WEDNESDAY AFTERNOON: The Lansing Lugnuts beat the Wisconsin Timber Rattlers 7-1 at Neuroscience Group Field. Jack Winkler hit for the cycle and drove in four runs for the Lugnuts. Robert Moore's sacrifice fly in the bottom of the eighth inning scored Wisconsin's only run.

HITCH YOUR WAGON: Wisconsin starting pitcher Cameron Wagoner allowed two runs on four hits in 4-2/3 innings to be tagged with the loss. In his four starts in June, Wagoner has allowed ten runs in 19-2/3 innings. The offense has scored just four runs while Wagoner has been in the game during those four starts, and he is 0-2 with two no decisions.

GRAY HAVENS: Joe Gray Jr went 1-for-4 yesterday to extend his longest hitting streak of the season to nine games. He is 13-for-37 during the streak.

EARLY OPPORTUNITY: Robert Moore singled to start the bottom of the first. Gray singled with one out to put runners at first and second against Lansing starter Brady Basso. The next batter grounded into a 4-6-3 double play to end the inning.

DRY SPELL: After the double play, the Timber Rattlers didn't have another hit until the sixth inning and didn't get another runner to second base until the eighth inning.

T IS FOR TERRIFIC: Terence Doston went 1-for-3 and scored a run for the Rattlers yesterday. Doston is 12-for-33 (.364) in ten games this month. He has scored six runs and is 4-for-4 in stolen bases in June. Doston has scored four runs in his last three games played.

IT HASN'T HAPPENED SINCE: The Timber Rattlers have only been shutout twice this season. They haven't been held scoreless since May 16. Quad Cities has held the Timber Rattlers without a run on both April 18 and May 16.

FIRST HALF FINISH: The first half of the Midwest League season ends tonight. Wisconsin has a chance to climb out of sixth place in the East. They enter tonight's game ½ game behind fifth place Beloit.

ABOUT THE LANSING LUGNUTS: The Lugnuts began their existence as the Lafayette (IN) Chiefs of the Mississippi-Ohio Valley League in 1955. Lafayette became the Red Sox in 1956 and as the Mississippi-Ohio Valley League became the Midwest League. The franchise moved Waterloo, Iowa in 1958 and remained there as the Hawks, Royals, Indians, and Diamonds until the end of the 1993 season. New ownership bought the team and moved them to Springfield, Illinois for two seasons before finally locating the team in Lansing, Michigan in 1996. Since they started in Lansing, the Lugnuts were affiliated with the Kansas City Royals (1996-1998), the Chicago Cubs (1999-2004), the Toronto Blue Jays (2005-2019), and the Oakland Athletics. The Lugnuts won Midwest League titles in 1997 and 2003. Notable Lansing alumni include Kevin Appier, Carlos Beltrán, Rich Hill, Mark Prior, Carlos Zambrano, Bo Bichette, Vladimir Guerrero Jr, Danny Janssen, Noah Syndergaard, and Rowdy Tellez.

ABOUT THE ATHLETICS: The Athletics have been on and off in the Midwest League since moving from Kansas City to Oakland for the 1968 season. They were in Burlington from 1968 through 1974. Oakland returned to the Midwest League in 1982 to be the parent club of the Madison Muskies and stayed in Madison through 1993. Oakland's affiliation stayed with the franchise after its move to West Michigan in 1994. Oakland left the league after the 1997 season only to return with Kane County as their affiliate from 2003 through 2010. From there, Oakland went to Burlington (2011-2012), Beloit (2013-2019), and now Lansing since 2021.

PROSPECTING IN THE SERIES: MLB Pipeline places five active Rattlers on their list of Brewers Top 30 Prospects: Jacob Misiorowski (#4), Eric Brown Jr (#6), Robert Moore (#8), Eduardo García (#19), and Matthew Wood (#24). Hendry Mendez (#13) and Joseph Hernandez (#25) are currently on Wisconsin's IL. MLB Pipeline has seven current Lansing players on their Top 30 list of Athletics prospects: Daniel Susac (#4), Max Muncy (#6), Clark Elliott (#15), Brayan Buelvas (#22), Euribiel Angeles (#24), Jacob Watters (#26), and Joelvis Del Rosario (#29).

WISCONSIN SCHEDULED STARTING PITCHER:

RHP STIVEN CRUZ: Signed by Milwaukee as an International Free Agent out of Nicaragua on July 2, 2019.

DELAYED START: Cruz began his pro career with the Brewers-1 affiliate in the Dominican Summer League in 2021. He was 3-3 with a 1.37 ERA and 73 strikeouts over 52-2/3 innings pitched in twelve games – eleven starts.

MUDDY WATERS: Cruz started the 2022 season with the Carolina Mudcats in the Carolina League. He went 3-5 with a 4.60 ERA in fifteen starts for Carolina. Cruz walked 18 and struck out 89 over 72-1/3 innings pitched.

ON TO WISCONSIN: Cruz joined the Timber Rattlers on August 16, 2022. He made four starts with the Rattlers and allowed one run on six hits with six walks and twenty strikeouts over nineteen innings pitched for a 1-1 record with a 0.47ERA.

IT'S A MAJOR AWARD: Cruz beat Lansing at home on August 24, 2022. He allowed a hit with a walk and seven strikeouts over six scoreless innings in the game. Cruz was named the Midwest League Pitcher of the Week on August 29 for this game.

LAST START: Cruz lost had a no decision at Great Lakes on <u>June 16</u>. He allowed five runs on six hits with a homer allowed, two walks, and three strikeouts over three innings. Cruz left the game with the Rattlers trailing 5-0, but Wisconsin rallied for an 8-7 win in ten innings.

VS. LANSING: As mentioned above, Cruz beat the Lugnuts on August 24, 2022 at Neuroscience Group Field. The only hit Cruz allowed in that game was a lead-off double by Gabriel Maciel in the top of the fifth.

LANSING SCHEDULED STARTING PITCHER:

RHP JOSE DICOCHEA: The Athletics selected Dicochea in the eighth round of the 2019 draft out of Sahuarita (AZ) High School.

NOT A WILDCAT: Dicochea signed with the Athletics over a commitment to the University of Arizona. He had 86 strikeouts in 54 innings pitched with a 1.30ERA in his senior season at Sahuarita High School.

GREEN & GOLD: Dicochea pitched for both the A's Arizona League teams in 2019. He was 0-1 in four starts for the Athletics Gold and 0-2 in six games – five starts – for the Athletics Green. In his first pro season, Dicochea was 0-3 with a 10.38 ERA and fourteen walks with fourteen strikeouts over 21-2/3 innings pitched.

CALIFORNIA DREAMING: Dicochea started the 2021 season on the IL of the Stockton Ports and was activated late in the season to go 1-2 in six games – five starts. He would start 2022 on the IL of the Ports and was activated late in the season to go 0-2 in three starts. Dicochea began 2023 healthy in Stockton and was 2-1 in nine games – seven starts – with 47 strikeouts in 39-1/3 innings before his promotion to Michigan on June 13.

LAST START: Dicochea had a no decision at home against Peoria on June 15. He allowed two runs on three hits – including a homer – with two walks and two strikeouts over 4-1/3 innings pitched in his Midwest League debut.

VS. WISCONSIN: Dicochea has never faced the Timber Rattlers prior to this evening. The only time he has faced an affiliate of the Milwaukee Brewers prior to this evening was on August 25, 2019. Dicochea allowed four runs on two hits with three walks and two strikeouts over 1-2/3 innings pitched as the starting pitcher and was charged with the loss in a game against the Brewers Blue. Alex Hall is the only current Rattler to face Dicochea in that game. Hall walked in his only plate appearance against Dicochea.
