INDY BITS

ABOUT LAST NIGHT: The Indianapolis Indians threatened with a ninth-inning rally but were ultimately vanquished by a three-run seventh from the Memphis Redbirds as they fell, 4-2, on Tuesday night at AutoZone Park. In a 1-1 game, Thomas Harrington entered the seventh inning with just two hits and one earned run allowed but was chased after allowing a single and a walk to lead off the inning. Memphis then strung together four singles off reliever Hunter Stratton to manufacture their game-winning three-run frame. Matt Koperniak opened the scoring for Memphis in the third inning with a solo blast off Harrington. Indianapolis struck back in the sixth when Matt Fraizer reached on a leadoff single, advanced to second on a wild pitch and came around to score on a Billy Cook single. Indy managed to scratch across a run with a fielding error and a trio of singles in the ninth but left the bases loaded to end the game.

SIMON SAYS: Infielder/outfielder Ronny Simon joins the Indians after being claimed by Pittsburgh on June 2. The 25-year-old was designated for assignment by Miami on May 30. The 25-year-old appeared in 19 games for the Marlins this season, hitting .234 (11-for-47) with two doubles, five RBI, seven walks and six runs. He made his major league debut on April 21 vs. Cincinnati, collecting his first major league hit and RBI off Nick Lodolo with a single up the middle. In 177 games between Durham and Jacksonville from 2023-2025, Simon is a career .288 hitter in Triple-A with 39 doubles, six triples, 14 home runs and a .803 OPS.

HARRI STYLES: Thomas Harrington took his sixth loss of the season last night, losing each of his last three starts. He tossed a season-high 6.0 innings with three earned runs, three hits, three walks and five strikeouts. It was Harrington's first quality start with Indy since Sept. 11, 2024, when he tossed 6.2 innings of two-run ball vs. Rochester. He has tossed 5.0-plus innings in five of his last seven starts.

SOMEONE COOKED HERE: Billy Cook posted his eighth multi-hit game of the season last night, going 2-for-5 with one RBI and one stolen base. He owns back-to-back two-hit performances and has a hit in eight of his last 10 games since May 23 at Toledo. In this span, he is hitting .316 (12-for-38 with two doubles, three RBI, three walks, three runs and two stolen bases - including a season-high six-game hitting streak from May 23-29.

FLAVOR FRAIZ: Matt Fraizer continued his hot run since being activated from the development list on May 1, going 2-for-4 with one walk and one run. He has one-plus hit in seven of his last 10 games, with four of those being multi-hit performances. In those 10 games since May 22 (1) at Toledo, he is hitting .344 (11-for-32) with three doubles, one home run, three RBI, six walks, seven runs, two stolen bases and a .967 OPS.

DAZZLING DAURI: The Indians roster still features one major league rehabber, right-hander Dauri Moreta. Moreta was placed on the 60-day injured list on Feb. 16 after undergoing Tommy John surgery and being sidelined for the entire 2024 season. Nearly 14 months after his last professional appearance, the right-hander began a rehab assignment with High-A Bradenton on April 29 and tossed 2.0 scoreless innings in two games. He has since pitched to a 2.79 ERA (3er/9.2ip) with Indy, allowing five hits while striking out 14 across his 11 appearances.

MAY FLOWERS: Winning four of six games last week, the Indians boast a 21-8 record at Victory Field on the campaign. They are tied with Jacksonville for the third most home wins in Triple-A and their .724 home winning percentage trails only Lehigh Valley (20-7, .741) for the best mark in Triple-A. Indy's 14-3 home record (.824) in May was the best home winning percentage in Triple-A. The 14 home wins in the month tied April 2013 for the most home victories in the month since going 15-4 in June of 1997. Since April 16, Indianapolis is 19-4 at home (.824), trailing only Toledo (20-4, .833) for the best home record in Triple-A in this span.

PITCHING PROWESS: In May, Indians pitchers led Triple-A in ERA (3.48, 90er/227.1), strikeouts (283), fewest hits allowed (188), opponent average (.223, 188-for-843), opponent OPS (.670), strikeout-to-walk ratio (3.11) and strikeouts per nine innings (11.20). Their 1.23 WHIP trailed only Toledo (1.21) for the best Triple-A mark in the month. In the month, the bullpen's 1.10 WHIP and .616 opponent OPS led Triple-A while its 2.72 ERA (32er/106.0ip) trailed only Nashville's pen (2.64, 31er/105.2ip).

TONIGHT'S MATCHUP: The Indianapolis Indians continue their six-game series with the Memphis Redbirds tonight at 8:05 PM. After dropping game one of the series, Indy aims for its first win over the Redbirds since April 6, 2024, and first win at Memphis since April 23, 2023. Taking the mound for the Indians is right-hander Carmen Mlodzinski. Since being optioned to Indianapolis on May 21, Mlodzinski has thrown 10.2 scoreless innings, two outs shy of Eddy Yean's team-high streak of 11.2 scoreless innings on the campaign (4/11-5/11). Mlodzinski last tossed 4.2 shutout frames on May 29 vs. Nashville, striking out five. In his first career Triple-A start on May 23 at Toledo, Mlodzinksi tossed 6.0 shutout frames for the first time in his career and struck out a career best 10 batters. He made one career appearance against the Redbirds on April 20, 2023, at Memphis, allowing three unearned runs in 1.0 innings with two hits, one walk and two strikeouts. On the bump for the Redbirds is left-hander Alex Cornwell. Cornwell has lost four consecutive decisions since earning the win in his season debut on April 2 vs. Buffalo. In his last start at Durham on May 29, he allowed seven earned runs in 4.0 innings, surrendering a career-high 11 hits. Tonight is set to be Cornwell's first career start against the Indians.

ON THIS DATE IN 2005: With the game knotted at 6-6 in front of 11,000 fans at Victory Field, Jose Leon launched a two-out, three-run homer to left-center field to give the Indians a 9-6 win over Charlotte. Behind a six-RBI day by Leon, the Indians battled with the Knights, trading a pair of runs in the fourth and four-spots in the sixth to tie the game. Paul Chiaffredo, who entered the game as a defensive replacement, roped a two-run single to tie the game in the sixth

TONIGHT'S PITCHER

Carmen Mlodzinski: Mlodzinski is making his third start with the Indians after being optioned from Pittsburgh on May 21.

Bucco Aboard: In nine starts with Pittsburgh this season, Mlodzinski posted a 1-4 record, 5.67 ERA (25er/39.2ip), 52 hits, 12 walks and 28 strikeouts. He has appeared in 84 games (14 starts) with the Pirates since 2023, posting a 9-12 record, 3.78 ERA (53er/126.1ip), 121 hits, 29 walks, four hit batters and 108 strikeouts.

Indianapolis: Mlodzinski made 15 appearances for the Indians last season, posting an 0-1 record and a 6.75 ERA (13er/17.1ip), pitching exclusively from the bullpen. In 38 career games with Indy, he is 3-4 with a 3.65 ERA (23er/56.2ip) with 58 hits, 27 walks, two hit batters and 66 strikeouts.

Last Outing: In his second career Triple-A start, Mlodzinski tossed 4.2 shutout innings on May 29 vs. Nashville.

Against the Redbirds: He made one career appearance against the Redbirds on April 20, 2023, at Memphis, allowing three unearned runs in 1.0 innings with two hits, one walk and two strikeouts.

Major League Debut: Mlodzinski made his major league debut with Pittsburgh on June 16, 2023, at Milwaukee, tossing 1.1 innings. He allowed a solo home run to Joey Wiemer and struck out Blake Perkins looking for his first career punchout.

Miscellaneous: Mlodzinski was selected by Pittsburgh in the first round (31st overall) of the 2020 First-Year Player Draft out of South Carolina University (Columbia).
