TODAY'S GAME: The Fayetteville Woodpeckers (Low-A Astros) continue a six-game series tonight against the Carolina Mudcats (Low-A Milwaukee Brewers). Carolina leads the series 3-1 after the Woodpeckers dropped a 5-2 game on Thursday night. This is the 11th game of the 24-game season series. Tonight, the Woodpeckers will start RHP Nic Swanson and the Mudcats hand the ball to RHP Fernando Olguin.

THE OPPONENT: The Carolina Mudcats have been a member of the Carolina League since the 2012 season after playing in the Double-A Southern League from 1991-2011. They have been a Milwaukee Brewers affiliate since the 2017 season after serving as a Atlanta Braves affiliate in 2015 and 2016. Their ballpark, Five County Stadium, opened in 1991 and extensively renovated in 1999, has a capacity of 6,500. The Woodpeckers have an all-time 25-29 record against the Mudcats going back to the 2019 season.

CERNY NAMED ASTROS POTM: The Houston Astros announced on Friday that Woodpeckers outfielder Logan Cerny has been named the organizational Minor League Player of the Month for June. During June, the 22-year-old Cerny batted .337 (29-for86) with seven doubles, five home runs, 27 RBI and a 1.011 OPS (.418 OBP/.593 SLG) in 23 games. This is the second award that Cerny has received this season, also being named the Carolina League Player of the Week back on June 13th. Former Fayetteville Woodpeckers pitcher Jaime Melendez was the Astros monthly award on the pitching side, pitching to a 2.01 ERA with 31 strikeouts over 22.1 innings in June.

PITCH, FORREST, PITCH! Former Astros first round draft pick from 2016, RHP Forrest Whitley has pitched near perfect baseball since his arrival to the Woodpeckers on rehab assignment on 6/22. After two scoreless innings pitched in his first rehab start, Whitley returned to the mound on 6/28 and tossed three perfect innings against the Carolina Mudcats. He struck out the final five batters he faced as well. Over his two starts with Fayetteville, Whitley as pitched 5.0 scoreless innings, allowing just one hit and no walks while striking out seven. Whitley underwent Tommy John surgery in April of 2021 and has yet to make his major league debut with the Astros. On Friday, it was announced that Whitley was completing his rehab assignment with Fayetteville and is returning to the active roster of the Sugarland Space Cowboys.

THE PROSPECTS: The Woodpeckers are currently carrying three of the Astros Top-30 Prospects on their active roster. RHP Alex Santos is the highest of the trio, sitting at #9. Outfielder Tyler Whitaker sits right behind him at #10 after dropping down a couple of spots. After a red-hot start to the month of June, outfielder Logan Cerny has surged up the rankings, coming in at #24 in the most recent rankings from MLB.com. Additionally, RHP Forrest Whitley who is on rehab assignment with Fayetteville is the #4 prospect in the system.

SLUGGERS OF THE CAROLINAS: Over the first 72 games of the regular season, the Woodpeckers lead the Carolina League with 69 long-balls, five more than the next closest team (Salem Red Sox, 63). 31 of Fayetteville's homers have been hit at Segra Stadium compared to 37 on the road, the second-most road homers of any team in the league behind Myrtle Beach (41). Additionally, the Woodpeckers are on pace to blow by their home run total in the 2021 season, where they finished fourth in the league with 111 homers.

RUNNING WILD: The new pitch clock and pick-off rules have led to a huge uptick in stolen bases across the league this season and multiple Woodpeckers are on-pace to steal close to 40 bases this year. Logan Cerny (23) needs just one more stolen base to pass Ronaldo Urdaneta (2021) for the most in Woodpeckers franchise history since 2018. Cody Orr (22) and Joey Loperfido (20) are also on pace to shatter the current record. Myles Straw remains the all-time franchise record holder with 36 SB for the Buies Creek Astros in 2017.

MOST LEADS ARE SAFE: Fayetteville has done an exceptional job maintaining leads down the stretch in games this season. The Woodpeckers are 25-3 when leading after seven innings and 28-1 when taking a lead into the ninth inning. However, on the flip side, Fayetteville has never won a game in which they have trailed after seven innings with an 0-27 record in that situation. Extra innings also have not been kind to the Woodpeckers, who are 1-7 in games that have gone past nine innings, but they did pick up their first extra-innings victory on May 26 in a 5-3 road win against the Down East Wood Ducks.

Recap: The Mudcats scored all five of their runs in the second inning against Deylen Miley. Stiven Cruz was dominant on the mound, throwing six scoreless innings in his first quality start of the season. Edinson Batista entered out of the bullpen in the first and was equally as efficient. He pitched 5.2 scoreless innings of relief and kept the game at 5-0 until Yeuris Ramirez hit a two-run homer in the seventh that cut the contest to 5-2. Michele Vassalotti was able to convert his second save of the series, working around a pair of Fayetteville baserunners in a scoreless 9th inning.

15 Joe Thon

Manager

Thon makes his return to Fayetteville and begins his first season as Woodpeckers manager after serving as a development coach in 2021. As the development coach, Thon helped coach Woodpeckers hitters and fielders, as well as assist with lineup planning and creating reports on individual athletes on the team.

Prior to joining the Astros as a full-time coach, Thon served as a summer intern with the organization during the 2019 summer. He helped analyze and balance revenue summaries, verified accounts for reconciling payments and processed and organized invoices for the Astros and Astros Foundation.

Following his intership, Thon broke into the coaching ranks by joining the University of Houston Baseball program in August 2019 as a student assistant coach before becoming the volunteer assistant prior to the 2020 season. After one season with UofH, Thon returned to the Astros in a full-time coaching role.

The former Minor League infielder enjoyed a seven-year minor league playing career. Thon was drafted in the 5th round (pick 156) by the Toronto Blue Jays in 2010 out of Academia Perpetuo Socorro in San Juan, Puerto Rico. He played in the Blue Jays organization until 2016 when he signed to join the St. Louis Cardinals. Thon played in the Cardinals farm system through 2017, reaching as high as Double-A with the Springfield Cardinals. His playing career concluded in 2017 in the Independent Atlanta League with the Sugar Land Skeeters, now the Triple-A Affiliate of the Astros. In total, Thon appeared in over 500 games across his MiLB career, posting a .243/.356/.318 slash line with 79 doubles, 17 triples, 27 home-runs and 178 RBI. Thon also played for Liga de Beisbol Profesional Roberto Clemente in Puerto Rico from 2010 through December 2016.

Thon comes from a deep baseball background. He is the son of former Astros shortstop Dickie Thon, a 1983 All-Star with Houston who enjoyed a 15-year MLB career with the California Angels, Astros, Padres, Phillies, Rangers and Brewers.
