ABOUT LAST NIGHT: The Beloit Sky Carp beat the Wisconsin Timber Rattlers 5-3 at Neuroscience Ground Field. Cameron Barstad drove in three runs and Zach Zubia scored three runs for the Sky Carp. Alex Hall hit his ninth homer of the season for Wisconsin, but the Rattlers could not rally from an early 3-0 deficit. The Rattlers did get to within 3-2 only to see Beloit score twice in the seventh inning.

HIGH STRESS INNINGS: Beloit had the lead-off batter on base in six of the nine innings. They were retired in order just one time.

HALL OF PAIN: Hall was on base four times last night with two singles, a walk, and a homer. Hall leads the Rattlers in home runs this season. Hall had nine RBI on Wednesday night and has added two more RBI to give him eleven in the series.

UNLUCKY THIRTEEN: Ernesto Martinez Jr went 0-for-4 last night and his thirteen-game losing streak ended.

CHAPTER 26: Robert Moore was 0-for-3 but walked twice last night to extend his current on-base streak to 26 games. Moore is 28-for-98 (.286) with an OPS of .841 with eighteen walks, seventeen RBI, and sixteen runs scored during the streak that started on June 8. Moore's streak is the third-longest in the Midwest League this season. Only Christian Cairo of Lake County (27 games) and Dalton Rushing of Great Lakes (29) have longer on-base streaks this season.

OF THIS ERA: Moore's on-base streak is the longest by a Rattler since the High-A Era began for the team in 2021. Moore's on-base streak is the longest by a Rattler since Thomas Dillard had a 29-game on-base streak from July 14 through August 15, 2019.

THE MISIOROWSKI REPORTS: Wisconsin starting pitcher Jacob Misiorowski appeared for the National League team in the SiriusXM All-Star Futures game in Seattle last night. He allowed a hit and struck out three in a scoreless fourth inning. Eleven of his pitches in the inning were at least 100mph.

ABOUT BELOIT: The Beloit Sky Carp changed their name from Snappers after the 2021 season. This is Beloit's third season as an affiliate of the Miami Marlins. Beloit started as the Beloit Brewers in 1982 as the Midwest League affiliate of Milwaukee. They changed their name to the Beloit Snappers for the 1995 season. The Snappers affiliation with Milwaukee ended after the 2004 season They were affiliated with the Minnesota Twins (2005-2012) and the Oakland Athletics (2013-2019) over their final seasons in the Midwest League. The Snappers said "Goodbye" to Pohlman Field on July 11, 2021 and moved into ABC Supply Stadium on August 3, 2021. Billy Gardner Jr is in his first season as the manager of the Sky

WISCONSIN SCHEDULED STARTING PITCHER:

RHP ALEXANDER CORNIELLE: Milwaukee signed Cornielle as an International Free Agent out of the Dominican Republic on June 15, 2019.

FAST DEBUT: Cornielle made his professional debut with one inning of relief against the Cubs #2 affiliate in the Dominican Summer League on August 2, 2019. He allowed one run on no hits with two walks in one inning. Cornielle made three appearances in the DSL in 2019 with no record and one run allowed over four innings.

HIT PLAY: Cornielle started the 2021 season with the Brewers Blue affiliate in the Arizona Complex League and was 4-2 in nine games – four starts – with a 4.64 ERA and 50 strikeouts over 33 innings pitched. He was called up to Carolina at the end of the season and was 0-1 in two starts with ten strikeouts in eight innings.

WEEKLY AWARD: Cornielle was named the ACL's Pitcher of the Week on September 6, 2021 after his performance against the White Sox on August 31, 2021. He allowed one run on one hit and two walks with six strikeouts over five innings in the game.

FEELING 2022: Cornielle was 9-7 in 22 games – 19 starts – with a 3.19 ERA and 124 strikeouts over 101-2/3 innings pitched for the Carolina Mudcats this season before joining the Timber Rattlers on August 23. He was second in the Carolina League in strikeouts and third in the Carolina League in ERA before his promotion to Wisconsin. Cornielle was 1-0 in three starts with Wisconsin and allowed four runs with six walks and 21 strikeouts over 17-1/3 innings pitched.

LAST START: Cornielle had a no decision against Beloit in game one of this series on July 4. He allowed two hits with two walks, and five strikeouts over 3-2/3 scoreless innings.

VS. BELOIT: Cornielle also made the start at home against the Sky Carp on April 29. He allowed two runs on six hits with a walk and seven strikeouts over 5-1/3 innings in that start.

BELOIT SCHEDULED STARTING PITCHER:

LHP CADE GIBSON: Selected in the tenth round of the 2022 draft by the Marlins out of Louisiana Tech.

TECHNICALLY SPEAKING: Gibson was 10-8 with a 5.57 ERA in 42 games – 24 starts – in two seasons at Louisiana Tech. He struck out 159 over 156-2/3 innings pitched in his career. In his final season of college, Gibson went 6-5 with a save and a 4.87 ERA in nineteen games – thirteen starts. Gibson also had 93 strikeouts with nineteen walks in 85 innings in his final season at Louisiana Tech.

GETTING COMPLEX: Gibson started his pro career with the Florida Complex League affiliate of the Marlins and allowed one run on four hits with ten strikeouts over seven innings in four games – one start – for no record. He moved up the Florida State League and Jupiter where he was 1-0 in four relief appearances with ten strikeouts over 7-2/3 scoreless innings.

JUPITER RISING: Gibson started the 2023 season in Jupiter and was 2-3 with a 3.12 ERA in seven games – six starts. He walked ten and struck out 33 in 34-2/3 innings pitched. Gibson was promoted to Beloit on May 20.

LAST START: Gibson had a no decision on <u>July 3</u> at home against the South Bend Cubs. He allowed four runs on five hits with three walks and four strikeouts over five innings.

VS. WISCONSIN: Gibson has never faced the Timber Rattlers prior to this afternoon. This is also the first time he will pitch against an affiliate of the Milwaukee Brewers.
