LAST ACTION: The Timber Rattlers split a doubleheader with the Peoria Chiefs on Sunday afternoon at home. The Chiefs won game one 1-0. Wisconsin rallied for two runs in the bottom of the seventh in game two for a 3-2 victory. The win in game two game the Timber Rattlers the series victory.

GAME ONE RECAP: Wisconsin starting pitcher Brandon Knarr had a no-hitter through four innings, but the Chiefs scraped a run across the plate on a walk, an infield single, a stolen base, a wild pitch, and an errant throw during a rundown. Wisconsin was held to two hits in the game but had the tying run on base in both the bottom of the sixth and seventh innings.

GAME TWO RECAP: Peoria broke a 1-1 tie with a solo home run by Aaron Antonini in the top of the seventh. In the bottom of the seventh, Yeison Coca and Sal Frelick drew back-to-back walks and both moved into scoring position on a wild pitch. Tyler Black lined a single through the middle to score Coca and Frelick with the tying and winning runs. Max Lazar, making his first game appearance since 2019, picked up the win.

HEY! IT'S TYLER! Black drove in all three of Wisconsin's runs in game two on Sunday. He also had an RBI double in the fifth inning to tie the game 1-1.

OUR PAL SAL: Frelick had two doubles in game two and scored two runs. He is 4-for-11 (.364) with at least one hit in all three games of the score for Wisconsin.

WALKING THROUGH HISTORY: Game two was the 22nd time the Rattlers have beaten the Peoria Chiefs in walkoff fashion. It was also the second time in the just-completed series Wisconsin celebrated a walkoff win over the Chiefs.

ON THE ROAD AGAIN: The Timber Rattlers went 26-33 on the road last season. The last time Wisconsin had a winning road record was during the 2012 season when they went 36-33. The Timber Rattlers also won a Midwest League Championship in 2012.

ABOUT BELOIT: The Beloit Sky Carp are in their first season as the Sky Carp and their second season as an affiliate of the Miami Marlins. Beloit started as the Beloit Brewers in 1982 as the Midwest League affiliate of Milwaukee. They changed their name to the Beloit Snappers for the 1995 season. The Snappers affiliation with Milwaukee ended after the 2004 season. They were affiliated with the Minnesota Twins (2005-2012) and the Oakland Athletics (2013-2019) over their final seasons in the Midwest League. The Snappers said "Goodbye" to Pohlman Field on July 11, 2021 and moved into ABC Supply Stadium on August 3. Jorge Hernandez is in his first season as the manager of the Sky Carp.

ABOUT THE MARLINS: The Florida/Miami Marlins have a history in the Midwest League. The Marlins' first Low-A affiliate was the Kane County Cougars from 1993 through 2002. Josh Beckett, Adrian Gonzalez, Dontrelle Willis, Miguel Cabrera, and former Timber Rattlers manager Matt Erickson all played for the Cougars in that timespan The Marlins returned to the Midwest League in in 2019 to affiliate with the Clinton LumberKings. The Marlins landed in Beloit after MLB reset the affiliations for the 2021 season.

PROSPECTING IN THE SERIES: MLB Pipeline puts eight Rattlers on their list of Brewers Top 30 Prospects: Sal Frelick (#1), Tyler Black (#6), Joe Gray Jr. (#13), Antoine Kelly (#14), Russell Smith (#16), Zavier Warren (#17), Carlos Rodríguez (#21), and Cam Robinson (#26). MLB Pipeline has six current Sky Carp on their Top 30 list of Miami Marlins prospects: Dax Fulton (#9), Victor Mesa Jr. (#14), Cody Morissette (#16), Nasim Nunez (#18), Justin Evans (#19), and Tanner Allen (#23).

■ PITCHING MATCHUPS

WISCONSIN SCHEDULED STARTING PITCHER:

LHP ANTOINE KELLY: Selected by the Brewers in the second round of the 2019 draft out of Wabash Valley College in Mt. Carmel, Illinois. He is rated as he #10 prospect in the Brewers system by MLB Pipeline.

WARRIORS...COME OUT TO PLAY: Kelly was 9-0 with 112 strikeouts in thirteen starts for the Warriors prior to the draft. He allowed 21 hits, 19 earned runs, and 31 walks over 52-2/3 innings pitched at Wabash Valley

SAYING NO TO SAN DIEGO: The San Diego Padres selected Kelly in the thirteenth round of the 2018 draft after his senior season at Maine East High School in Park Ridge, Illinois. Kelly chose junior college over signing with the Padres.

THE BOYHOOD DREAM COMES TRUE: Kelly has been a Milwaukee Brewers fan since he was young.

WHAT'S BREWING? Kelly made his pro debut in the AZL with the Brewers Blue and made one start for the Rattlers in 2019. He spent 2020 with the Brewers Alternate Training Site. He underwent surgery for Thoracic Outlet Syndrome on November 5, 2020 and has worked his way back to Wisconsin after a relief appearance in Arizona and seven starts with Carolina before joining the Rattlers near the end of the 2021 season.

LAST START: Kelly took the loss against Cedar Rapids on September 9, 2021. He allowed eight runs on three hits with three walks, two hit batsmen, and three strikeouts in 1-1/3 innings pitched.

VS. CEDAR RAPIDS: Kelly has never faced the Sky Carp prior to this evening. This is also the first time he will pitch against an affiliate of the Miami Marlins.

BELOIT SCHEDULED STARTING PITCHER:

RHP MD JOHNSON: The Marlins selected Johnson in the 6th round of the 2019 draft out of Dallas Baptist University.

PATRIOT GAMES: Johnson pitched four seasons at Dallas Baptist. He was 29-9 with a 4.27 ERA and 274 strikeouts in 297 innings over 68 games - 57 starts - in his career.

SENIOR MOMENTS: Johnson was 10-2 in sixteen starts in his final season at DBU. He had an ERA of 2.76 and had 110 strikeouts with 29 walks over 98 innings pitched as a senior.

TO THE PROS: Johnson made pitched for the Batavia Muckdogs in the New York-Penn League in 2019 after signing with the Marlins. He made fifteen relief appearances and was 1-0 while allowing nine earned runs and striking out 22 in 19 innings pitched.

FLORIDA MAN: Johnson went 3-4 with the Jupiter Hammerheads to start his 2021 season. He had a 3.19 ERA in ten games - seven starts before his promotion to Beloit on July 6.

CENTRALLY LOCATED: Johnson was 3-4 in eleven starts with Beloit in 2021. He had a 2.58ERA with 59 strikeouts over 59.1 innings pitched.

LAST START: Johnson had a no decision at Lake County on September 16. He allowed three runs on six hits with four walks and four strikeouts over 3.1 innings pitched.

VS. WISCONSIN: Johnson made two starts against the Timber Rattlers in 2021. He beat Wisconsin in Beloit on August 6 when he pitched five no-hit, shutout innings with four walks and nine strikeouts. Johnson had a no decision against the Rattlers in the Fox Cities on September 2 with six shutout innings as he allowed three hits, walked two, and struck out
