ABOUT LAST NIGHT: The Cedar Rapids Kernels beat the Wisconsin Timber Rattlers 6-5 at Neuroscience Group Field at Fox Cities Stadium. Both teams scored two runs in the first inning. The Kernels scored two runs in the second and two runs in the third to take a 6-2 lead. The Rattlers rallied to within a run but fell just short in their comeback attempt.

KING OF TRIOS: Mike Boeve went 3-for-3 with a double, a walk, two runs scored, and an RBI for Wisconsin last night. Boeve has eight multi-hit games and three three-hit games this season. Milwaukee's second round pick of the 2023 draft is 19-for-36 (.528) this season. He has also walked twelve times in twelve games for an on base percentage of .620. Boeve leads all classifications of baseball - including MLB - in both average and on base percentage.

DOUBLE TROUBLE: Dylan O'Rae and Gregory Barrios both had two doubles last night. Barrios has four doubles and is 6-for-10 in the first three games of this series with Cedar Rapids.

THE RULE OF EIGHT: Reliever Mark Manfredi pitched four scoreless innings for the Timber Rattlers last night. He struck out the first six batters he faced. Manfredi had eight strikeouts in the game. The only base runner he allowed was a one-out single in the top of the eighth. FORE! Eduarqui Fernández, Luis Lara, and O'Rae all extended their current hitting streaks to four games last night. Fernández is 4-for-15, Lara is 6-for-14, and O'Rae is 6-for-17. These are their longest hitting streaks of the season.

## NEVER STOP FIGHTING UNTIL THE FIGHT IS **DONE:** Wisconsin scored twice in the fourth inning to pull to within 6-4 on an RBI grounder by Matt Wood and a sacrifice fly by Jadher Areinamo. Lara knocked in a run in the seventh with another sacrifice fly to cut the deficit to a single run, but the Rattlers could not make it all the way back.

ABOUT CEDAR RAPIDS: The current franchise began its existence in 1949 as the Cedar Rapids Rockets, an unaffiliated team in the Central Association. They moved to the Three-I League as the Cedar Rapids Indians as an affiliate of Cleveland in 1950. They were affiliated with the Milwaukee Braves from 1954 through 1962. Cedar Rapids has been called the Braves, Red Raiders, Cardinals, Astros, Giants, and Reds until they became the Kernels in 1993. That was the same year the California Angels became the parent club of the Kernels. That affiliation remained through the 2012 season. Cedar Rapids has been affiliated with the Minnesota Twins since 2013. The Kernels have made the Midwest League playoffs every year they have been affiliated with the Twins, including a Midwest League Championship last season. Notable alumni include Mike Trout, Byron Buxton, Trevor Hoffman, Brewers Pitching Coach Chris Hook, and Ted Simmons. Hall of Famers John McGraw (1891 Canaries) and Lou Boudreau (1938 Raiders) played for earlier pro teams in Cedar Rapids

ABOUT THE TWINS: Minnesota has a long history of in the Midwest League. They started out with Wisconsin Rapids (1964-1983) and moved to Kenosha (1984-1992) and to Fort Wayne (1993-1998) as the franchise moved. Minnesota has also been with Quad Cities (1999-2004) and Beloit (2005-2012) before their current affiliation with Cedar Rapids Kernels started in 2013.

PROSPECTING IN THE SERIES: MLB Pipeline places six active Rattlers on their list of Brewers Top 30 Prospects: Luis Lara (#9), Mike Boeve (#15), Luke Adams (#16), Dylan O'Rae (#21), Jadher Areinamo (#23), and Patricio Aquino (#29). MLB Pipeline has eight active Kernels on their list of Minnesota prospects: Gabriel Gonzalez (#4), CJ Culpepper (#8), Luke Keaschall (#9), Danny DeAndrade (#14), Andrew Morris (#18), Zebby Matthews (#20), Ricardo Olivar (#22), and Darren Bowen (#29). Connor Prelipp (#17) is currently on the IL.

THAT CHAMPIONSHIP SEASON: Cedar Rapids is the reigning Midwest League Champion. The Kernels beat the Peoria Chiefs in Game Three of the best-of-three Western Division Finals and the Great Lakes Loons in Game Three of the best-of-three Championship Series to claim their first Midwest League pennant since 1994. The Kernels were 82-50 during the 2023 regular season to finish last year with the best record in the Midwest League.

# PITCHING MATCHUP

#### WISCONSIN STARTING PITCHER:

RHP BRETT WICHROWSKI: The Milwaukee Brewers selected Wichrowski in the thirteenth round of the 2023 draft out of Bryant (RI) University.

**BULLDOG:** Wichrowski was 7-5 with a save and 109 strikeouts over 92-2/3 innings in 32 appearances – 15 starts – over three seasons at Bryant. In his final season, he was 5-3 with a save, a 4.50 ERA, and 64 strikeouts over 50 innings.

THE LIFE OF BRYANT: There have been two former Bulldogs who made the major leagues. Keith MacWhorter, who pitched in 14 games for the Boston Red Sox in 1980, and James Karinchak, who has pitched in 174 games with fifteen saves for the Cleveland Guardians from 2019 through 2023. Wichrowski is one of two Bryant pitchers to be drafted in 2023. Coleman Picard was selected in the sixth round by the Kansas City Royals.

**IN THE SUMMER TIME:** Wichrowski pitched for Orleans in the Cape Cod League in 2021, Mystic in the New England Collegiate Baseball League in 2022, and with Wareham in the Cape Cod League in 2023.

**DEBUTING IN THE POSTSEASON:** Wichrowski did not pitch in the regular season after signing with Milwaukee. He made his pro debut with a scoreless, hitless second inning against the ACL Rockies in the Arizona Complex League Semifinal Game on August 24, 2023. He did not have a walk or a strikeout in the inning.

**SPRING HAS SPRUNG:** Wichrowski worked a scoreless inning against the Chicago White Sox in a Cactus League game on March 7, 2024. He had a strikeout with no walks or hits.

**LAST START:** Wichrowski had a no decision in game one of a doubleheader at South Bend on April 19. He allowed three hits, walked none, and struck out five over four scoreless innings.

VS. CEDAR RAPIDS: Tonight is the first time Wichrowski will pitch against the Kernels. This is also the first time he will pitch against an affiliate of the Minnesota Twins.

#### CEDAR RAPIDS STARTING PITCHER:

RHP MIGUELANGEL BOADAS: The Minnesota Twins signed Boadas as an International Free Agent out of Venezuela on July 2, 2019.

A DOMINICAN SUMMER: Boadas made his professional debut with Minnesota's Dominican Summer League affiliate in 2021. He had no record with a 3.63 ERA in twelve games – three starts – and walked eight with 34 strikeouts over 34-2/3 innings pitched.

IT'S COMPLEX: Boadas spent the 2022 season with the Florida Complex League Twins and went 3-2 with two saves and a 5.53 ERA in twelve relief appearances. Boadas walked nine and struck out 25 in 27-2/3 innings.

**SAME LOCATION, DIFFERENT LEVEL:** Boadas was with the Fort Myers Mighty Mussels in 2023 and made eleven starts for Minnesota's Florida State League affiliate. He was 0-2 with a 7.75 ERA. Boadas walked 24 and struck out 35 over 36 innings pitched for the Mighty Mussels.

**LAST APPEARANCE:** Boadas picked up the win in relief <u>against</u> <u>Dayton at home on April 13</u>. He allowed two hits, walked none, and had a strikeout over three scoreless innings.

**LAST START:** Boadas made the start against Bradenton on September 7, 2023. He allowed two runs on two hits with six walks and four strikeouts over 3-1/3 innings for a no decision.

**VS. WISCONSIN:** Boadas has never faced the Timber Rattlers prior to this evening. Tonight is also the first time he will pitch against an affiliate of the Milwaukee Brewers.
