INDY BITS

ABOUT SUNDAY: The Indianapolis Indians jumped on top of the Memphis Redbirds with a run in the first inning and never looked back as they backed an impressive start from Thomas Harrington and secured a series split with a 6-2 victory on Sunday afternoon at AutoZone Park. Jack Suwinski opened the scoring for the Indians in the first with an RBI single to drive in Matt Fraizer, who reached on a leadoff walk before swiping second and third to set up the run. Indy added a trio of runs in the third when Liover Peguero, DJ Stewart and Shawn Ross each scored doubles and Frazier brought Ross around to score with an RBI single of his own. Indy capped its scoring with a pair of runs in the fifth as Suwinski tripled and scored on a double from Darick Hall, who scored Indy's sixth run on a DJ Stewart single. Indy held Memphis scoreless until the ninth, when they rallied to plate two runs with two outs, but it wasn't enough to overcome the deficit. Righty Zach Plesac took the loss for Memphis in his season debut. Harrington allowed just two hits and no runs across 6.0 innings. Eddy Yean and Hunter Stratton each bridged to the ninth with a clean frame of their own.

HARRI STYLES: Thomas Harrington tossed his second consecutive quality start on Sunday, blanking Memphis across 6.0 innings on two hits, two walks and three strikeouts. It marked his first scoreless appearance since his season debut on April 13 at St. Paul and first scoreless quality start since 7.0 frames on Aug. 17, 2024, vs. St. Paul. He has thrown 5.0-plus innings in six of his last eight starts since April 29 at Omaha. His two hits allowed were the fewest allowed in a start this season.

JACK ATTACK: Jack Suwinski extended his on-base streak to 10 games on Sunday, going 2-for-5 with one triple, one RBI and one run. It was his first triple since Aug. 28, 2024 (1), vs. Louisville. It was his seventh multi-hit game of the campaign and third in his last six games. In the 10-game run since May 28, Suwinski is hitting .278 (10-for-36) with one double, one triple, two home runs, nine RBI, five walks, nine runs, two stolen bases and a .914 OPS in this span. Since his season debut on April 25, Suwinski leads the team in total bases (56), home runs (7) and RBI (29).

SOLAK ECLIPSE: Among all minor leaguers with at least 30 games played, Nick Solak ranks second in batting average (.381), third in OPS (1.055) and fifth in SLG (.619). He has reached base safely in 31 of 35 games this season and has one-plus hit in 30 of those. Going 0-for-5 on Sunday, Solak's 10-game hitting streak concluded. It was his second double-digit hitting streak on the campaign, including a team best 13-game hitting streak from April 3-23. He tallied five RBI with a trio of hits on Thursday last week, marking the most RBI in a single game by an Indy batter since Joshua Palacios' five RBI on Sept. 8, 2024, at Toledo and Solak's most in a game since Aug. 28, 2022, with Round Rock at Albuquerque.

DAZZLING DAURI: The Indians roster features one major league rehabber, right-hander Dauri Moreta. Moreta was placed on the 60-day injured list on Feb. 16 after undergoing Tommy John surgery and being sidelined for the entire 2024 season. Nearly 14 months after his last professional appearance, the right-hander began a rehab assignment with High-A Bradenton on April 29 and tossed 2.0 scoreless innings in two games. He has since pitched to a 4.22 ERA (5er/10.2ip) with Indy, allowing seven hits while striking out 16 across his 13 appearances dating back to May 6.

SOMEONE COOKED HERE: Billy Cook went 2-for-5 with one run on Saturday, posting four straight games in which he reached base safely multiple times. He reached four times on Wednesday and Thursday, and three times on Friday last week at Memphis. He extended his hitting streak to six games, collecting two-plus hits in three straight games and five of those six overall. It marks his first string of three consecutive multi-hit performances since Sept. 6-8, 2024. He has hit safely in 12 of his last 13 games with an official at-bat dating back to May 23 at Toledo. In that span, he is hitting .385 (20-for-52) with four doubles, four RBI, eight walks, seven runs and four stolen bases. Thursday night marked his first multi-steal game since Sept. 5, 2023, with Double-A Bowie vs. New Hampshire. He drew three walks on Wednesday, his most since walking three times on Sept. 2, 2024, at Toledo.

SIMON SAYS: Ronny Simon launched the second pitch of the game 407 feet to right-center field for a leadoff homer on Saturday night. It was Indy's first leadoff blast since Nick Gonzales on Aug. 22, 2024, at Columbus. Simon finished 1-for-4 with the homer and a walk in that game. He made his mark in his Indians debut, going 2-for-4 with a stolen base on Friday night. It marked his third multi-hit game of the campaign, last doing so with Jacksonville at Memphis on April 15. He joined the Indians this week after being claimed by Pittsburgh on June 2. The 25-year-old was designated for assignment by Miami on May 30. In 19 games for the Marlins this season, he hit .234 (11-for-47) with two doubles, five RBI, seven walks and six runs. He made his major league debut on April 21 vs. Cincinnati, collecting his first major league hit and RBI off Nick Lodolo with a single up the middle.

SERIES PREVIEW: The Indianapolis Indians begin a seven-game series at Victory Field against the St. Paul Saints at 7:05 PM. The two teams meet for the third time this season, with Indy trailing the season series, 3-5. The Indians opened the season in St. Paul, losing on Opening Day on March 28, 11-0. The final two games of that series were postponed due to inclement weather. The Indians returned to St. Paul from April 22-27, losing four of seven games. One game was postponed which accounts for Game 2 of Thursday night's seven-inning doubleheader this week. Indy seeks its third straight series win at Victory Field over the Saints. Indianapolis is 13-1 at Victory Field against St. Paul since April 15, 2023, and are winners of seven straight at the venue since April 21, 2024.

TONIGHT'S MATCHUP: Right-hander Carmen Mlodzinski takes the mound for the Indians, set to make his fourth start of the season. Mlodzinski has allowed just two runs in 15.2 innings this season on 11 hits, seven walks and 16 strikeouts. He began the campaign with 11.1 consecutive scoreless innings. He struck out a career-high 10 batters in his first career Triple-A start on May 23 at Toledo. Mlodzinski has made six career appearances against the Saints, allowing five runs (four earned) across 9.0 innings. Opposite Mlodzinski is Saints right-hander Travis Adams. He is set to make his second consecutive start, third start of the season and 14th game on the campaign. Tonight will mark his third game against Indianapolis this season. He tossed 4.0 scoreless frames on April 22 and 3.0 innings of three-run ball on April 16, both at St. Paul. He is 0-2 with a 3.60 ERA (4er/10.0ip) in three career games against the Indians. Tonight is his first career start against Indy.

ON THIS DATE IN 1954: Two female second basemen were featured in the Indianapolis Clowns season-opening game against the Kansas City Monarchs. Connie Morgan played second for the Clowns, and Toni Stone for the Monarchs. Kansas City won the game, 9-8.

TONIGHT'S PITCHER

Carmen Mlodzinski: Mlodzinski is making his fourth start with the Indians after being optioned by Pittsburgh on May 21.

Bucco Aboard: In nine starts with Pittsburgh this season, Mlodzinski posted a 1-4 record, 5.67 ERA (25er/39.2ip), 52 hits, 12 walks and 28 strikeouts. He has appeared in 84 games (14 starts) with the Pirates since 2023, posting a 9-12 record, 3.78 ERA (53er/126.1ip), 121 hits, 29 walks, four hit batters and 108 strikeouts.

Indianapolis: Mlodzinski made 15 appearances for the Indians last season, posting an 0-1 record and a 6.75 ERA (13er/17.1ip), pitching exclusively from the bullpen. In 38 career games with Indy, he is 3-4 with a 3.65 ERA (23er/56.2ip) with 58 hits, 27 walks, two hit batters and 66 strikeouts.

Last Outing: Mlodzinski earned his second win of the season, tossing 5.0 innings of one-run ball on June 3 at Memphis, allowing four hits and two walks with one strikeout.

Against the Saints: Mlodzinski has made six career appearances against the Saints, allowing five runs (four earned) across 9.0 innings.

Major League Debut: Mlodzinski made his major league debut with Pittsburgh on June 16, 2023, at Milwaukee, tossing 1.1 innings. He allowed a solo home run to Joey Wiener and struck out Blake Perkins looking for his first career punchout.

Miscellaneous: Mlodzinski was selected by Pittsburgh in the first round (31st overall) of the 2020 First-Year Player Draft out of South Carolina University (Columbia).

2025 Highlights

» Entered the season rated as the No. 12 prospect in Pittsburgh's farm system according to *Baseball America* and No. 18 according to MLB Pipeline.

» Finished a homer shy of the cycle on 4/15 vs. Toledo; apart of a six-game hitting streak from 4/12 (1)-4/17 in which he hit .391 (9-for-23) with four extra-base hits and a 1.071 OPS.

» Has racked up multiple hits in five of his six games played in June and in seven of 11 games dating back to 5/26 vs. Nashville; he leads qualified International League hitters since 5/26 in batting average (.405, 17-for-42), is tied for the lead in hits and ranks seventh in on-base percentage (.468).
