### ABOUT LAST NIGHT: [The Fort Wayne TinCaps beat the Wisconsin Timber Rattlers 5-1 at Parkview Field.](#)

Joshua Mears and Colton Bender had back-to-back homers in the bottom of the third inning to put the TinCaps up 5-0. Mears had a three-run home run and Bender followed with his blast. Fernandez Sanchez allowed one run over seven innings for the win. Terence Doston's sacrifice fly in the seventh inning gave Wisconsin its only run.

**TOUGH TIMES:** Wisconsin starting pitcher K.C. Hunt had 75 pitches over three innings as he took the loss. Hunt escaped a jam with runners at second and third with one out in the first inning thanks to a pair of strikeouts. The TinCaps loaded the bases with no outs in the second and scored one run on a sacrifice fly by Alain Camou. The first two Fort Wayne batters reached in the third inning before Mears hit his second homer of the series. Bender, who had doubled and scored in the second, followed with his solo shot for the 5-0 lead.

**STREAK STOPPED:** The Timber Rattlers four-game winning streak ended with last night's loss. Wisconsin won five games in a row twice in April. They have won four games in a row three times since April.

**ABOUT FORT WAYNE:** The Fort Wayne TinCaps franchise started in Mattoon, Illinois for the 1947 season. That franchise moved to Keokuk, Iowa to become the Keokuk Cardinals from 1958 through 1962. The team moved again to Wisconsin Rapids, Wisconsin for 1963. They were affiliated with the Washington Senators in 1963 and became a Minnesota Twins affiliate after the Major League team moved to Minneapolis for the 1964 season. Wisconsin Rapids moved to Kenosha, Wisconsin for the 1984 season and remained an affiliate of the Twins. Fort Wayne joined the Midwest League after the Kenosha Twins were in 1992 and the franchise moved to Fort Wayne, Indiana for the 1993 season. The team renamed themselves as the Fort Wayne Wizards and stayed an affiliate of the Twins through the 1998 season. Fort Wayne affiliated with the San Diego Padres and has remained in that relationship to this day. There was one more move for the franchise. The team moved from Memorial Stadium to Parkview Field to start the 2009 season. They also changed their name to TinCaps for 2009. The TinCaps won the only MWL Pennant for the Fort Wayne entry of the franchise in 2009. Notable former Fort Wayne players include Torii Hunter, Jake Peavy, AJ Pierzynski, Josh Barfield, LaTroy Hawkins, Corey Kluber, David Freese, Trea Turner, and Fernando Tatis Jr.

**ABOUT THE PADRES:** San Diego's relationship with Midwest League teams began in 1990 when they started an affiliation with the Waterloo Diamonds. That partnership moved to the Springfield Sultans with the Waterloo franchise for 1994. The Padres were the parent club of the Clinton LumberKings from 1995 through 1998 before joining with the Fort Wayne franchise for 1999.

# PITCHING MATCHUP

## WISCONSIN STARTING PITCHER:

**RHP WILL RUDY:** The Milwaukee Brewers selected Rudy in the fifth round of the 2022 draft out of the California Polytechnic State University, Pomona.

**WHAT A SEASON:** Rudy was at Cal Poly Pomona for three seasons but had just one full season due to COVID-19 abbreviating 2020 and canceling the 2021 season for the Broncos. In 2022, which was still his freshman season, Rudy went 8-1 with a 3.10 ERA over thirteen starts. He walked fifteen and struck out 96 in 87 innings pitched during that season.

**TROPHY ROOM:** Rudy was a three-time Pitcher of the Week in the California Collegiate Athletic Association, two-time National Collegiate Baseball Writers Association West Region Pitcher of the Week, a First Team All-CCAA selection, and the CCAA's Most Valuable pitcher last season.

**OUR OLD FRIEND FROM POMONA:** Rudy was the highest draft selection of a Poly Pomona player since Cody Ponce was picked 55<sup>th</sup> overall in the 2015 draft. The Brewers also picked Ponce, who pitched for the Timber Rattlers right after the 2015 draft.

**THE CAPE:** Rudy made one start for Yarmouth-Dennis in the Cape Cod League in 2022 before the draft. He did not pitch in the Brewers system until 2023.

**THE MUDCAT:** Rudy was 5-3 in eighteen starts for Carolina in 2023 for his professional debut. Rudy had a 3.46 ERA, 26 walks, and 69 strikeouts over 80-2/3 innings.

**LAST START:** Rudy had a no decision at West Michigan on [June 14](#). He allowed one run on one hit with a hit batsman, no walks, and five strikeouts over five innings.

**VS. FORT WAYNE:** Rudy had a no decision against Fort Wayne at home on [May 30](#). He allowed three runs on five hits over 5-1/3 innings. Rudy hit a batter, walked none, and struck out two.

## FORT WAYNE STARTING PITCHER:

**RHP HENRY BÁEZ:** The San Diego Padres signed Báez as an International Free Agent out of the Dominican Republic July 2, 2019.

**WHERE IT ALL BEGAN:** Báez made his pro debut for the DSL Padres in 2021 as an 18-year-old. He was 0-2 in twelve games – ten starts – with a 4.25 ERA and 37 strikeouts over 36 innings pitched.

**CLIMBING THE LADDER:** Báez pitched in the Arizona Complex League in 2022 with a 1-4 record and a 3.82 ERA in nine games – seven starts. Last year, Báez began the season with Lake Elsinore in the California League and was 7-3 with a 3.24 ERA and 85 strikeouts over 83-1/3 innings over seventeen games – fourteen starts. He was bumped up to Fort Wayne in August and had no record and a 7.20ERA in four starts with the TinCaps.

**LAST START:** Báez had a no decision at Lake County on [June 14](#). He allowed a run on three hits with four walks and three strikeouts over 5-2/3 innings. The only run Báez was a solo home run.

**VS. WISCONSIN:** Báez had a no decision against the Timber Rattlers at Wisconsin on [May 31](#). He allowed two runs on four hits with a hit batsman, a walk, and five strikeouts.
