TODAY'S GAME: The Fayetteville Woodpeckers (Low-A Astros) continue the first ever six-game series against the Delmarva Shorebirds (Single-A Orioles). The Woodpeckers currently lead the series 2-1 following a 15-5 win on Wednesday night. Today, RHP Zack Matthews will start for Fayetteville and RHP Moises Chance will get the ball for

THE OPPONENTS: The Shorebirds are in their second season as a member of the Carolina League after being a part of the Class A South Atlantic League from 1996 to 2020, winning titles in 1997 and 2000. After a brief affiliation with the Montreal Expos in 1996, the Shorebirds have been an affiliate of the Orioles since the 1997 season. They play their home games at Arthur W. Perdue Stadium which opened in 1996 and seats 5,200 fans. In 2021, the Shorebirds finished with an overall record of 68-52 and in second place in the Low-A East North Division.

HISTORIC 5-HIT NIGHT: On Thursday night against Delmarva, Joey Loperfido finished 5-for-6 with a 2B, 3B, 3 R, and 3 RBI, becoming the first Fayetteville hitter with a five-hit game in franchise history. He is the fifth player this season in the Carolina League with a five-hit game. Delmarva's Isaac Bellony also accomplished the feat on 5/29/22 @ CSC. No Woodpeckers hitter had a five-hit game during the 2021 season or the 2019 season. On top of that, no player during the Buies Creek Astros era in 2017 and 2018 had a five-hit game.

THE PROSPECTS: The Woodpeckers are currently carrying three of the Astros Top-30 Prospects on their active roster. Outfielder Tyler Whitaker, Houston's third round pick in 2021, has climbed to #6 in the organizational rankings per MLB.com. RHP Alex Santos is not far behind as he is the eighth-best prospect in the system. Outfielder Logan Cerny also finds himself in the top 30 at #28.

SLUGGERS OF THE CAROLINAS: Over the first 54 games of the regular season, the Woodpeckers lead the Carolina League with 57 long-balls, averaging over a home run per game. 24 of Fayetteville's homers have been hit at Segra Stadium compared to 33 on the road, the most road homers of any team in the league. In May, the Woodpeckers hit 27 home runs and are currently on pace to shatter that mark in June with 11 round-trippers in nine games. Fayetteville has also taken advantage of the long ball with runners on base, hitting 28 multi-run home runs compared to 29 solo home runs.

SURGING CERNY: Outfielder Logan Cerny has picked it up at the plate in late May and early June. In Tuesday's series opener, Cerny hit his eighth HR of the season and finished 3-for-5 with 3 RBI. He followed it up on Thursday with the first 5 RBI game from any Fayetteville player this season. Across the last ten games played, he is 17-for-39 (.436 AVG) with 4 HR, 3B, 3 2B, 17 RBI, 6 BB, 9 K. Since May 27th, Cerny has raised his overall batting average from .175 to .231 and overall OPS from .629 to .791

GOOD WITH THE BAD: The Woodpeckers pitching staff has issued a Carolina League-high 311 walks so far in 2022. However, they have made up for it by missing bats as Fayetteville has struck out the most batters in the league with 603. Additionally, in the month of May, the Woodpeckers allowed the fewest hits (169) in the league and had the fourth-lowest earned run average of the month at 3.60, compared to a 4.99 ERA in April.

CORONA, FIND YOUR SWING: Kenedy Corona has broken out to one of the best offensive stretches of his career over the last three series. Since May 16th in a span of 19 games, Corona is slashing .329/.386/.671 with 6 2B, 7 HR, 20 RBI and 20 R. His 9 HR on the season are tied with Logan Cerny for the team lead and tied for second in the Carolina League with DJ Gladney of Kannapolis. During the 2021 season Corona only had 2 HR and 22 RBI over 57 games and batted .257.

MOST LEADS ARE SAFE: Fayetteville has done an exceptional job maintaining leads down the stretch in games this season. The Woodpeckers are 20-2 when leading after seven innings and 23-1 when taking a lead into the ninth inning. However, on the flip side, Fayetteville has never won a game in which they have trailed after seven innings with an 0-21 record in that situation. Extra innings also have not been kind to the Woodpeckers, who are 1-5 in games that have gone past nine innings, but they did pick up their first extra-innings victory on May 26 in a 5-3 road win against the Down East Wood Ducks.

Miguel Ullola struck out a season-high seven hitters while Kasey Ford closed the game with 2.2 scoreless innings of relief work. The Woodpeckers as a team also scored eight runs in the eight inning, tied for the most runs in a single inning this year.

15 Joe Thon Manager Vincent Blue

Thon makes his return to Fayetteville and begins his first season as Woodpeckers manager after serving as a development coach in 2021. As the development coach, Thon helped coach Woodpeckers hitters and fielders, as well as assist with lineup planning and creating reports on individual athletes on the team.

Prior to joining the Astros as a full-time coach, Thon served as a summer intern with the organization during the 2019 summer. He helped analyze and balance revenue summaries, verified accounts for reconciling payments and processed and organized invoices for the Astros and Astros Foundation.

Following his intership, Thon broke into the coaching ranks by joining the University of Houston Baseball program in August 2019 as a student assistant coach before becoming the volunteer assistant prior to the 2020 season. After one season with UofH, Thon returned to the Astros in a full-time coaching role.

The former Minor League infielder enjoyed a seven-year minor league playing career. Thon was drafted in the 5th round (pick 156) by the Toronto Blue Jays in 2010 out of Academia Perpetuo Socorro in San Juan, Puerto Rico. He played in the Blue Jays organizationuntil 2016 when he signed to join the St. Louis Cardinals. Thon played in the Cardinals farm system through 2017, reaching as Double-A with the Springfield Cardinals. His playing career concluded in 2017 in the Independent Atlanta League with the Sugar Land Skeeters, now the Triple-A Affiliate of the Astros. In total, Thon appeared in over 500 games across his MiLB career, posting a .243/.356/.318 slash line with 79 doubles, 17 triples, 27 home-runs and 178 RBI. Thon also played for Liga de Beisbol Professional Roberto Clemente in Puerto Rico from 2010 through December 2016.

Thon comes from a deep baseball background. He is the son of former Astros shortstop Dickie Thon, a 1983 All-Star with Houston who enjoyed a 15-year MLB career with the California Angels, Astros, Padres, Phillies, Rangers and Brewers. Joe and his fiance Erika spend their offseason living in Houston with their dogs.

23 Jose Puentes Hitting Coach

Joining the Woodpeckers for his first season with the franchise and third season in the Astros organization is hitting coach Jose Puentes.

Puentes started his career with the Astros as a hitting coach in the Dominican Summer League and most recently served as hitting coach with the Florida Complex League Astros in 2021.

He has coached at the high school level at MacArthur High School, Johnson High School, Steele High School and Wagner High School. From 2006-2007, he was the head baseball coach at St. Anthony Catholic High School. Puentes has owned and operated two hitting academies, Gap to Gap Academy and Cardinals Select Baseball Academy.

He earned his bachelor's degree in Spanish and Master's degree in teaching from University of Incarnate Word along with a Master's degree in education from the University of Texas at San Antonio.

16 John Kovalik Pitching Coach

John Kovalik takes over as the third pitching coach in Woodpeckers history, bringing three years of coaching experience to the Woodpeckers staff. The 30-year-old enters his fourth season in the Astros organization after serving as the pitching coach for the Tri-City Valley Cats in 2019, along with the pitching coach for the Florida Complex League Astros in 2021. While with the Valley Cats, Kovalik coached Astros farmhands and future big leaguers Luis Garcia, Jose Urquidy and Shawn Dubin along with other high-level pitching prospects.

Prior to his time with the Astros, Kovalik spent three seasons as pitching coach (2016-2018) at Slippery Rock University, where he oversaw all aspects of the team's pitching program.

Kovalik earned his bachelor's degree from Slippery Rock, where he also pitched for the baseball team. Following his college career he played four seasons in the Independent leagues for the Frontier Greys and the Gary-Southshore Railcats.
