ABOUT LAST NIGHT: The Beloit Sky Carp defeated the Wisconsin Timber Rattlers 6-4 at ABC Supply Stadium. Wisconsin had a 4-1 lead, but Beloit rallied with a run in the sixth, a run in the seventh, and three runs in the eighth to beat Wisconsin. Beloit scored all six of their runs after there were two outs.

MR. SMITH GOES TO BELOIT: Russell Smith was the Wisconsin starting pitcher last night. He allowed two runs over 5-2/3 innings. Smith set a new single-game high as a pro for strikeouts with eight.

IT'S BEEN A WHILE: Cam Robinson entered the game in the eighth inning last night to protect a 4-3 lead. The Wisconsin closer had not allowed a run since April 28 and his scoreless inning streak had reached 18-1/3 innings. The Sky Carp had a runner at third with two outs when Bennett Hostetler singled on a 2-2 pitch to drive in the tying run. Dalvy Rosario followed with an RBI triple. Davis Bradshaw capped the inning with an RBI double. Last night was just the second blown save of the season for Robinson and his scoreless inning streak ended at nineteen.

EXTRA MILE: Wisconsin had six hits last night and four of them were extra-base hits. Tyler Black had an RBI double and an RBI triple for the Rattlers. Ethan Murray and Alex Hall each had a double.

ABOUT BELOIT: The Beloit Sky Carp are in their first season as the Sky Carp and their second season as an affiliate of the Miami Marlins. Beloit started as the Beloit Brewers in 1982 as the Midwest League affiliate of Milwaukee. They changed their name to the Beloit Snappers for the 1995 season. The Snappers affiliation with Milwaukee ended after the 2004 season. They were affiliated with the Minnesota Twins (2005-2012) and the Oakland Athletics (2013-2019) over their final seasons in the Midwest League. The Snappers said "Goodbye" to Pohlman Field on July 11, 2021 and moved into Al <u>Supply Stadium on August 3.</u> Jorge Hernandez is in his first season as the manager of the Sky Carp.

ABOUT THE MARLINS: The Florida/Miami Marlins have a history in the Midwest League. The Marlins' first Low-A affiliate was the Kane County Cougars from 1993 through 2002. Josh Beckett, Adrian Gonzalez, Dontrelle Willis, Miguel Cabrera, and former Timber Rattlers manager Matt Erickson all played for the Cougars in that timespan The Marlins returned to the Midwest League in in 2019 to affiliate with the Clinton LumberKings. The Marlins landed in Beloit after MLB reset the affiliations for 2021.

PROSPECTING IN THE SERIES: MLB Pipeline puts six active Rattlers on their list of Brewers Top 30 Prospects: Tyler Black (#6), Joe Gray Jr. (#13), Antoine Kelly (#14), Russell Smith (#16), Zavier Warren (#17), and Cam Robinson (#26). Carlos Rodríguez (#21) is on the Wisconsin injured list. MLB Pipeline has six current Sky Carp on their Top 30 list of Miami Marlins prospects: Dax Fulton (#9), Victor Mesa Jr. (#14), Cody Morissette (#16), Nasim Nunez (#18), Evan Fitterer (#19), and Tanner Allen (#23).

PITCHING MATCHUP

WISCONSIN SCHEDULED STARTING PITCHER:

LHP ANTOINE KELLY: Selected by the Brewers in the second round of the 2019 draft out of Wabash Valley College in Mt. Carmel, Illinois. He is rated as the #14 prospect in the Brewers system by MLB Pipeline. *Baseball America* places Kelly at #10 for their in-season update of Milwaukee prospects.

WARRIORS...COME OUT TO PLAY: Kelly was 9-0 with 112 strikeouts in thirteen starts for the Warriors prior to the draft. He allowed 21 hits, 19 earned runs, and 31 walks over 52-2/3 innings pitched at Wabash Valley College

SAYING NO TO SAN DIEGO: The San Diego Padres selected Kelly in the thirteenth round of the 2018 draft after his senior season at Maine East High School in Park Ridge, Illinois. Kelly chose junior college over signing with the Padres

THE BOYHOOD DREAM COMES TRUE: Kelly has been a Milwaukee Brewers fan since he was young.

WHAT'S BREWING? Kelly made his pro debut in the AZL with the Brewers Blue and made one start for the Rattlers in 2019. He spent 2020 with the Brewers Alternate Training Site. He underwent surgery for Thoracic Outlet Syndrome on November 5, 2020 and has worked his way back to Wisconsin after a relief appearance in Arizona and seven starts with Carolina before joining the Rattlers near the end of the 2021 season.

LAST START: Kelly had a <u>no decision against Peoria at home on June 3</u>. He allowed two runs on four hits with three walks and three strikeouts over four innings.

VS. BELOIT (2022): Kelly has made two starts against the Sky Carp this season, both at Beloit. He had a <u>no decision on April 12</u> and another <u>no decision on April 17</u>. He has allowed four runs on five hits with six walks and twelve strikeouts over 8-2/3 innings against the Sky Carp this season.

BELOIT SCHEDULED STARTING PITCHER:

LHP PATRICK MONTEVERDE: The Marlins selected Monteverde in the 8th round of the 2021 draft out of Texas Tech.

RED RAIDER: Monteverde was 7-4 with a 3.75 ERA in sixteen starts at Texas Tech. He walked 21 and struck out 101 in 86-1/3 innings pitched.

BEFORE TEXAS: Monteverde pitched for Virginia Wesleyan University in 2017 as went 7-2 with a 1.96 ERA to be named Rookie of the Year in the Old Dominion Athletic Conference. He transferred to Seton Hill University in Greensburg, PA for 2018 and suffered a UCL injury in 2019. Transferred to Texas Tech for 2021.

TO THE PROS: Monteverde went to the Marlins affiliate in the Florida Complex League after signing with Miami. He was 2-for-2 in save opportunities in six relief appearances last season. Monteverde also made one start. He had a 3.07 ERA, walked four, and struck out sixteen over 14-2/3 innings pitched as a pro last season.

DID YOU KNOW: Monteverde faced Timber Rattlers pitcher Russell Smith in a Big XII game between <u>Texas Tech and TCU on May 28, 2021.</u> TCU won the game 7-2. Smith allowed two runs on three hits and struck out ten for the win. Monteverde allowed four runs – two earned – on six hits with six strikeouts over six innings to take the loss.

LAST START: Monteverde had a <u>no decision at home against Lansing on May 25</u>. He allowed three runs on six hits, including two home runs, with a walk and seven strikeouts over five innings

VS. WISCONSIN (2022): Monteverde had a <u>no decision against the Timber Rattlers in game one of a doubleheader on April 14 at home</u>. He allowed three hits, walked three, and struck out six over 4-2/3 scoreless innings.
