THE SURGE - The Wichita Wind Surge continue a six game home series today against the defending Texas League Champion Arkansas Travelers. The Travs won the second half, last season and won the league title for the first time since 2008.

VS TRAVS - The Wind Surge and Travelers are in their first of three scheduled series this season with two of the series coming in Wichita. The all-time series has the Surge with a 47-34 series lead, and a 25-20 advantage in Wichita. The Surge won the 2024 season series 10-8, splitting the 12 games in The Air Capital. The '25 series has the Travs leading two games to one.

THE STANDINGS - The Wind Surge open play today in a first place tie with Arkansas. The first half just passed the mid-way point.

HOMEFIELD ADVANTAGE - The Wichita Wind Surge are a league best 10-5 at home this season, the best start in franchise history. The home winning percentage is the best in the Texas League.

ABOUT YESTERDAY - Aaron Rozek amounted six strikeouts in a 5-3 loss by the Wichita Wind Surge against the Arkansas Travelers at Equity Bank Park. While showing signs of life by tying the game twice, a ninth inning home run provided the difference for Arkansas, as the first three games have now flipped back and forth between the two teams. Victor Labrada lined a sacrifice fly to right field for the game's first run in the top of the third. Bill Knight recorded a sac fly of his own two innings later for a 2-0 Travelers lead. Noah Cardenas cut the deficit in half on an RBI double to left field in the home half of the fifth. Tyler Dearden brought home Cardenas on a sacrifice fly to tie the game 2-2. Jared Sundstrom scored on an infield error in the top of the sixth, then Kyler Fedko pushed the game back to an even score once again at 3-3 on a sac fly to center in the bottom part of the frame. John Klein threw three innings of one-hit baseball with a walk and four strikeouts out of the bullpen in relief of Aaron Rozek, who struck out six men over five innings as the Wichita starter. Hunter Fitz-Gerald broke the tie in the top of the ninth on a two-run home run that crept over the wall in left. A routine bottom of the ninth thrown by Brandyn Garcia secured the 5-3 win for Arkansas.

- \*The Wind Surge picked off three Travelers baserunners.
- \*John Klein hasn't allowed an earned run in three of his four outings so far in May.
- \*Aaron Rozek has struck out five or more batters in five of his six starts this season for Wichita.
- \*Both teams have combined for seven sacrifice flies across the last two games.

ON THE MOUND - The Wind Surge will start Ricky Castro. Its his sixth start of the season and seventh appearance. Castro pitched in relief last week at NW Arkansas dealing two scoreless innings. The 25-year-old has never faced Arkansas. He has a 8.44 ERA at home and a 3.86 ERA on the road

PITCHER OF THE WEEK - Wichita left-handed pitcher Connor Prielipp has been named Twins minor league Pitcher of the Week. Prielipp, 24, made the start for the Wind Surge on Thursday at Northwest Arkansas, pitching 4.0 shutout innings, with three hits allowed, no walks and six strikeouts...the Tomah, Wisconsin native was selected by the Twins in the second round (48th overall) in the 2022 First-Year Player Draft out of the University of Alabama...he is ranked as the organization's fifth-best prospect, per MLB. com, and number one pitcher.

PITCHING - The Wind Surge open play tonight with the second best ERA in The Texas League, 3.51 The 98 walks issued is the fewest in all of Minor League Baseball and the best in the Texas League. The Wind Surge rotation is fourth best in all of Class AA 3.30 ERA, best in TL but has the fewest wins (4) and has pitched the fewest innings (137.2). The bullpen 15 wins lead the league and also lead the league with most innings pitched 172.2. Mike Paredes leads the league with a 1.86 ERA and Trent Baker is fourth. Aaron Rozek is fifth with a 1.01 WHIP

THE OFFENSE- Tanner Schobel is third in the league with 40 hits. Ricardo Olivar is third in the league batting .322. Kyler Fedko is seventh in walks, 8th in OBP. The Surge went 2-for 6 with runners in scoring position yesterday and left 5 men on base.... The team is batting .221 for the season with runners in scoring position, ninth in the ten team Texas League.

\*Overall the Wind Surge are third in the league in hitting, batting .249 with 37 home runs, tied for most in the league...

\*Wichita leads the league in most drawn walks, but have grounded into a league leading 28 double plays and have the least amount of stolen bases. The 23 stolen bases are fourth fewest amongst all 120 Minor League Teams.

ICT NOTES - The Wind Surge are 5-0 in games Ricardo Olivar has homered. The Surge bullpen has had four blown saves in last eight games, and ten for eighteen for the season. The Minnesota Twins have the longest active win streak in baseball with eleven.

ROSTER MOVES - The Wind Surge made a few roster moves today. Jaylen Nowlin has been promoted to Class AAA St Paul, Allan Cerda has been released.

FAMILAR FACES - The Travs have a pair of former Wind Surge players: Outfielder Yoyner Fajardo, and pitcher Taylor Floyd. The team also features for Wichita State Shocker's infielder Brock Rodden, the 2023 American Athletic Conference Player of the Year!
