ABOUT LAST NIGHT: [The Beloit Sky Carp beat the Wisconsin Timber Rattlers 2-0 at ABC Supply Stadium.](#)

Beloit took a 1-0 lead on a home run by Chase Jaworsky in the second inning. They scored their other run on a two-out, RBI double by Cam Cannarella in the fifth. Four Beloit pitchers combined to hold the Rattlers to two hits for their second shutout win of this series. Eliazer Dishmeyer was the starting pitcher for the Sky Carp. He allowed one hit, walked two, and struck out six over five innings. Dishmeyer retired the final eleven Rattlers he faced. Beloit's win allowed them to remain tied with South Bend at the top of the West Division standings with thirteen games remaining in the season.

CLINCHED: Beloit's win last night gave them a 10-7 lead in the season series against Wisconsin with one game remaining between the teams in 2025.

THERE WERE CHANCES: Dishmeyer walked Luis Castillo and Andrick Nava with one out in the top of the second inning. He ended the inning with a strikeout and a grounder to first to start his streak of eleven consecutive outs. Wisconsin left six runners on base last night and went 0-for-7 with runners in scoring position.

DOG DAYS: Last night was the fourth time Wisconsin has been shut out in August. Wisconsin is hitting .194 with a team OPS of .604 in nineteen games this month. They are 7-12 and have been outscored 95-64.

BISHOP IS BACK: Bishop Letson made his second start off the Wisconsin injured list last night. The home run to Jaworsky was the first he has given up this season. He had gone 29-2/3 innings without allowing a homer. Letson allowed a run on two hits with no walks and three strikeouts over 2-2/3 innings last night.

YEOMAN'S WORK: Sam Garcia worked 5-1/3 innings out of the bullpen in his first relief outing as a Rattler. He allowed one run on four hits with three walks and seven strikeouts. Garcia matched his professional single-game high for strikeouts last night.

ABOUT BELOIT: The Beloit Sky Carp changed their name from Snappers after the 2021 season. This is Beloit's fourth season as an affiliate of the Miami Marlins. Beloit started as the Beloit Brewers in 1982 as the Midwest League affiliate of Milwaukee. They changed their name to the Beloit Snappers for the 1995 season. The Snappers affiliation with Milwaukee ended after the 2004 season. They were affiliated with the Minnesota Twins (2005-2012) and the Oakland Athletics (2013-2019) over their final seasons in the Midwest League. The Snappers said "Goodbye" to Pohlman Field on July 11, 2021 and moved into ABC Supply Stadium on August 3, 2021. Angel Espada is in his first season as the manager of the Sky Carp. Bill Hall, Prince Fielder, Rickie Weeks, Chris Bosio, Greg Vaughn, Joey Meyer, BJ Surhoff, Tim Dillard, Mitch Stetter, and Matt Chapman played in Beloit.

ABOUT THE MARLINS: The Florida/Miami Marlins have lots of history in the Midwest League. The Marlins' first Low-A affiliate was the Kane County Cougars from 1993 through 2002. Josh Beckett, Adrian Gonzalez, Dontrelle Willis, Miguel Cabrera, and former Timber Rattlers manager Matt Erickson all played for the Cougars in that timespan. The Marlins returned to the Midwest League in 2019 to affiliate with the Clinton LumberKings. The Marlins landed in Beloit after MLB reset the affiliations for 2021.

PITCHING MATCHUP

WISCONSIN STARTING PITCHER:

RHP TRAVIS SMITH: The Milwaukee Brewers selected Smith in the fifteenth round of the 2024 draft out of the University of Kentucky.

WILDCAT: Smith pitched two seasons at Kentucky and was 7-7 with a 5.44 ERA and 76 strikeouts over 86 innings in 26 games – nineteen starts.

CAROLINA ON MY MIND: Smith made his pro debut with the Carolina Mudcats in the Carolina League in 2025. He was 4-4 with a 3.20 ERA in nineteen starts. Smith walked twenty and struck out 57 over 76 innings with the Mudcats before his promotion to Wisconsin.

LAST START: Smith took the loss against Beloit in game one of this series on [August 19](#). He allowed a run on four hits with a walk and three strikeouts over 5-1/3 inning.

VS. БЕЛОИТ: Smith had never pitched against the Sky Carp prior to the game on August 19. That was also his first appearance against an affiliate of the Miami Marlins.

БЕЛОИТ STARTING PITCHER:

RHP BRANDON WHITE: The Miami Marlins selected White in the twelfth round of the 2021 draft out of Washington State University.

DODGING LA: The Los Angeles Dodgers picked White in the fourteenth round of the 2018 draft out of W. F. West High School in Chehalis, Washington. White elected to attend Washington State over signing with the Dodgers.

GO COUGARS: White pitched from 2019 through 2021 with Washington State and was 8-12 with a 5.69 ERA in 30 games – 29 starts with 119 strikeouts and 67 walks over 131-1/3 innings pitched in his career.

ALL PART OF THE JOURNEY: White was with the Mat-Su Miners of the Alaskan Summer League in 2019 and the St. Cloud Rox of the Northwoods League in 2020. White did not pitch professionally in 2021 and missed the 2022 season with an injury. He made his pro debut with the Marlins Florida Complex League affiliate and the Jupiter Hammerheads of the Florida State League in 2023. White pitched with Jupiter again in 2024 and was 6-5 with a 4.98 ERA in nineteen games – fifteen starts.

LAST START: White beat South Bend at home on [August 17](#). He allowed three hits, walked none, and struck out six over six scoreless innings.

VS. WISCONSIN: White pitched in relief in game two of a doubleheader at Neuroscience Group Field against Wisconsin on [May 16](#) and took the loss in a 1-0 game. He allowed two hits over two innings with no walks and two strikeouts. One of the hits he allowed was a walkoff-homer by Eduardo Garcia in the bottom of the seventh inning. White was the winning pitcher against Wisconsin as the starter on [July 3](#) at Beloit. He allowed two hits, walked two, and struck out four over five scoreless innings.
