### SUNDAY IN THE PARK: [The Wisconsin Timber Rattlers beat the Quad Cities River Bandits 5-1 at Modern Woodmen Park in the series finale.](#)

The Timber Rattlers earned a split in the series with the win. Wisconsin broke a 1-1 tie with four runs in the top of the eighth inning. Jadhver Areinamo put the Rattlers up 3-1 with a two-run double. Blake Burke added an RBI single, and Eduardo Garcia capped the inning with an RBI double.

**IN CONTROL:** Wisconsin pitchers did not walk a batter on Sunday at Quad Cities. In the last four games of the series with the Bandits, Wisconsin pitchers walked four and struck out 47. The Timber Rattlers staff has walked the fewest opposing batters (27) in the High-A classification of Minor League Baseball through the first nine games of the season.

**STARTING STRONG:** Rattlers starting pitchers allowed four runs and struck out 32 with only seven walks in 29-1/3 innings during the six-game series at Quad Cities. Tyson Hardin, the Wisconsin starter in game one and game six of the series, pitched nine scoreless innings, allowed four hits, walked one, and struck out nine. The Rattlers won both of his starts.

**STAYING HOT:** Garcia extended his team-hit hitting streak to five games (7-for-21, .333) and his team-high on-base streak to seven (OBP: .387) with his RBI double on Sunday. Sunday's double was his fifth of the season. Garcia is tied with three other players in the Midwest League in doubles.

**PLAYING IT CLOSE:** The last four games of the six-game series at Quad Cities were tied in the eighth inning. In game two on Wednesday, Quad Cities won 1-0 with the only run scoring on a two-out double in the seventh. In game one last Tuesday, Wisconsin had a 2-0 lead before adding two insurance runs in the top of the sixth.

**PLAYING IT CLEAN:** Wisconsin's defense committed two errors in the series at Quad Cities. They were error-free in the final three games.

**ABOUT THE LANSING LUGNUTS:** The Lugnuts began their existence as the Lafayette (IN) Chiefs of the Mississippi-Ohio Valley League in 1955. Lafayette became the Red Sox in 1956 and as the Mississippi-Ohio Valley League became the Midwest League. The franchise moved Waterloo, Iowa in 1958 and remained there as the Hawks, Royals, Indians, and Diamonds until the end of the 1993 season. New ownership bought the team and moved them to Springfield, Illinois for two seasons before finally locating the team in Lansing, Michigan in 1996. Since they started in Lansing, the Lugnuts were affiliated with the Kansas City Royals (1996-1998), the Chicago Cubs (1999-2004), the Toronto Blue Jays (2005-2019), and the Athletics. The Lugnuts won Midwest League titles in 1997 and 2003. Notable Lansing alumni include Kevin Appier, Carlos Beltrán, Rich Hill, Mark Prior, Carlos Zambrano, Bo Bichette, Vladimir Guerrero Jr, Danny Janssen, Noah Syndergaard, and Rowdy Tellez.

**ABOUT THE ATHLETICS:** The Athletics have been on and off in the Midwest League since the 1968 season. They were in Burlington from 1968 through 1974 before leaving the league. The A's returned to the Midwest League in 1982 to be the parent club of the Madison Muskies and stayed in Madison through 1993. Their affiliation stayed with the franchise after its move to West Michigan in 1994. The Athletics left the league again after the 1997 season only to return with Kane County as their affiliate from 2003 through 2010. From there, they went to Burlington (2011-2012), Beloit (2013-2019), and now Lansing since 2021.

## WISCONSIN STARTING PITCHER:

**RHP RYAN BIRCHARD:** The Milwaukee Brewers selected Birchard in the 5<sup>th</sup> round of the 2023 draft out of the Niagara County Community College.

**PLAYER OF THE YEAR:** Birchard was name the Western New York Athletic Conference Player of the Year in 2023. He was 8-0 in ten games – nine starts – with a 1.08 ERA and 95 strikeouts over fifty innings pitched. Birchard was also named a First Team All-NJCAA Division III All-American in 2023.

**QUICK TRIP TO TRENTON:** Birchard made four appearances – two starts – for Trenton in the MLB Draft League after the end of his college season. He allowed one run, walked one, and struck out sixteen over nine innings before signing with Milwaukee.

**DELAYED START:** Birchard did not pitch professionally in 2023. He made a start for the Carolina Mudcats on April 6, 2024 (4.0IP, H, R, 0ER, 2BB, 6K) but was placed on the IL after that game. He next pitched with the ACL Brewers on July 16 and July 22. Birchard rejoined Carolina for appearances on July 28 and August 3 before being sent to Wisconsin on August 13.

**AS A RATTLER (2024):** Birchard made five regular season starts for Wisconsin last season. He was 0-3 with an 8.71 ERA. He walked fourteen and struck out thirteen in 10-1/3 innings with the Timber Rattlers

**LAST START:** Birchard had a no decision at Quad Cities on [April 9](#) for his 2025 debut. He allowed a hit, walked four, and struck out four over 3-2/3 scoreless innings.

**VS. LANSING:** Birchard has never faced the Lugnuts before tonight's game. He made a start against the ACL Athletics on [July 16, 2024](#) his first game back from an injury that halted his season in April. Birchard allowed one run on two hits with no walks and two strikeouts in one inning for a no decision.

## LANSING SCHEDULED STARTING PITCHER:

**RHP JAKE GARLAND:** The Athletics selected Garland in the seventeenth round of the 2022 draft out of the University of Miami.

**ROCK YOU LIKE A HURRICANE:** Garland pitched three seasons at Miami. He was 13-6 with a save and a 4.67 ERA in 36 games – 25 starts. Garland was 6-2 with a save a 3.99 ERA in fourteen games – twelve starts – in his final season at Miami.

**IN CONTROL:** Garland issued 30 walks in 142-2/3 innings pitched during his career at Miami.

**CLIMBING THE LADDER:** Garland started his pro career in the Arizona Complex League in 2022 and was 0-1 in three games – one start. He began the 2023 season with Stockton in the California League and was 1-2 in six games – four starts. He walked eight and struck out 31 in 32-1/3 innings pitched before a promotion to Lansing on May 16, 2023. Garland finished 2023 4-9 with a 6.40 ERA in eighteen games – fifteen starts. Last season, he was 6-6 with a 3.75 ERA in 25 games – fourteen starts – with Lansing. Garland also made one start with Midland in the Texas League and one start with Las Vegas in the Pacific Coast League in 2024.

**LAST START:** Garland lost to Great Lakes at home on [April 8](#). He allowed seven runs on ten hits with a walk and five strikeouts over 4-1/3 innings.

**VS. WISCONSIN:** Garland beat Wisconsin at Neuroscience Group Field on [June 23, 2023](#). He allowed two runs on eight hits with a walk and a strikeout over five innings.
