ABOUT LAST NIGHT: [The Wisconsin Timber Rattlers beat the South Bend Cubs 3-1 at Four Winds Field.](#)

Marco Dinges hit a two-run home run in the top of the sixth inning to break a scoreless tie. Jadher Areinamo had three hits and scored an insurance run on an RBI single by Eduardo Garcia in the seventh. Zach Peek (2IP, 4K, Hold) and Bayden Root (IP, K) closed out the game with three scoreless innings out of the bullpen. The Rattlers have won two straight games to open the series.

IN THE ARENA: Dinges, the reigning Carolina League player of the week, made his first start at catcher for Wisconsin yesterday. His two-run homer was his first Midwest League home run and gave him three RBI in his first two games with the Rattlers. Dinges had three homers and 27 RBI with the Carolina Mudcats before joining Wisconsin on Tuesday. Dinges also had a crucial pickoff of a runner at first in the bottom of the fifth.

MULTI-BALL: Areinamo had his twelfth multi-hit game of the season yesterday. He has two three-hit games this year.

STARTING STRONG: Anthony Flores pitched three scoreless innings as the starting pitcher for Wisconsin. He walked two, hit one, allowed two hits, and struck out four. Flores has not allowed a run over eight innings in his last two starts.

ADD ONE: Blake Burke went 1-for-4 yesterday to extend his on-base streak to 24 games (32-for-94, eleven walks, .410 OBP, .910 OPS).

ABOUT SOUTH BEND: The South Bend Cubs started as the South Bend White Sox when the Midwest League added them as an expansion team in 1988. They changed their name to the Silver Hawks for the 1994 season and became an affiliate of the Arizona Diamondbacks in 1997. South Bend became an affiliate of the Chicago Cubs in 2015. South Bend has won Midwest League titles in 1989, 1993, 2005, 2019, and 2022. Notable alumni for the South Bend franchise include Mike Cameron, Jose Valverde, Chris Capuano, Mark Reynolds, Justin Upton, Wade Miley, Chase Anderson, Keon Broxton, Gleyber Torres, Ian Happ, Carlos Gonzalez, Pete Crow-Armstrong, and current Timber Rattlers manager Victor Estevez. Terry Francona was the manager of the South Bend White Sox in 1982. Nick Lovullo, the son of Arizona Diamondbacks manager Torey Lovullo, is in his second year as South Bend's manager.

ABOUT THE CUBS: The Chicago Cubs had several different Midwest League affiliates before settling in South Bend in 2015. They were affiliated with Quincy from 1965 through 1973 before leaving the Midwest League. The Cubs returned to the MWL for an affiliation with Quad Cities from 1979 through 1984, Peoria from 1985 through 1994 and again from 2005 through 2012, Rockford from 1995 through 1998, Lansing from 1999 through 2004, and Kane County in 2013 and 2014.

PITCHING MATCHUP

WISCONSIN STARTING PITCHER:

RHP TYSON HARDIN: The Milwaukee Brewers selected Hardin in the 12th round of the 2024 draft out of Mississippi State University.

BULLDOG: Hardin was 3-3 and two saves with a 6.59 ERA and 61 strikeouts over 56 innings in forty games – two starts – at Mississippi State.

DAYTONA 500: Hardin pitched two seasons at Daytona State College (2021 and 2022). He was the team's pitcher of the year as a freshman and was 8-5 with two saves in 38 appearances – fifteen starts – at DSC.

BREAKING OUT: Hardin worked two innings in Milwaukee's 2025 Spring Breakout Game against the Cincinnati Reds on [March 16](#). He allowed one hit and struck out three without a walk in two scoreless innings.

AWARD WINNING APRIL: Hardin was named Milwaukee's Minor League Pitcher of the Month for April. He was 2-0 with a 0.96 ERA with four walks and 20 strikeouts over 18-2/3 innings.

WHAT A WEEK: Hardin was named the Midwest League's Pitcher of the Week on May 19 for his seven-inning, complete-game, two-hit shutout against Beloit on May 16.

LAST START: Hardin earned the win against Beloit in game one of a doubleheader at home on [May 16](#) with a complete-game shutout. He allowed two hits, walked none, and struck out six.

VS. SOUTH BEND: Hardin has never faced South Bend prior to this evening. Tonight is also the first time he will pitch against an affiliate of the Chicago Cubs.

SOUTH BEND STARTING PITCHER:

RHP ERICAN RODRIGUEZ: The Chicago Cubs selected Rodriguez in the 13th round of the 2021 draft out of Georgia Premier Academy in Statesboro, Georgia.

PANAMA! Rodriguez was born in Panama City, Panama on November 11, 2001. He had a commitment to Northwest Florida State College but chose to sign with the Cubs.

THE FIRST TWO YEARS: Rodriguez did not pitch professionally in 2021. He went 2-2 in eleven games – one start – for the Cubs Arizona Complex League team in 2022 with an ERA of 11.57, ten walks, and fifteen strikeouts over 11-2/3 innings. In 2023, he was 5-6 with a 6.49 ERA in 26 games – three starts – for Myrtle Beach. In 69-1/3 innings, Rodriguez walked 45 and struck out 74 with an ERA of 6.49.

ON THE BEACH: Rodriguez started the 2024 season back in Myrtle Beach. He was 3-3 with a 3.29 ERA in thirteen games – two starts – and struck out 41 with sixteen strikeouts over 41 innings. He was promoted to South Bend on June 18, 2024 and went 1-2 with a 3.52 ERA in eleven starts in the Midwest League for the rest of 2024.

LAST START: Rodriguez completed a rehab assignment with the ACL Cubs with a start against the ACL Brewers on [May 15](#). He allowed two runs on five hits with a walk and a strikeout. Jeferson Quero homered for the Brewers off Rodriguez.

VS. WISCONSIN: Rodriguez had two no decisions against Wisconsin in two starts last season. He allowed five runs on seven hits with seven walks and three strikeouts over seven innings.
