WEDNESDAY AFTERNOON: [The Great Lakes Loons beat the Wisconsin Timber Rattlers 9-8 at Neuroscience Group Field.](https://www.wisconsinrattlers.com/news/the-great-lakes-loons-beat-the-wisconsin-timber-rattlers-9-8-at-neuroscience-group-field)

Noah Miller homered twice to help the Loons build an 8-0 lead after the top of the sixth inning. Wisconsin stormed back with two runs in the sixth and five runs in the seventh to get to within 8-7. Great Lakes added a run in the top of the eighth on an RBI single by Dylan Campbell. Terence Doston hit a two-out solo homer in the bottom of the ninth and the Rattlers got the winning run to the plate. However, Great Lakes got the final out on a force play at second and held on for their eighth straight win. Miller is 6-for-10 with three homers and six RBI in this series.

DEFICIT SPENDING: The Loons scored in each of the first six innings of the game to go up 8-0. Miller had a two-run homer in the first. Alex Freeland had an RBI double in the second. Chris Newell homered in the third. An error in the fourth let in one run and an error on a fielder's choice let in two runs in the fifth. Miller cracked another homer in the sixth. Jared Karros was the starting pitcher for Great Lakes, and he tossed five scoreless innings before the Loons bullpen took over.

ON THE COMEBACK TRAIL: Luke Adams had an RBI single in the bottom of the sixth. A run scored on a wild pitch scored the second run. The Timber Rattlers had two outs and a runner at first in the seventh inning when the next seven Rattlers reached base and they cut the lead to one run. The Rattlers left the bases loaded in the seventh.

SIX PACK: Gregory Barrios was 1-for-4 yesterday to move his hitting streak to six games. He is 9-for-23 during the streak to match the longest hitting streak by a Rattler this season.

KING OF TRIOS: Jadher Areinamo had three hits and a walk yesterday. Areinamo had two three-hit games and six multi-hit games in 2024.

STAY HOT: Doston was 2-for-5 with two RBI on Wednesday. He is on a five-game hitting streak (9-for-20).

ABOUT GREAT LAKES: The Great Lakes Loons came into existence in 2007 after the Midwest League team left Battle Creek, Michigan at the end of the 2006 season. The team in Battle Creek had been known as the Michigan Battle Cats, Battle Creek Yankees, and the Southwest Michigan Devil Rays. The Loons have been affiliated with the Los Angeles Dodgers since 2007. They have made the Midwest League playoffs nine times since 2007. The Loons won the Midwest League title in 2016 and lost to Cedar Rapids in the Midwest League Championship Series in 2023. Notable Great Lakes alumni include Clayton Kershaw, Kenley Jansen, Nathan Eovaldi, Joc Peterson, Julio Urias, Walker Buehler, and Gavin Lux. Jair Fernandez, who played in 52 games with the Timber Rattlers in 2007, is the manager of the Loons in 2024.

ABOUT THE DODGERS: The Los Angeles Dodgers were only in the Midwest League for a few seasons prior to affiliating with the Loons. They were in Dubuque in 1967 and in Clinton from 1977 to 1979. Orel Hershiser and Steve Sax were notable Dodgers to play in Clinton.

PROSPECTING IN THE SERIES: [MLB Pipeline](https://www.mlb.com/pipeline) places five active Rattlers on their list of Brewers Top 30 Prospects: Luis Lara (#8), Luke Adams (#15), Dylan O'Rae (#20), Jadher Areinamo (#22), and Patricio Aquino (#28). [MLB Pipeline](https://www.mlb.com/pipeline) has five Great Lakes players on their list of Top 30 Dodgers prospects: Jackson Ferris (#7), Thayron Liranzo (#9), Maddux Bruns (#14), Noah Miller (#26), and Peter Heubeck (#30).

THE SEASON SO FAR: The Loons completed a six-game sweep at Fort Wayne on April 28. They are 16-7 and are the top team in the East Division. Great Lakes had not faced a team from the West before this series.

PITCHING MATCHUP

WISCONSIN STARTING PITCHER:

RHP WILL RUDY: The Milwaukee Brewers selected Rudy in the 5th round of the 2022 draft out of the California Polytechnic State University, Pomona.

WHAT A SEASON: Rudy was at Cal Poly Pomona for three seasons but had just one full season due to COVID-19 abbreviating 2020 and canceling the 2021 season for the Broncos. In 2022, which was still his freshman season, Rudy went 8-1 with a 3.10 ERA over thirteen starts. He walked fifteen and struck out 96 in 87 innings pitched during that season.

TROPHY ROOM: Rudy was a three-time Pitcher of the Week in the California Collegiate Athletic Association, two-time National Collegiate Baseball Writers Association West Region Pitcher of the Week, a First Team All-CCAA selection, and the CCAA's Most Valuable pitcher last season.

OUR OLD FRIEND FROM POMONA: Rudy was the highest draft selection of a Poly Pomona player since Cody Ponce was picked 55th overall in the 2015 draft. The Brewers also picked Ponce, who pitched for the Timber Rattlers right after the 2015 draft.

THE CAPE: Rudy made one start for Yarmouth-Dennis in the Cape Cod League in 2022 before the draft. He did not pitch in the Brewers system until 2023.

THE MUDCAT: Rudy was 5-3 in eighteen starts for Carolina in 2023 for his professional debut. Rudy had a 3.46 ERA, 26 walks, and 69 strikeouts over 80-2/3 innings.

LAST START: Rudy had a no decision at Peoria on [April 25](#). He allowed three runs on six hits with no walks and six strikeouts over five innings. The Timber Rattlers broke a 3-3 tie with two runs in the seventh for a 5-3 victory.

VS. GREAT LAKES: Rudy has never faced the Great Lakes Loons prior to this evening. This is the first time he will face an affiliate of the Los Angeles Dodgers.

GREAT LAKES STARTING PITCHER:

RHP PETER HEUBECK: The Los Angeles Dodgers selected Heubeck in the third round of the 2021 draft out of Gilman High School in Baltimore, Maryland.

DON'T GO INTO THE FOREST: Heubeck signed with the Dodgers over a commitment to Wake Forest University.

THE RANKINGS: MLB Pipeline places Heubeck at the #30 spot in their list of Top Dodgers Prospects. The *2024 Baseball America Prospect Handbook* rated him at #27 prior to the start of the season.

REPEATING THE LEVEL: Heubeck made a brief pro debut with the Dodgers Arizona Complex League team with two appearances in 2021. He began the 2022 season at Rancho Cucamonga in the California League. He was 0-1 with a 7.39 ERA in fifteen games – thirteen starts – and walked 25 with 42 strikeouts over 31-2/3 innings. Heubeck started the 2023 back in Rancho Cucamonga and went 3-5 with a 5.11 ERA in nineteen starts with 91 strikeouts over 68-2/3 innings before a promotion to Great Lakes on August 4, 2023.

AS A LOON: Heubeck was 2-2 with an 8.47 ERA in six games – five starts – for the Loons in the regular season at the end of 2023. Heubeck also made two relief appearances without a decision in the 2023 Midwest League Playoffs for the Loons.

LAST START: Heubeck had a no decision at Fort Wayne on [April 26](#). He allowed three hits, walked one, and struck out eight over four scoreless innings against the TinCaps in that game.

VS. WISCONSIN: Heubeck has never pitched against the Timber Rattlers prior to this evening. This is also the first time he will pitch against an affiliate of the Milwaukee Brewers.
