ABOUT LAST NIGHT: [The Wisconsin Timber Rattlers beat the Cedar Rapids Kernels 12-2 at Neuroscience Group Field at Fox Cities Stadium.](#) Three Wisconsin pitchers held the Kernels to two runs and recorded thirteen strikeouts while the offense pounded fourteen hits and built an early 7-1 lead.

BACK-TO-BACK JACKS: Thomas Dillard and LG Castillo cracked consecutive home runs in the bottom of the second inning. Dillard's homer was his fifteenth of the season and was a two-run blast. Castillo's homer was his fourth of the season and first at home in 2021.

RELAY RACE: Relievers Cristian Sierra, John LaRossa, and Taylor Floyd had to cover the game, which had been originally scheduled as a start for Reese Olson before Olson was traded to the Detroit Tigers on Friday. Sierra, making his second pro start, allowed two runs over four innings. LaRossa struck out six over three scoreless innings and Floyd got the last six outs to close out the victory.

FIRST! LaRossa earned his first professional win in affiliated ball last night.

ON-BASE MACHINE: Korry Howell doubled, was hit by a pitch, walked, stole a base, and scored two runs last night. Howell's on-base streak is at seventeen games. He has scored sixteen runs during the streak.

ABOUT CEDAR RAPIDS: The Cedar Rapids Kernels are charter members of the High-A Central League. The current franchise began its existence as the Cedar Rapids Braves, an affiliate of the Milwaukee Braves in the Three-I League in 1958. That was the same year and league the current Timber Rattlers franchise joined the Three-I League as the Fox Cities Foxes. Both teams moved to the Midwest League when the Three-I League ended after the 1961 season. Cedar Rapids has been called the Braves, Red Raiders, Cardinals, Astros, Giants, and Reds until they became the Kernels in 1993. That was the same year the California Angels became the parent club of the Kernels. That affiliation remained through the 2012 season. Cedar Rapids has been affiliated with the Minnesota Twins since 2013. The Kernels made the Midwest League playoffs every year they were affiliated with the Twins. Notable alumni include Mike Trout, Byron Buxton, Trevor Hoffman, and Ted Simmons.

ABOUT THE TWINS: Minnesota's former High-A Affiliate was the Fort Myers Miracle in the Florida State League. From 1995 through 2019, the Twins were affiliated with four teams in the Midwest League. They were with the Fort Wayne Wizards (1995-1998), Quad City River Bandits (1999-2005), Beloit Snappers (2006-2012), and Cedar Rapids Kernels (2013-2019)

PROSPECTING IN THE SERIES: [MLB Pipeline](#) puts five Rattlers on their list of Brewers Top 30 Prospects: Carlos Rodríguez (#14), Hayden Cantrelle (#16), Nick Kahle (#20), Thomas Dillard (#22), and David Hamilton (#27). [MLB Pipeline](#) has five Kernels on their list of Twins prospects: Matt Wallner (#11), Wander Javier (#20), Seth Gray (#23), Luis Rijo (#24), and Yunior Severino (#28). Matt Canterino (#5) and Blayne Enlow (#9) are currently on the Kernels injured list.

WISCONSIN STARTING PITCHER:

LHP NICK BENNETT: Selected by the Brewers in the 6th round of the 2019 draft out of the University of Louisville.

LOUISVILLE: Bennett was 7-3 with a 4.40ERA in sixteen starts during his final season with the Cardinals. He went 20-6 in 45 games – 40 starts – during his career at Louisville with 209 strikeouts over 215-2/3 innings pitched.

DREAMS OF OMAHA: Bennett made two starts for the Cardinals in the College World Series. He was the starter against TCU as a freshman on June 22, 2017 and took the loss. Bennett started against Mississippi State on June 20, 2019 for a no decision in a game that Louisville rallied from a 3-0 deficit to win 4-3.

TO THE SPRINGS: Bennett made his pro debut with the Rocky Mountain Vibes, the Pioneer League affiliate of the Brewers. He appeared in six games – three starts – for the Vibes and allowed two earned runs with 19K in 12-2/3 innings.

ON WISCONSIN: Bennett appeared in five games – three starts – for the Timber Rattlers in 2019. He walked four and struck out 24 in 20-1/3 innings pitched with Wisconsin. Bennett was 1-0 with a 2.21 ERA. One of his starts with the Rattlers was at Clinton, the Miami Marlins affiliate at the time, and he matched his professional high for strikeouts in a single game with seven and set a single-game high as a pro for innings pitched with 5-2/3.

THIS YEAR: Bennett started this season with the Timber Rattlers and was 1-0 with a 4.96 ERA in four games – three starts – before a move to Biloxi in the Double-A South in early June. He was 1-4 with a 4.66 ERA in ten games – six starts – for the Shuckers before coming back to Wisconsin.

LAST START: Bennett had a no decision for the Biloxi Shuckers [on July 22 in a road game against the Mississippi Braves](#). He allowed an unearned run on no hits, a hit batsman, and six walks with three strikeouts over 4-1/3 innings.

VS. CEDAR RAPIDS: Bennett has never faced the Kernels prior to this afternoon. This is also the first time he will pitch against an affiliate of the Minnesota Twins.

CEDAR RAPIDS STARTING PITCHER:

RHP TYLER BECK: The Twins selected Beck in the 30th round of the 2019 draft out of the University of Tampa.

TAMPA, TOO: Beck, a native of South Bend, Indiana, began his college career at Purdue University where he spent time as a redshirt freshman. He transferred to Pasco-Hernando State College for two years before pitching two years at Tampa.

SENIOR RELIEF: Beck appeared in 24 games as a senior with the Tampa Spartans. He was 3-3 with ten saves, a 2.14 ERA, 19 walks, and 71 strikeouts over 54 innings.

2019: Beck pitched for the Gulf Coast League Twins, Elizabethton Twins in the Appalachian League, and Fort Myers Miracle in the Gulf Coast League in 2019. He was 1-2 in 18 relief appearances with a 3.07 ERA, ten walks, and 43 strikeouts in 29-1/3 innings pitched over those three stops in the Twins system.

LAST START: Beck had a no decision at home [against Beloit at home on July 20](#). He allowed two runs on eight hits with no walks and seven strikeouts over five innings.

VS. WISCONSIN: Beck had a no decision [against the Timber Rattlers on May 25 at Cedar Rapids](#). He allowed two runs on five hits with two walks and four strikeouts over 3-1/3 innings.
