ABOUT LAST NIGHT: The Wisconsin Timber Rattlers beat the Peoria Chiefs 8-7 in ten innings. Wisconsin rallied from deficits of 6-0 and 7-3 to beat the Chiefs in extra innings on an Eduarqui Fernández RBI single in the bottom of the tenth. The largest previous deficit the Rattlers had rallied from to win this season had been

AYRAULT'S ELEVEN: The Timber Rattlers had eleven hits last night and all eleven were singles.

WHAT A TURN AROUND: Wisconsin was 26-for-165 (.158) with two outs and runners in scoring position heading into last night's game. They were 0-for-2 in that situation through the first six innings last night. In the seventh and eighth innings, Wisconsin was 4-for-6 with runners in scoring position and two outs. In the eighth, Robert Moore got the Rattlers to within 7-6 with a two-out, RBI single. Matt Wood tied the game with a two-out, RBI single moments later.

STRANDING THEM: Karlos Morales entered the game with the bases loaded and two outs in the top of the eighth. He got the final out on a force out at second. Morales has inherited eleven runners this season and hasn't allowed any to score.

A GOOD WOODY WORD: Wood was 3-for-3 with two walks to reach base in all five of his plate appearances. He drew a bases-loaded walk in the seventh inning to go with his RBI single in the eighth.

DO NOT RUN: Joe Gray Jr picked up his second outfield assist of the season when he threw out Jeremy Rivas at the plate in the top of the ninth. Rivas tried to score from first on a double by Osvaldo Tovalin. Wisconsin outfielders have twelve assists this season.

MEET THE METZ: Wisconsin first baseman Ben Metzinger spoiled a sacrifice bunt in the top of the tenth by throwing out the runner trying to advance to second. He also started an inning-ending 3-2-3 double play.

MORE THAN A WALKOFF WINNER: Fernandez had an RBI single in the seventh, walked and scored in the eighth, and had the game-winning hit in the tenth.

ABOUT PEORIA: The Peoria Chiefs were in the Three-I League from 1953-1958 before the team folded. They were a St. Louis Cardinals affiliate from 1953-1957 and a New York Yankees affiliate in 1958. The Chiefs re-entered organized baseball when the Danville franchise moved to Peoria after the 1982 season. They were named the Peoria Suns and were affiliated with the California Angels for 1983 and 1984 with a change to the Chiefs nickname for 1984 followed by an affiliation switch to the Chicago Cubs for the 1985 season. Peoria became the Cardinals Midwest League affiliate for the first time in 1995, switched back to the Cubs in 2005, and went back to the Cardinals in 2013. The Chiefs won a Midwest League title in 2002. They made the Midwest League Championship Series in 2018 but lost to Bowling Green. Patrick Anderson is in his second year as Peoria's manager. Notable former Chiefs include Greg Maddux, Mark Grace, Albert Pujols, and Yadier Molina

ABOUT THE CARDINALS: St. Louis had several different Midwest League affiliates before settling back in Peoria in 2013. They were in Cedar Rapids from 1965-1972 before leaving the league until returning to the league to affiliate with the Springfield, Illinois team from 1982 through 1993. St. Louis spent one year with the Madison Hatters before their first affiliation with Peoria from 1995 through 2004. The Cardinals left Peoria for Quad Cities from 2005 through 2012.

PROSPECTING IN THE SERIES: MLB Pipeline places five active Rattlers on their list of Brewers Top 30 Prospects: Eric Brown Jr (#6), Robert Moore (#8), Eduardo García (#19), Matthew Wood (#24), and Joseph Hernandez (#25). Hendry Mendez (#13) is currently on Wisconsin's IL. MLB Pipeline has six Peoria players on their list of Top 30 Cardinals prospects: Tink Hence (#3), Cooper Hjerpe (#6), Jimmy Crooks (#15), Ian Bedell (#24), Dionys Rodriguez (#26), and Victor Scott II (#27). Inohan Paniagua (#17), Austin Love (#19), and Zane Mills (#30) are on Peoria's IL.

PITCHING MATCHUP

WISCONSIN SCHEDULED STARTING PITCHER:

RHP EDWIN JIMENEZ: Milwaukee signed Jimenez as an International Free Agent out of Venezuela on October 11, 2018.

HEADING TO THE CO-OP: Jimenez was assigned to the Dominican Summer League Co-op team shared between Milwaukee and Cleveland for the 2019 season. Jimenez was 1-5 with a 3.05 ERA in twelve games – eight starts. He walked 26 and struck out 32 over 41-1/3 innings in his first professional season.

FROM THE ISLAND TO THE DESERT: Jimenez started the 2021 season with Milwaukee's number two affiliate in the Dominican Summer League. He was assigned to the Brewers Blue affiliate in the Arizona Complex League on August 7, 2021. Jimenez went 1-1 with a 1.72 ERA in five games – four starts – in the DSL and 0-4 with a save and a 5.25 ERA in the ACL. He walked twelve and struck out 48 over 39-2/3 innings combined between his two stops in the system that season.

CAROLINA ON MY MIND: Jimenez was 4-7 in 25 games – seventeen starts – with the Carolina Mudcats in 2022. He had a 4.75 ERA, walked 41, and struck out 104 over 113-2/3 innings pitched in the Carolina League last season. Jimenez started the 2023 season with Carolina and went 2-0 in four games – one start – with five walks and 23 strikeouts over eighteen innings before his promotion to Wisconsin on May 2.

LAST START: Jimenez picked up the win when he made his first start as a Timber Rattler on May 25 at Cedar Rapids. He allowed two runs on four hits with a walk and five strikeouts over five innings.

VS. PEORIA: Jimenez has made two relief appearances – May 2 and May 7 – against the Chiefs this season. He allowed a run on three hits with no walks and eight strikeouts over six innings in the two appearances against the Chiefs.

PEORIA SCHEDULED STARTING PITCHER:

RHP DIONYS RODRÍGUEZ: The Cardinals signed Rodríguez as an International Free Agent out of the Dominican Republic in 2018.

AND TO THE REPUBLIC: Rodríguez pitched of the Dominican Summer League affiliate of the Cardinals in 2018 and 2019.

WILD PALMS: Rodríguez pitched for Palm Beach in 2021 and made 22 appearances – twelve starts – for the Cardinals that season. He was 4-5 with 22 walks, 88 strikeouts, and a 3.36 ERA in 69-2/3 innings pitched.

LAST YEAR IN PEORIA: Rodríguez was 3-11 with a 4.59 ERA in 27 games – 25 starts – for the Chiefs in 2022. He had 119 strikeouts over 121-2/3 innings last season.

HOW DOES HE RATE? MLB Pipeline has listed Rodríguez as the #26 prospect in the St. Louis system.

LAST START: Rodríguez <u>lost to Great Lakes on May 25 at home</u>. He allowed two runs on five hits with two walks and two strikeouts over 5-2/3 innings pitched.

VS. WISCONSIN (2023): Rodríguez has made three relief appearances – <u>April 7</u>, <u>April 11</u>, and <u>May 7</u> – and a start on <u>May 2</u> against Wisconsin this season. He is 1-0 against the Rattlers with a win in relief on May 7. Rodriguez has allowed six runs on eight hits with seven walks and nine strikeouts over 11-1/3 innings in his four appearances against Wisconsin this year.

VS. WISCONSIN (2022): Rodríguez went 1-1 in four starts against the Timber Rattlers last season. He had a no decision at Wisconsin in game two of a doubleheader on April 10, lost to the Rattlers at home on April 28, beat the Rattlers at Wisconsin on June 2, and had a no decision in Peoria on August 31 despite pitching five no-hit innings. Rodríguez allowed one run on twelve hits with nine walks and twenty strikeouts over 19 innings against Wisconsin in 2022.
