ABOUT LAST NIGHT: The Peoria Chiefs defeated the Wisconsin Timber Rattlers 2-1 in the season opener for both teams

FIRST ROUND KO: Wisconsin knocked Peoria starting pitcher Cooper Hjerpe out of the game seven batters into the first inning. Hjerpe walked three and hit a batter to allow a run. Matt Wood drew a two-out walk with the bases loaded to give the Rattlers a 1-0 lead.

FALLING BEHIND: The Chiefs took a 2-1 lead in the top of the third inning. Won-Bin Cho drove in the tying run and reached on a dropped sacrifice fly. Cho stole second, stole third, and scored the go-ahead run on a throwing error.

NO OFFENSE: Wisconsin was held to one hit, a single by Wood in the fourth inning. The Chiefs had three hits. HOME OPENER HISTORY: Wisconsin in 20-8 in their home openers since 1995. The Rattlers have won their last four home openers and six of their last seven. Tonight is the eighth time Wisconsin has their home opener against Peoria.

ABOUT PEORIA: The Peoria Chiefs were in the Three-I League from 1953-1958 before the team folded. They were a St. Louis Cardinals affiliate from 1953-1957 and a New York Yankees affiliate in 1958. The Chiefs re-entered organized baseball when the Danville franchise moved to Peoria after the 1982 season. They were named the Peoria Suns and were affiliated with the California Angels for 1983 and 1984 with a change to the Chiefs nickname for 1984 followed by an affiliation switch to the Chicago Cubs for the 1985 season. Peoria became the Cardinals Midwest League affiliate for the first time in 1995, switched back to the Cubs in 2005, and went back to the Cardinals in 2013. The Chiefs won a Midwest League title in 2002. They made the Midwest League Championship Series in 2018 but lost to Bowling Green. Patrick Anderson is in his third year as Peoria's manager. Notable former Chiefs include Greg Maddux, Mark Grace, Albert Pujols, Yadier Molina, Nolan Gorman, and Victor Scott II.

ABOUT THE CARDINALS: St. Louis had several different Midwest League affiliates before settling back in Peoria in 2013. They were in Cedar Rapids from 1965-1972 before leaving the league until returning to the league to affiliate with the Springfield, Illinois team from 1982 through 1993. St. Louis spent one year with the Madison Hatters before their first affiliation with Peoria from 1995 through 2004. The Cardinals left Peoria for Quad Cities from 2005 through 2012.

## PITCHING MATCHUP

#### WISCONSIN SCHEDULED STARTING PITCHER:

RHP ALEXANDER CORNIELLE: Milwaukee signed Cornielle as an International Free Agent out of the Dominican Republic on June 15, 2019.

**FAST DEBUT:** Cornielle made his professional debut with one inning of relief against the Cubs #2 affiliate in the Dominican Summer League on August 2, 2019. He allowed one run on no hits with two walks in one inning. Cornielle made three appearances in the DSL in 2019 with no record and one run allowed over four innings.

**HIT PLAY:** Cornielle started the 2021 season with the Brewers Blue affiliate in the Arizona Complex League and was 4-2 in nine games – four starts – with a 4.64 ERA and 50 strikeouts over 33 innings pitched. He was called up to Carolina at the end of the season and was 0-1 in two starts with ten strikeouts in eight innings.

**WEEKLY AWARDS:** Cornielle was named the ACL's Pitcher of the Week on September 6, 2021. He also won the Midwest League Pitcher of the Week Award on September 11, 2023.

**BACK IN 2022:** Cornielle was 9-7 in 22 games – 19 starts – with a 3.19 ERA and 124 strikeouts over 101-2/3 innings pitched for the Carolina Mudcats this season before joining the Timber Rattlers on August 23. He was second in the Carolina League in strikeouts and third in the Carolina League in ERA before his promotion to Wisconsin. Cornielle was 1-0 in three starts with Wisconsin and allowed four runs with six walks and 21 strikeouts over 17-1/3 innings pitched.

**LAST SEASON:** Cornielle was 1-3 in twenty games – eighteen starts – for Wisconsin. He walked 34, struck out 92, and compiled a 4.55 ERA in 89 innings pitched for the Rattlers.

**LAST START:** Cornielle was the winning pitcher against Cedar Rapids at home on September 8, 2023. He walked one and struck out nine while allowing three hits over seven scoreless innings for the win. Cornielle set a new single-game high for innings pitched as a professional in that game.

VS. PEORIA (2023): Cornielle went 0-1 in four starts against the Chiefs last season. He allowed thirteen runs on twenty hits with five walks and thirteen strikeouts over 16-2/3 innings versus Peoria last season.

#### PEORIA SCHEDULED STARTING PITCHER:

RHP HANCEL RINCON: The St. Louis Cardinals signed Rincon as an International Free Agent out of the Dominican Republic on January 26, 2019.

CLIMBING THE LADDER: Rincon spent 2019 and 2021 with the Cardinals Dominican Summer League affiliate. He split time between the Florida Complex League Cardinals and the Palm Beach Cardinals in 2022 before spending all 2023 with Palm Beach in the Florida State League. In his career, Rincon is 13-21 with a 3.34 ERA in 65 games – 55 starts. Rincon has 250 strikeouts over 296-1/3 innings pitched as a professional through 2023.

**LIFE AMONG THE PALMS IN 2023:** Rincon was 9-6 with a 3.26 ERA for Palm Beach last season. He made 24 appearances – 23 starts - while walking 20 and striking out 97 over 132-2/3 innings pitched.

**A LEADER:** Rincon led the Florida State League in innings (132-2/3), WHIP (0.97), and opponent batting average (.219).

STARS AND AWARDS: The Cardinals named Rincon their Minor League Pitcher of the Month for May 2023. He was also named a Postseason All-Star for the Florida State League by Minor League Baseball.

**LAST START:** Rincon lost to Clearwater at home on September 8, 2023. He allowed four runs on six hits over six innings. Rincon hit a batter, walked none, and struck out seven in the game.

VS. WISCONSIN: Rincon has never pitched against Wisconsin prior to this afternoon. Today is the first time Rincon will pitch against an affiliate of the Milwaukee Brewers since August 24, 2019 when he made the start and took the loss against the Dominican Summer League Brewers. Eduarqui Fernández was the only current Rattler to face Rincon in that game.
