ABOUT LAST NIGHT: The Wisconsin Timber Rattlers and Peoria Chiefs each came away with a win.

Wisconsin won the conclusion of Friday's suspended game 8-1. Peoria won the seven-inning game that followed 5-2.

GAME ONE: Peoria tied the game 1-1 with an RBI single in the top of the seventh by Johnfrank Salazar. Eduardo Garcia put Wisconsin back in front with a two-out, two-run double in the bottom of the seventh. The Rattlers added another run in the seventh and four in the eighth to put the game away for their third win in a row.

GAME TWO: Wisconsin had a 2-0 lead after two runs scored in the bottom of the second inning. The Chiefs scored single runs in the fourth, fifth, and sixth inning to take the lead. They added a pair of runs in the seventh.

HISTORY: Luke Adams was hit by a pitch in the third inning of game two. Adams has tied Nick Sanay of the 2017 Lansing Lugnuts for the Midwest League record for times being hit by a pitch. Adams also walked and singled in the game to raise his league-leading OBP to .448.

ABOUT PEORIA: The Peoria Chiefs were in the Three-I League from 1953-1958 before the team folded. They were a St. Louis Cardinals affiliate from 1953-1957 and a New York Yankees affiliate in 1958. The Chiefs re-entered organized baseball when the Danville franchise moved to Peoria after the 1982 season. They were named the Peoria Suns and were affiliated with the California Angels for 1983 and 1984 with a change to the Chiefs nickname for 1984 followed by an affiliation switch to the Chicago Cubs for the 1985 season. Peoria became the Cardinals Midwest League affiliate for the first time in 1995, switched back to the Cubs in 2005, and went back to the Cardinals in 2013. The Chiefs won a Midwest League title in 2002. They made the Midwest League Championship Series in 2018 but lost to Bowling Green. Patrick Anderson is in his third year as Peoria's manager. Notable former Chiefs include Greg Maddux, Mark Grace, Albert Pujols, Yadier Molina, Nolan Gorman, and Victor Scott II.

ABOUT THE CARDINALS: St. Louis had several different Midwest League affiliates before settling back in Peoria in 2013. They were in Cedar Rapids from 1965-1972 before leaving the league until returning to the league to affiliate with the Springfield, Illinois team from 1982 through 1993. St. Louis spent one year with the Madison Hatters before their first affiliation with Peoria from 1995 through 2004. The Cardinals left Peoria for Quad Cities from 2005 through 2012.

PROSPECTING IN THE SERIES: [MLB Pipeline](#) places six active Rattlers on their list of Brewers Top 30 Prospects: Cooper Pratt (#4), Luis Lara (#8), Luke Adams (#15), Jadhver Areinamo (#21), Patricio Aquino (#28), Ryan Birchard (#30). [MLB Pipeline](#) has six Peoria players on their list of Top 30 Cardinals prospects: Chase Davis (#6), Leonardo Bernal (#8), Won-Bin Cho (#10), Brycen Mautz (#20), Zach Levenson (#21), and Pete Hansen (#25).

SECOND HALF CHIEFS: Peoria is 23-24 in the second half. They are one game behind Quad Cities for the second half West Division playoff spot. They will start a home series with Fort Wayne on Tuesday. In 2023, Peoria won the second half West Division playoff spot but lost to Cedar Rapids in the first round.

PITCHING MATCHUP

WISCONSIN STARTING PITCHER:

RHP RYAN BIRCHARD: The Milwaukee Brewers selected Birchard in the 5th round of the 2023 draft out of the Niagara County Community College. MLB Pipeline rates Birchard as the #30 prospect in the Milwaukee organization.

PLAYER OF THE YEAR: Birchard was named the Western New York Athletic Conference Player of the Year in 2023. He was 8-0 in ten games – nine starts – with a 1.08 ERA and 95 strikeouts over fifty innings pitched. Birchard was also named a First Team All-NJCAA Division III All-American in 2023.

QUICK TRIP TO TRENTON: Birchard made four appearances – two starts – for Trenton in the MLB Draft League after the end of his college season. He allowed one run, walked one, and struck out sixteen over nine innings before signing with Milwaukee.

DELAYED START: Birchard did not pitch professionally in 2023. He made a start for the Carolina Mudcats on April 6 (4.0IP, H, R, 0ER, 2BB, 6K) but was placed on the IL after that game. He next pitched with the ACL Brewers on July 16 and July 22. Birchard rejoined Carolina for appearances on July 28 and August 3 before being sent to Wisconsin on August 13.

LAST START: Birchard lost to Peoria at home on [August 13](#). He allowed five runs – four earned – on seven hits with a walk and three strikeouts over three innings.

VS. PEORIA: Birchard had never faced the Chiefs prior to the game on August 13. That was also the first time he pitched against an affiliate of the St. Louis Cardinals.

PROFESSIONAL BESTS:

INNINGS PITCHED: 4.0 – 4/6/2024 at Salem

STRIKEOUTS: 6 – 4/6/2024 at Salem

PEORIA STARTING PITCHER:

LHP IXAN HENDERSON: The St. Louis Cardinals selected Henderson in the 8th round of the 2023 draft out of Fresno State University.

BULLDOG: Henderson pitched three seasons for Fresno State. He was 12-9 with a 4.18 ERA in 46 games – 33 starts – during his collegiate career. Henderson walked 94 and struck out 230 in 202-1/3 innings at Fresno State.

TIME ON THE BEACH: Henderson made four brief relief appearances with 3-2/3 scoreless innings for the Palm Beach Cardinals of the Florida State League in 2023. He started the 2024 season in Palm Beach and was 6-2 with a save and a 2.10 ERA in sixteen games – eleven starts. Henderson walked 27 and struck out 79 in 73 innings for Palm Beach before his promotion to Peoria on July 30, 2024.

HOW DO YOU SAY? Ixan is pronounced EE-shawn.

LAST START: Henderson had a no decision against Cedar Rapids at home on [August 11](#). He allowed three runs on six hits with a walk and five strikeouts over four innings.

VS. WISCONSIN: Henderson has never pitched against the Timber Rattlers prior to this afternoon. Today is also the first time he will face an affiliate of the Milwaukee Brewers.
