GAME ONE: [The Wisconsin Timber Rattlers beat the River Bandits 1-0](#) on Tuesday night at Modern Woodmen Park to take a 1-0 series lead. Jadhre Areinamo hit a lead-off home run in the fifth inning for Wisconsin's only hit off Quad Cities starting pitcher Ryan Ramsey. The Rattlers were held to two hits in the game. Alexander Cornielle, Mark Manfredi, and Tyler Bryant combined on the five-hit shutout.

BREAK IT DOWN: Cornielle allowed two hits, walked four, and struck out five over 5-2/3 scoreless innings. Manfredi allowed two hits, walked two, and struck out two over 2-1/3 scoreless innings. Bryant pitched a scoreless ninth inning with a hit and a strikeout.

THAT NINTH INNING THOUGH: Dustin Dickerson doubled to start the bottom of the ninth. Sam Kulasingam just missed a home run to right for a flyout that moved Dickerson to third with the tying run. Shortstop Cooper Pratt made a diving catch of a liner off the bat of Omar Hernandez for the second out. Bryant rallied from a 3-1 count to strike out Justin Johnson to end the game.

IT HAS HAPPENED BEFORE: The last time the Timber Rattlers won a playoff game 1-0 was in Game Three of the Midwest League Championship Series against the South Bend Silver Hawks on September 15, 2005. Robert Rohrbaugh pitched eight scoreless innings, Chris Colton drew a bases loaded walk with two outs in the bottom of the eighth, and Stephen Kahn worked a scoreless ninth to close out the game.

BREAKING SOME STREAKS: Wisconsin last playoff win before Tuesday as September 16, 2012 in Game Four of the Championship Series at Fort Wayne. The Rattlers had been swept in their last two playoff appearances. Tuesday's win in Game One of a First Round series was the first by the Rattlers since 2001 when they beat Quad Cities at home. That win was also, Wisconsin's first road win in Game One of a First Round series since September 7, 1999 at Rockford.

ABOUT QUAD CITIES: The River Bandits are the Midwest League affiliate of the Kansas City Royals. The current version of Davenport Professional Baseball club started in 1960 as the Midwest League affiliate of the Milwaukee Braves. Quad Cities has affiliated with several MLB teams: The California Angels (1962-1978 and 1985-1992), the Chicago Cubs (1979-1984), the Houston Astros (1993-1998 and 2013-2019), the Minnesota Twins (1999-2004), and the St. Louis Cardinals (2005-2012). The team became the Quad City River Bandits in 1992. They changed their name to the Swing of the Quad Cities from 2004 through 2007 before changing to Quad Cities River Bandits in 2008. Quad Cities won Midwest League pennants in 1968, 1971, 1979, 1990, 2011, 2013, and 2017. They were the High-A Central League champions in 2021. Notable alumni of Quad Cities: Carlos Correa, Joe Mauer, Josh Hader, Billy Wagner, Shawon Dunston, Justin Morneau, and Brett Phillips.

ABOUT THE ROYALS: The Kansas City Royals have been Quad Cities' parent club since 2021. They left the Midwest league and an affiliation with Kane County at the end of the 2012 season. The Royals had previously been in the Midwest League with Waterloo (1969-1976), Appleton (1987-1992), Rockford (1993-94), Springfield (1995), Lansing (1996-1998), Burlington (2001-2010), and Kane County (2011-2012).

WISCONSIN STARTING PITCHER:

RHP WILL RUDY: The Milwaukee Brewers selected Rudy in the fifth round of the 2022 draft out of the California Polytechnic State University, Pomona.

WHAT A SEASON: Rudy was at Cal Poly Pomona for three seasons but had just one full season due to COVID-19 abbreviating 2020 and canceling the 2021 season for the Broncos. In 2022, which was still his freshman season, Rudy went 8-1 with a 3.10 ERA over thirteen starts. He walked fifteen and struck out 96 in 87 innings pitched during that season.

TROPHY ROOM: Rudy was a three-time Pitcher of the Week in the California Collegiate Athletic Association, two-time National Collegiate Baseball Writers Association West Region Pitcher of the Week, a First Team All-CCAA selection, and the CCAA's Most Valuable pitcher last season.

OUR OLD FRIEND FROM POMONA: Rudy was the highest draft selection of a Poly Pomona player since Cody Ponce was picked 55th overall in the 2015 draft. The Brewers also picked Ponce, who pitched for the Timber Rattlers right after the 2015 draft.

THE CAPE: Rudy made one start for Yarmouth-Dennis in the Cape Cod League in 2022 before the draft. He did not pitch in the Brewers system until 2023.

THE MUDCAT: Rudy was 5-3 in eighteen starts for Carolina in 2023 for his professional debut. Rudy had a 3.46 ERA, 26 walks, and 69 strikeouts over 80-2/3 innings.

LAST START: Rudy won at Cedar Rapids on [September 6](#). He allowed five hits, walked three, and struck out seven over six scoreless innings.

VS. QUAD CITIES: Rudy is 1-3 in four starts against the River Bandits this season. He has allowed seventeen runs on 21 hits with eleven walks and seventeen strikeouts over 17-1/3 innings in those four starts. Quad Cities has hit four homers off Rudy this season.

QUAD CITIES STARTING PITCHER:

RHP ETHAN BOSACKER: The Kansas City Royals selected Bosacker in the 13th round of 2023 draft out of Xavier.

X MARKS THE SPOT: Bosacker was 4-3 with a 3.34 ERA in twelve games – ten starts – for the Musketeers in 2021. He missed the entire 2022 season due to injury and bounced back to go 8-3 with a 3.49 ERA in sixteen starts in 2023. In his final season at Xavier, Bosacker walked 29 and struck out 101 in 98 innings.

APPALACHIAN SUMMER: Bosacker made three starts for Johnson City in the Appalachian League in 2021. He was 0-1 with eleven strikeouts over 6-2/3 innings.

FIREFLIES: Bosacker's pro debut was two brief relief appearances in the ACL in 2023. He began 2024 for Columbia in the Carolina League and was 6-2 with a 2.78 ERA. The Royals promoted Bosacker to Quad Cities on July 9, 2024.

AWARD WINNER: Bosacker was named the Midwest League pitcher of the Month for August. He was 5-0 with a 1.80 ERA in five starts. Bosacker walked five and struck out twenty over 30 innings pitched in August.

LAST START: Bosacker had a no decision against Beloit on [September 5](#) at home. He allowed two runs on four hits with two walks and three strikeouts over five innings.

VS. WISCONSIN: Bosacker is 2-0 in two starts against Wisconsin since joining the River Bandits. He has allowed four runs on nine hits with four walks and five strikeouts over eleven innings against the Rattlers.
