ABOUT LAST NIGHT: [The Great Lakes Loons beat the Wisconsin Timber Rattlers 13-4 at Dow Diamond.](#)

Alex De Jesus hit for the cycle and four Loons pitchers recorded seventeen strikeouts. Great Lakes scored in each of the first five innings to build a 12-0 lead.

ADD IT UP: Wisconsin hitters have struck out 33 times in the last two games. The sixteen strikeouts on Wednesday night matched a season high for one game. The seventeen strikeouts last night set a new single-game high for the season.

TWO-OUT BINGO: The Loons ten of their thirteen runs with two outs. Wisconsin scored three of their four runs with two outs.

HEY, NINETEEN: Loons hitters had nineteen hits last night. That is the most allowed by Wisconsin pitching this season. Twelve of their hits went for extra bases. Great Lakes had nine doubles, a triple, and two home runs.

KING OF TRIOS: Tyler Black had three hits last night for Wisconsin. He has five three-hit games and fifteen multi-hit games to lead the Timber Rattlers in both categories.

FROM THE FIELD TO THE HILL: Ashton McGee moved from first base to the mound to pitch the bottom of the eighth inning. He allowed a hit with a hit batsman and a strikeout over a scoreless frame. Last night was the second time McGee has pitched in a game this season.

ABOUT GREAT LAKES: The Great Lakes Loons came into existence in 2007 after the Midwest League team left Battle Creek at the end of the 2006 season. The team in Battle Creek had been known as the Michigan Battle Cats, Battle Creek Yankees, and the Southwest Michigan Devil Rays. The Loons have been affiliated with the Los Angeles Dodgers since 2007. They made the Midwest League playoffs seven times between 2007 and 2019. The Loons won the Midwest League title in 2016. Notable Great Lakes alumni include Clayton Kershaw, Kenley Jansen, Nathan Eovaldi, Joc Peterson, Julio Urias, Walker Buehler, and Gavin Lux.

ABOUT THE DODGERS: The Los Angeles Dodgers were only in the Midwest League for a few seasons prior to affiliating with the Loons. They were in Dubuque in 1967 and in Clinton from 1977 to 1979. Orel Hershiser and Steve Sax were notable Dodgers to play in Clinton.

GREAT LAKES IN 2021: The Loons went 63-57 and missed the playoffs. Great Lakes had an opportunity to make the playoffs in the final week of the season, but the Timber Rattlers won five of six games from the Loons at Dow Diamond to knock Great Lakes out of the playoff picture.

GREAT LAKES IN 2022: The Loons are in second place in the Eastern Division. They won the final five games in a series at first place Dayton prior to starting this series with Wisconsin to cut the deficit from 8-1/2 games to 3-1/2 games. They are now 4-1/2 games out of first.

PROSPECTING IN THE SERIES: [MLB Pipeline](#) puts six active Rattlers on their list of Brewers Top 30 Prospects: Tyler Black (#6), Joe Gray Jr. (#13), Antoine Kelly (#14), Russell Smith (#16), Xavier Warren (#17), and Cam Robinson (#26). Carlos Rodriguez (#21) is on the Wisconsin injured list. [MLB Pipeline](#) has seven current Loons on their list of Dodgers prospects: Diego Cartaya (#1), Eddys Leonard (#8), Jorbit Vivas (#9), Nick Nastrini (#13), Jose Ramos (#14), Carlos Duran (#16), and Alex De Jesus (#20). Hyun-il Choi (#28) is on the Great Lakes Injured List.

WISCONSIN SCHEDULED STARTING PITCHER:

RHP JUSTIN JARVIS: Selected by Milwaukee in the 5th round of the 2018 draft out of Lake Norman High School in Mooresville, North Carolina.

THE SENIOR SEASON: In his final season of high school, Jarvis was 8-2 with a 1.60ERA, and 95 strikeouts. Former Major Leaguer Ty Wigginton was his head coach.

A PERFECT DAY: Jarvis pitched a perfect game with 18 strikeouts in a game against East Rowan High School early in his senior season of high school.

NOT ON CAMPUS: Jarvis signed with the Brewers over a commitment to UNC-Wilmington.

YEAR ONE: Jarvis was 1-2 with a 6.63ERA in ten games – three starts – for Milwaukee's Arizona League affiliate after signing with Milwaukee. He walked four and struck out 18 over 19 innings pitched in the Arizona League.

2019: Jarvis was 4-1 with a 3.50 ERA in 18 games – eleven starts – for the Timber Rattlers in 2019. He had 52 strikeouts over 74-2/3 innings.

2021: Jarvis was 1-7 with a 5.40 ERA in seventeen starts for the Timber Rattlers in 2021. He had 62 strikeouts over 63-1/3 innings.

LAST START: Jarvis [beat Beloit on the road on June 11](#). He allowed three runs – one earned – on six hits with no walks and nine strikeouts over seven innings.

VS. GREAT LAKES (2021): Jarvis was 0-1 in two starts against the Loons last season. He allowed six runs – four earned – on seven hits with six walks and six strikeouts over 5-1/3 innings in those two starts.

GREAT LAKES SCHEDULED STARTING PITCHER:

RHP KYLE HURT: Acquired by the Los Angeles Dodgers on February 12, 2021 in a trade with the Miami Marlins. The Marlins received Dylan Floro in exchange for Alex Vesia and Hurt.

ORIGIN STORY: The Marlins selected Hurt in the fifth round of the 2020 draft out of the University of Southern California. Hurt was 9-13 in 36 games – 30 starts – with a 5.06 ERA and 170 strikeouts over 172-2/3 innings over his three seasons at USC.

GONE FISHING: Hurt never pitched an inning in a minor league game in the Marlins organization.

ABOUT LAST YEAR: Hurt was 1-0 in four games – three starts – for the Dodgers Arizona Complex League affiliate before a promotion to Rancho Cucamonga last season. He was 1-2 with a save and a 5.51 ERA in eight games – one start for the Quakes in 2021. Hurt had 36 strikeouts and ten walks over 21 innings pitched between both levels in the Dodgers system last year.

AWARD WINNING: Hurt was named the Midwest League Pitcher of the Week on April 25 after he pitched six scoreless innings with three hits, one walk, and ten strikeouts in starts against Lake County on April 19 and April 24.

LAST START: Hurt had [a no decision at Dayton on June 11](#). He allowed one hit and struck out two in one scoreless inning.

VS. WISCONSIN: Hurt has never faced the Timber Rattlers prior to this evening. This is also the first time he will pitch against an affiliate of the Milwaukee Brewers.
