ABOUT LAST NIGHT: The Wisconsin Timber Rattlers beat the Peoria Chiefs 5-3 at Dozer Park. Luis Peña homered in the first inning to give Wisconsin an early 1-0 lead. Jesús Made broke a 2-2 tie with an RBI triple in the top of the seventh inning and scored an insurance run later in the inning. Jack Seppings pitched around two base runners in the bottom of the eighth and two more in the bottom of the ninth for his first Midwest League save.

A NIGHT OF DEBUTS: Wisconsin starting pitcher Travis Smith, Peña, and Made all made their Midwest League debuts last night. Smith allowed two runs on three hits with two walks and three strikeouts over four innings for a no decision. Peña homered with one out in the top of the first inning in his first at bat as a Rattler and finished his evening 1-for-4 with a walk. Made was 1-for-5.

AN OASIS: The home run by Peña was the first by a Timber Rattler since Hebert Pérez went deep at Quad Cities on July 26.

RUNNING WILD: Wisconsin went 5-for-5 in stolen base attempts last night. Yhoswar Garcia stole two bases last night to give him 48 on the season. Garcia has the most steals in a season by a Timber Rattler in the Brewers Era (2009 to present). Only two players in Rattlers history have stolen 50 or more bases in a season (Pedro Liriano – 65 in 2001 and Ramon Valera – 52 in 1998)

HELPING HANDS: Luiyin Alastre threw out Won-Bin Cho at the plate in the bottom of the seventh inning as Cho tried to score from second on a single to left. Cho would have scored the run to make the score 4-4. Kay-Lan Nicasia made a diving catch in the bottom of the ninth for the final out of the game to strand the tying runs on base.

A CENTURY OF PROGRESS: Wisconsin turned two double plays last night to give them 100 on the season. The Everett AquaSox of the Northwest League lead the High-A classification with 102 double plays in 2025

ABOUT PEORIA: The Peoria Chiefs were in the Three-I League from 1953-1958 before the team folded. They were a St. Louis Cardinals affiliate from 1953-1957 and a New York Yankees affiliate in 1958. The Chiefs re-entered organized baseball when the Danville franchise moved to Peoria after the 1982 season. They were named the Peoria Suns and were affiliated with the California Angels for 1983 and 1984 with a change to the Chiefs nickname for 1984 followed by an affiliation switch to the Chicago Cubs for the 1985 season. Peoria became the Cardinals Midwest League affiliate for the first time in 1995, switched back to the Cubs in 2005, and went back to the Cardinals in 2013. The Chiefs won a Midwest League title in 2002. They made the Midwest League Championship Series in 2018 but lost to Bowling Green. Patrick Anderson is in his third year as Peoria's manager. Notable former Chiefs include Greg Maddux, Mark Grace, Albert Pujols, Yadier Molina, Nolan Gorman, and Victor Scott II.

ABOUT THE CARDINALS: St. Louis had several different Midwest League affiliates before settling back in Peoria in 2013. They were in Cedar Rapids from 1965-1972 before leaving the league until returning to the league to affiliate with the Springfield, Illinois team from 1982 through 1993. St. Louis spent one year with the Madison Hatters before their first affiliation with Peoria from 1995 through 2004. The Cardinals left Peoria for Quad Cities from 2005 through 2012

PITCHING MATCHUP

WISCONSIN STARTING PITCHER:

RHP MANUEL RODRIGUEZ: The Milwaukee Brewers signed Rodriguez as an International Free Agent out of Mexico on April 5, 2022.

WHIRLWIND: Rodriguez had a very busy 2022. After signing with Milwaukee in April, he began his professional career in the Dominican Summer League in June and went 1-5 with a 4.54 ERA in twelve games — five starts. Later in the year he pitched for Mexico in the U-18 World Cup of Baseball. Rodriguez went 1-1 in the tournament with a win over Australia and a loss to the Netherlands.

PLAYOFF EXPERIENCE: Rodriguez has pitched in the postseason in each of the last two seasons. He made a relief appearance for the ACL Brewers in the Arizona Complex League Semifinal Game in 2023 and was the starter in Game Two of the Carolina League Playoffs for the Mudcats against Fredericksburg.

CHECK THE RATING: MLB Pipeline moved Rodriguez into their Top 30 list of Brewers Prospects at #30 after Yophery Rodriguez was traded to Boston on April 7, 2025 and up to #29 when Isaac Collins graduated from the list on April 19, 2025. In the July 25, 2025 update, Rodriguez is back at #30. Baseball America listed Rodriguez as the #25 prospect in the Milwaukee System in their 2025 Prospect Handbook.

LAST START: Rodriguez had a no decision against Lake County at home on <u>July 31</u>. He allowed one run on two hits with no walks and four strikeouts over six innings.

VS. PEORIA: Rodriguez has never faced the Chiefs prior to this evening. Tonight is his first time facing an affiliate of the St. Louis Cardinals since a game against the Dominican Summer League Cardinals on <u>June 27, 2022</u>.

PEORIA STARTING PITCHER:

RHP CHEN-WEI LIN: The St. Louis Cardinals signed Lin as a Minor League Free Agent on July 3, 2023.

WORLD TRAVELER: Lin, a native of Taiwan, pitched for Kenosha in the Northwoods League in 2022 going 0-1 in nine games – four starts – with a 12.06 ERA, 24 walks, and sixteen strikeouts over 15-2/3 inning. He also went to Frederick in the MLB Draft League in 2023 with ten walks, fifteen strikeouts, a 3.24 ERA, and a 2-0 record in four starts prior to signing with St. Louis.

PROSPECT TALK: Lin is the #14 prospect in the St. Louis system according to MLB Pipeline. He has a fastball that can reach triple digits and usually sits from 95-98 mph.

LAST SEASON: Lin was 10-5 with a 2.79 ERA in 22 starts for the Palm Beach Cardinals of the Florida State League in 2024. He walked 36 and struck out 123 in 116 innings pitched.

LAST START: Lin had a no decision against the South Bend Cubs at home on <u>July 3</u>. He allowed two runs on four hits and four walks with seven strikeouts over four innings.

VS. WISCONSIN: Lin made his Midwest League debut against the Timber Rattlers with a start at Dozer Park on May 11. He also made a start at Neuroscience Group Field on May 31. Lin has allowed five runs – two earned – on six hits with a walk and six strikeouts over 6-2/3 innings with no record in those two starts.
