commit an error last night. It was their 41<sup>st</sup> game without an error this season.

ABOUT WEST MICHIGAN: The West Michigan Whitecaps joined the Midwest League in 1994 when the Madison Muskies moved to Grand Rapids, Michigan following the 1993 season. The Whitecaps started play in the league as an affiliate of the Oakland Athletics. They became Low-A affiliate of the Detroit Tigers for the 1997 season. The Whitecaps won six Midwest League Pennants (1996, 1998, 2004, 2006, 2007, and 2015) before getting the bump up to the High-A Affiliate of the Tigers going into the 2021 season. Notable former Whitecaps include Nick Castellanos, Joel Zumaya, Fernando Rodney, Brandon Inge, and Cameron Maybin.

**ABOUT THE TIGERS:** Detroit has been affiliated with the Whitecaps since 1997. The Tigers had just one other stint in the Midwest League prior to their current partnership. They were with the Clinton Pilots from 1971 through 1975.

THE SEASON SO FAR: West Michigan finished the first half 31-35 in fourth place in the Eastern Division. They are coming into this series with Wisconsin after going 5-1 in a six-game series at Dayton. The Whitecaps are the first-place team in the Eastern Division and have a two-game lead over Great Lakes, the first half champions in the Eastern Division.

PROSPECTING IN THE SERIES: MLB Pipeline puts five active Rattlers on their list of Brewers Top 30 Prospects: Tyler Black (#7), Joe Gray Jr. (#13), Antoine Kelly (#14), Russell Smith (#16), and Zavier Warren (#17). Carlos Rodríguez (#21) is on the Wisconsin injured list. MLB Pipeline has three members of the Whitecaps roster on their list of Top 30 Prospects in the Detroit system: Ty Madden (#5), Keider Montero (#25), and Brant Hurter (#29). Dylan Smith (#8) and Colt Keith (#12) are on the IL.

# PITCHING MATCHUP

#### WISCONSIN SCHEDULED STARTING PITCHER:

RHP JUSTIN JARVIS: Selected by Milwaukee in the 5<sup>th</sup> round of the 2018 draft out of Lake Norman High School in Mooresville, North Carolina.

**THE SENIOR SEASON:** In his final season of high school, Jarvis was 8-2 with a 1.60ERA, and 95 strikeouts. Former Major Leaguer Ty Wigginton was his head coach.

A PERFECT DAY: Jarvis pitched a perfect game with 18 strikeouts in a game against East Rowan High School early in his senior season of high school.

**NOT ON CAMPUS:** Jarvis signed with the Brewers over a commitment to UNC-Wilmington.

**YEAR ONE:** Jarvis was 1-2 with a 6.63ERA in ten games – three starts – for Milwaukee's Arizona League affiliate after signing with Milwaukee. He walked four and struck out 18 over 19 innings pitched in the Arizona League.

**2019**: Jarvis was 4-1 with a 3.50 ERA in 18 games – eleven starts – for the Timber Rattlers in 2019. He had 52 strikeouts over 74-2/3 innings.

**2021**: Jarvis was 1-7 with a 5.40 ERA in seventeen starts for the Timber Rattlers in 2021. He had 62 strikeouts over 63-1/3 innings.

**LAST START:** Jarvis <u>lost at South Bend on July 10</u>. He four runs on seven hits with no walks and five strikeouts. Jarvis allowed two solo homers in the first inning of the game.

VS. WEST MICHIGAN (2021): Jarvis lost twice in two starts – May 18 and May 23 – against the Whitecaps in Wisconsin last season. He allowed three runs on nine hits with three walks and seven strikeouts over eight innings in the two starts.

#### WEST MICHIGAN SCHEDULED STARTING PITCHER:

**LHP BRANT HURTER:** The Tigers selected Hurter in the  $7^{\text{th}}$  round of the 2021 draft out of Georgia Tech.

**RAMBLIN' WRECK:** Hurter pitched three seasons at Georgia Tech. He was 7-6 in 24 games – 20 starts – in his first two seasons. Hurter missed the 2020 season with an injury and returned for the 2021 season to go 5-4 with a 3.90 ERA in fifteen starts. He had a career 4.13 ERA with 197 strikeouts over 187-1/3 innings pitched with the Yellowjackets.

NO GO AS A PRO: Hurter did not pitch professionally in 2021.

**FLYING TIGER:** Hurter made his professional debut with Lakeland in the Florida State League to start the 2022 season. He was 3-3 with a 2.98 ERA in ten games – six starts. Hurter had 57 strikeouts and six walks over 42-1/3 innings with Lakeland before his promotion to West Michigan on June 13

**MICHIGANDER:** Hurter is 2-0 in five starts with the Whitecaps. He has 26 strikeouts and five walks in 23 innings pitched.

**HOW DOES HE RATE?** MLB Pipeline places Hurter as the #29 prospect in the Tigers system. *Baseball America* has Hurter at #25 on their list to Top 30 prospects in the Tigers system.

**LAST START:** Hurter <u>won at Dayton on July 10</u>. He allowed a run on three hits with a walk and five strikeouts over 5-1/3 innings.

**VS. WISCONSIN:** Hurter has never faced the Timber Rattlers prior to this evening. This is also the first time he will pitch against an affiliate of the Milwaukee Brewers.
