ABOUT LAST NIGHT: The Beloit Sky Carp beat the Wisconsin Timber Rattlers 8-6 in twelve innings at Neuroscience Group Field. Wisconsin had a 4-0 lead after the bottom of the first and a 5-2 lead after six innings. However, the Sky Carp scored a run in the seventh and two runs with two outs in the ninth to tie the game. Both teams scored in the eleventh. Beloit took an 8-6 lead in the twelfth on an RBI single by RBI single by Cameron Barstad and a sacrifice fly by Jacob Berry. Barstad had an RBI pinch-hit single in the ninth with an error on the play letting the tying run score.

OUT OF THE BLOCKS: Wisconsin loaded the bases

**OUT OF THE BLOCKS:** Wisconsin loaded the bases with no outs in the bottom of the first. Hendry Mendez drove in the first two runs of the inning with a double. Alex Hall drove in the third run with an infield grounder. Eduardo García capped the inning with a two-out single.

QUALITY IS JOB ONE: Tyler Woessner was Wisconsin's starting pitcher and he picked up his sixth quality start of the season. Woessner allowed two runs on four hits with two walks and a strikeout over six innings.

**EVEN DOZEN:** Ernesto Martinez Jr went 1-for-5 last night to extend his hitting streak to twelve games. Martinez is 17-for-43 (.395) during the streak, which is the longest on the team in 2023.

**TWO DOZEN:** Robert Moore was 3-for-5 with a run scored and two RBI last night to extend his current onbase streak to 24 games. Moore is 27-for-90 (.300) with an OPS of .867 with sixteen walks, seventeen RBI, and fifteen runs scored during the streak that started on June 8. Moore's streak is tied for the third-longest in the Midwest League this season. Moore also happens to be on a ten-game hitting streak (13-for-39, .333), his longest of the season.

**OF THIS ERA:** Moore's on-base streak is the longest by a Rattler since the High-A Era began for the team in 2021. Tristan Peters had a 23 game on-base streak last year.

ABOUT BELOIT: The Beloit Sky Carp changed their name from Snappers after the 2021 season. This is Beloit's third season as an affiliate of the Miami Marlins. Beloit started as the Beloit Brewers in 1982 as the Midwest League affiliate of Milwaukee. They changed their name to the Beloit Snappers for the 1995 season. The Snappers affiliation with Milwaukee ended after the 2004 season. They were affiliated with the Minnesota Twins (2005-2012) and the Oakland Athletics (2013-2019) over their final seasons in the Midwest League. The Snappers said "Goodbye" to Pohlman Field on July 11, 2021 and moved into ABC Supply Stadium on August 3, 2021. Billy Gardner Jr is in his first season as the manager of the Sky Carp.

ABOUT THE MARLINS: The Florida/Miami Marlins have lots of history in the Midwest League. The Marlins' first Low-A affiliate was the Kane County Cougars from 1993 through 2002. Josh Beckett, Adrian Gonzalez, Dontrelle Willis, Miguel Cabrera, and former Timber Rattlers manager Matt Erickson all played for the Cougars in that timespan The Marlins returned to the Midwest League in in 2019 to affiliate with the Clinton LumberKings. The Marlins landed in Beloit after MLB reset the affiliations for 2021

PROSPECTING IN THE SERIES: MLB Pipeline places five active Rattlers on their list of Brewers Top 30 Prospects: Jacob Misiorowski (#4), Robert Moore (#8), Hendry Mendez (#13), Eduardo García (#19), and Matthew Wood (#24). Eric Brown Jr (#6) and Joseph Hernandez (#25) are currently on Wisconsin's IL. MLB Pipeline has five Beloit players on their list of Marlins prospects: Jacob Berry (#2), Joe Mack (#5), Yiddi Cappe (#6), Kahlil Watson (#12), and Karson Milbrandt (#15).

# PITCHING MATCHUP

#### WISCONSIN SCHEDULED STARTING PITCHER:

RHP EDWIN JIMENEZ: Milwaukee signed Jimenez as an International Free Agent out of Venezuela on October 11, 2018.

**HEADING TO THE CO-OP:** Jimenez was assigned to the Dominican Summer League Co-op team shared between Milwaukee and Cleveland for the 2019 season. Jimenez was 1-5 with a 3.05 ERA in twelve games - eight starts. He walked 26 and struck out 32 over 41-1/3 innings in his first professional season.

FROM THE ISLAND TO THE DESERT: Jimenez started the 2021 season with Milwaukee's number two affiliate in the Dominican Summer League. He was assigned to the Brewers Blue affiliate in the Arizona Complex League on August 7, 2021. Jimenez went 1-1 with a 1.72 ERA in five games – four starts - in the DSL and 0-4 with a save and a 5.25 ERA in the ACL. He walked twelve and struck out 48 over 39-2/3 innings combined between his two stops in the system that season.

CAROLINA ON MY MIND: Jimenez was 4-7 in 25 games – seventeen starts – with the Carolina Mudcats in 2022. He had a 4.75 ERA, walked 41, and struck out 104 over 113-2/3 innings pitched in the Carolina League last season. Jimenez started the 2023 season with Carolina and went 2-0 in four games - one start - with five walks and 23 strikeouts over eighteen innings before his promotion to Wisconsin on May 2.

LAST START: Jimenez had a no decision at Quad Cities on July 1. He allowed three runs on five hits with three walks and two strikeouts over four

VS. BELOIT: Jimenez has never faced the Sky Carp prior to this evening. Tonight is also the first time he will pitch against an affiliate of the Marlins.

## BELOIT SCHEDULED STARTING PITCHER:

RHP GABE BIERMAN: Selected by the Miami Marlins in the seventh round of the 2021 draft out of Indiana University.

HOOSIERS: Bierman pitched three seasons (2019-2021) at Indiana. He was 9-8 with a 4.43 ERA in 32 games – 28 starts in college. Bierman walked 61 and struck out 159 batters in 146-1/3 innings pitched for the Hoosiers. He was 5-4 with a 2.68 ERA and 80 strikeouts over 74 innings in twelve starts in his final season at Indiana.

KING FISH: Bierman made three starts for the Kenosha Kingfish of the Northwoods League in 2019. He was 2-0 with a 0.56 ERA in three starts for Kenosha. He walked seven and struck out 20 over sixteen innings in

STARTING OVER: Bierman split time between Miami's Florida Complex League affiliate and Jupiter in the Florida State League after signing with the Marlins. He was 1-0 with and 4.50 ERA and 31 strikeouts and eleven walks in 28 innings over eight appearances – seven starts – in his first

LAST YEAR: Bierman started the 2022 season with Jupiter and was 6-6 with a 4.76 ERA and 105 strikeouts over 96-1/3 innings in 22 games - 19 starts. He was promoted to Beloit at the end of the season and was 1-1 in two starts with walk walks and eleven strikeouts in twelve innings.

LAST START: Bierman had a no decision at home against South Bend on July 1. He allowed three runs on five hits with two walks and four strikeouts over four innings.

VS. WISCONSIN: Bierman had a no decision at Wisconsin on April 25. He allowed three runs on five hits with six walks and two strikeouts over five innings. The Sky Carp won the game 4-3 with two runs in the top of the eighth inning to erase a 3-2 lead for the Rattlers.
