LAST ACTION: [The Quad Cities River Bandits beat the Wisconsin Timber Rattlers 15-2 at Neuroscience Group Field on Sunday afternoon.](#)

Quad Cities scored five runs in the second inning and added six runs in the third to take a commanding 11-0 lead. The River Bandits won the final five games of the series with the Rattlers and scored first in all five of their wins.

FIRST TIME: Wisconsin has lost five in a row for the first time this season. Quad Cities outscored Wisconsin 37-7 in the final five games of the just-completed series.

REHAB PARADE: Hoby Milner pitched a perfect fifth inning for the Rattlers in his rehab for the Milwaukee Brewers Sunday afternoon. He had one strikeout and used nine pitches (seven strikes) in his appearance.

DID YOU KNOW? Sunday's game was the first time this season Wisconsin had someone other than Matt Wood or Ramón Rodríguez start the game at catcher. Victor Torres made the start on Sunday for Wisconsin.

FINAL NUMBER: Sunday was Wisconsin's final home game of the regular season, and it drew a crowd of 4,664 fans. Wisconsin drew 229,129 fans to 62 dates for an average attendance of 3,696. There were four rainouts at Neuroscience Group Field in 2024.

ABOUT CEDAR RAPIDS: The current franchise began its existence in 1949 as the Cedar Rapids Rockets, an unaffiliated team in the Central Association. They moved to the Three-I League as the Cedar Rapids Indians as an affiliate of Cleveland in 1950. They were affiliated with the Milwaukee Braves from 1954 through 1962. Cedar Rapids has been called the Braves, Red Raiders, Cardinals, Astros, Giants, and Reds until they became the Kernels in 1993. That was the same year the California Angels became the parent club of the Kernels. That affiliation remained through the 2012 season. Cedar Rapids has been affiliated with the Minnesota Twins since 2013. The Kernels have made the Midwest League playoffs every year they have been affiliated with the Twins, including a Midwest League Championship last season. Notable alumni include Mike Trout, Byron Buxton, Trevor Hoffman, Brewers Pitching Coach Chris Hook, and Ted Simmons. Hall of Famers John McGraw (1891 Canaries) and Lou Boudreau (1938 Raiders) played for earlier pro teams in Cedar Rapids.

ABOUT THE TWINS: Minnesota has a long history of in the Midwest League. They started out with Wisconsin Rapids (1964-1983) and moved to Kenosha (1984-1992) and to Fort Wayne (1993-1998) as the franchise moved around the league. Minnesota has also been with Quad Cities (1999-2004) and Beloit (2005-2012) before their current affiliation with Cedar Rapids Kernels started in 2013.

PROSPECTING IN THE SERIES: [MLB Pipeline](#) places four active Rattlers on their list of Brewers Top 30 Prospects: Cooper Pratt (#2), Luke Adams (#8), Luis Lara (#16), and Jader Areinamo (#21). Blake Burke (#15) is currently on the IL. [MLB Pipeline](#) has five active Kernels on their list of Minnesota prospects: Walker Jenkins (#1), Kaelen Culppepper (#6), Gabriel Gonzalez (#9), Connor Prielipp (#22), and Rubel Cespedes (#24). Rayne Doncon (#19) and Danny DeAndrade (#23) are currently on the IL.

THAT CHAMPIONSHIP SEASON: Cedar Rapids is the reigning Midwest League Champion. The Kernels beat the Peoria Chiefs in Game Three of the best-of-three Western Division Finals and the Great Lakes Loons in Game Three of the best-of-three Championship Series to claim their first Midwest League pennant since 1994. The Kernels were 82-50 during the 2023 regular season to finish last year with the best record in the Midwest League.

WISCONSIN STARTING PITCHER:

RHP STIVEN CRUZ: Signed by Milwaukee as an International Free Agent out of Nicaragua on July 2, 2019.

DELAYED START: Cruz began his pro career with the Brewers-1 affiliate in the Dominican Summer League in 2021. He was 3-3 with a 1.37 ERA and 73 strikeouts over 52-2/3 innings pitched in twelve games – eleven starts.

MUDDY WATERS: Cruz started the 2022 season with the Carolina Mudcats in the Carolina League. He went 3-5 with a 4.60 ERA in fifteen starts for Carolina. Cruz walked 18 and struck out 89 over 72-1/3 innings pitched.

ON TO WISCONSIN: Cruz joined the Timber Rattlers on August 16, 2022. He made four starts with the Rattlers and allowed one run on six hits with six walks and twenty strikeouts over nineteen innings pitched for a 1-1 record with a 0.47ERA. In 2023, Cruz spent the entire season with the Rattlers and was 7-6 with a 6.90 ERA in 24 games – 19 starts.

IT'S A MAJOR AWARD: Cruz beat Lansing at home on August 24, 2022. He allowed a hit with a walk and seven strikeouts over six scoreless innings in the game. Cruz was named the Midwest League Pitcher of the Week on August 29 for this game.

LAST START: Cruz lost to Quad Cities at home on [August 28](#). He allowed two runs on six hits with two walks and three strikeouts over four innings.

VS. CEDAR RAPIDS (2024): Cruz has no record in three games – one start – against the Kernels this season. He has given up one run on six hits with a walk and a strikeout in 5-2/3 innings.

CEDAR RAPIDS STARTING PITCHER:

RHP TY LANGENBERG: The Minnesota Twins selected Langenberg in the eleventh round of the 2023 draft out of the University of Iowa.

LAST YEAR: Langeberg went 6-3 with a 4.15 ERA in seventeen games – fifteen starts – at Iowa. He made his professional debut with the Florida Complex League Twins with two brief relief appearances. Langenberg also made three brief relief appearances with the Ft. Myers Mighty Mussels in the Florida State League last season.

BEFORE THE PROMOTION: Langenberg started 2024 with Ft. Myers. He was 3-3 with a 3.38 ERA and struck out 56 over 48 innings pitched in nine starts. He was promoted to Cedar Rapids on June 11.

LAST START: Langenberg won at Lake County on [August 28](#). He allowed two hits, walked two, and struck out three over six scoreless innings.

VS. WISCONSIN: Langenberg has never pitched against the Timber Rattlers before this evening. Tonight is also his first appearance against an affiliate of the Milwaukee Brewers.
