**LAST ACTION:** [The Quad Cities River Bandits beat the Wisconsin Timber Rattlers 4-2 at Neuroscience Group Field.](#) The Timber Rattlers had a 2-0 lead after an RBI single by Josh Adamczewski in the first and a solo homer by Kay-Lan Nicasia in the fifth. Quad Cities scored a run in the sixth and three in the seventh to take the lead. Wisconsin had runners at first and second with no outs in the seventh, the bases loaded with no outs in the eighth, and the lead-off batter on bases in the ninth but did not score. Wisconsin stranded ten runners and were 1-for-11 with runners in scoring position on Sunday.

**QUALITY IS JOB ONE:** Manuel Rodriguez was the starting pitcher for Wisconsin on Sunday. He allowed a run on five hits with no walks and six strikeouts over six innings for his third quality start of the season.

**THE CRUELEST MONTH:** Wisconsin finished August with an 8-18 record, including a 3-12 record at home. They hit .197 with an OPS of .597 and were outscored 133-81 last month.

**GREAT CROWDS:** Sunday's attendance at Neuroscience Group Field was 6,079. The Timber Rattlers drew over 5,000 fans in fifteen of their last eighteen home games with a total of 99,134. For the season, Wisconsin drew 236,441 fans over 63 openings for an average attendance of 3,753. That marks the highest total attendance since 2016 (243,769) and highest average attendance since 2014 (3,970).

**DOWN THE STRETCH:** The Beloit Sky Carp start a series at home with Peoria tonight. Quad Cities is home to open a series with first half playoff qualifier Cedar Rapids. The South Bend Cubs entered last week tied with Beloit at the top of the division but were just swept in a six-game series at Peoria. There are six games remaining in the season.

**ABOUT SOUTH BEND:** The South Bend Cubs started as the South Bend White Sox when the Midwest League added them as an expansion team in 1988. They changed their name to the Silver Hawks for the 1994 season and became an affiliate of the Arizona Diamondbacks in 1997. South Bend became an affiliate of the Chicago Cubs in 2015. South Bend has won Midwest League titles in 1989, 1993, 2005, 2019, and 2022. Notable alumni for the South Bend franchise include Mike Cameron, Jose Valverde, Chris Capuano, Mark Reynolds, Justin Upton, Wade Miley, Chase Anderson, Keon Broxton, Gleyber Torres, Ian Happ, Carlos Gonzalez, Pete Crow-Armstrong, and current Timber Rattlers manager Victor Estevez. Terry Francona was the manager of the South Bend White Sox in 1992. Nick Lovullo, the son of Arizona Diamondbacks manager Torey Lovullo, is in his second year as South Bend's manager.

**ABOUT THE CUBS:** The Chicago Cubs had several different Midwest League affiliates before settling in South Bend in 2015. They were affiliated with Quincy from 1965 through 1973 before leaving the Midwest League. The Cubs returned to the MWL for an affiliation with Quad Cities from 1979 through 1984, Peoria from 1985 through 1994 and again from 2005 through 2012, Rockford from 1995 through 1998, Lansing from 1999 through 2004, and Kane County in 2013 and 2014.

# PITCHING MATCHUP

## WISCONSIN STARTING PITCHER:

**RHP TANNER GILLIS:** The Milwaukee Brewers signed Gillis as a non-drafted free agent on September 3, 2024.

**ON THE HORIZON:** Gillis was a First Team All-Horizon League selection in his one season at Northern Kentucky in 2024. He was 8-3 with a 5.00 ERA in fourteen starts. Gillis had pitched four seasons for Cedarville University, an NCAA Division II school from 2019-2023.

**HOW GREEN WAS THE VALLEY?** Gillis made five appearances – four starts – for Mahoning Valley in the MLB Draft League in 2024. He was 2-1 with a 1.80 ERA, struck out 24, and walked seven over 25 innings.

**CAROLINA ON MY MIND:** Gillis started the 2025 season with the Carolina Mudcats. He was 1-1 with a save in seven relief appearances. Gillis had a 1.32 ERA and 28 strikeouts in 27-1/3 innings for the Mudcats before he was assigned to Wisconsin on May 15.

**IT'S A MAJOR AWARD:** Gillis was named the Midwest League Pitcher of the Week on August 11. He set a new professional single-game high for strikeouts with seven over 6-1/3 scoreless innings at Peoria on August 7.

**LAST START:** Gillis had a no decision against Quad Cities on [August 27](#). He allowed three runs on four hits with three walks and two strikeouts over three innings.

**VS. SOUTH BEND:** Gillis is 0-1 in two starts – [May 24](#) and [July 12](#) – against the Cubs. He has allowed three runs on nine hits with one walk and eight strikeouts over nine innings in those two games.

## SOUTH BEND STARTING PITCHER:

**RHP DAWSON NETZ:** The Cubs signed Netz as a non-drafted free agent on May 8, 2025.

**WILDCAT:** Netz pitched five seasons at the University of Arizona and made a total of 94 appearances – fourteen starts. He was 6-2 with a 3.98 ERA and 130 strikeouts in 131 innings in college.

**THE KEY TO EVERYTHING:** Netz pitched for the Frederick Keys of the MLB Draft League in 2024 and was 4-0 with a 3.32 ERA in eleven relief appearances. He had 33 strikeouts and four walks in 21-2/3 innings at Frederick.

**TRI-LEVEL:** Netz began 2025 with the Arizona Complex League Cubs and was 1-3 in nine games – six starts. He was promoted to Myrtle Beach in the Carolina league on July 30 and was 2-0 with a 1.62 ERA in five games – one start – before bumping up to South Bend on August 26.

**LAST START:** Netz made his South Bend debut in a game at Peoria on [August 26](#). He took the loss after allowing three runs – two earned – on eight hits with no walks and six strikeouts over five innings.

**VS. WISCONSIN:** Netz has never pitched against the Timber Rattlers before this evening. Tonight is also the first time he will face an affiliate of the Milwaukee Brewers.
