ABOUT LAST NIGHT: The Wisconsin Timber Rattlers and South Bend Cubs split a doubleheader at Four Winds Field. Both teams scored two runs in the twinbill. Wisconsin won game one 1-0. South Bend won the nightcap 2-1.

GAME ONE RECAP: Jadher Areinamo drove in the lone run of the game with a sacrifice fly in the second inning. The Cubs had a runner at second in all but one inning from the second through the seventh and outhit Wisconsin 6-2, but the Rattlers held on for their first shutout win of the season. Brett Wichrowski (4IP, 5K), Will Childers (2IP), and Yerlin Rodriguez were Wisconsin's three pitchers in the game.

GAME TWO RECAP: Jose Acosta drove in Terence Doston with a double in the top of the fifth inning to give Wisconsin a 1-0 lead. However, Rafael Morel walked on four pitches to start the bottom of the sixth and Jefferson Morales followed with a two-run homer. Jesús Chirinos doubled for Wisconsin to start the seventh and Doston walked with one out. The Cubs got the final two outs on force plays at second to hold on for

MIKE CHECK: Mike Boeve was 0-for-1 with two walks and a run scored in the opener and 2-for-2 with a walk in the nightcap to extend his season-opening on-base streak to seven. Boeve is 9-for-21 with eight walks, an OBP of .567 and an OPS of 1.043.

JADHER HEY! Areinamo had a double to go with his RBI in game one to move his hitting and RBI streaks to five games. The streaks ended in the nightcap.

WHERE THERE'S A WILL: Will Rudy, Wisconsin's starting pitcher in game two, made his 2024 debut last night. He allowed three hits, walked two, and struck out three over 4-2/3 innings pitched.

MAKING MOVES: Acosta has been transferred to the Carolina Mudcats. Ben Metzinger has been activated from the Wisconsin development list and is eligible for today's game.

ABOUT SOUTH BEND: The South Bend Cubs started as the South Bend White Sox when the Midwest League added them as an expansion team in 1988. They changed their name to the Silver Hawks for the 1994 season and became an affiliate of the Arizona Diamondbacks in 1997. South Bend became an affiliate of the Chicago Cubs in 2015. South Bend has won Midwest League titles in 1989, 1993, 2005, 2019, and 2022. Notable alumni for the South Bend franchise include Mike Cameron, Jose Valverde, Chris Capuano, Mark Reynolds, Justin Upton, Wade Miley, Chase Anderson, Keon Broxton, Gleyber Torres, Ian Happ, Carlos Gonzalez, and current Timber Rattlers manager Victor Estevez. Terry Francona was the manager of the South Bend White Sox in 1982. Nick Lovullo, the son of Arizona Diamondbacks manager Torev Lovullo, is in his first year as South Bend's manager.

ABOUT THE CUBS: The Chicago Cubs had several different Midwest League affiliates before settling in South Bend in 2015. They were affiliated with Quincy from 1965 through 1973 before leaving the Midwest League. The Cubs returned to the MWL with an affiliation with Quad Cities from 1979 through 1984, Peoria from 1985 through 1994 and again from 2005 through 2012, Rockford from 1995 through 1998, Lansing from 1999 through 2004, and Kane County in 2013 and 2014.

PROSPECTING IN THE SERIES: MLB Pipeline places six active Rattlers on their list of Brewers Top 30 Prospects: Luis Lara (#9), Mike Boeve (#15), Luke Adams (#16), Dylan O'Rae (#21), Jadher Areinamo (#23), and Patricio Aquino (#29). MLB Pipeline has four active South Bend players on their list of Cubs prospects: Jefferson Rojas (#8), Drew Gray (#15), Pedro Ramirez (#17), and Brody McCullough (#26).

PITCHING MATCHUP

WISCONSIN STARTING PITCHER:

RHP ALEXANDER CORNIELLE: Milwaukee signed Cornielle as an International Free Agent out of the Dominican Republic on June 15, 2019.

FAST DEBUT: Cornielle made his professional debut with one inning of relief against the Cubs #2 affiliate in the Dominican Summer League on August 2, 2019. He allowed one run on no hits with two walks in one inning. Cornielle made three appearances in the DSL in 2019 with no record and one run allowed over four innings.

HIT PLAY: Cornielle started the 2021 season with the Brewers Blue affiliate in the Arizona Complex League and was 4-2 in nine games – four starts – with a 4.64 ERA and 50 strikeouts over 33 innings pitched. He was called up to Carolina at the end of the season and was 0-1 in two starts with ten strikeouts in eight innings.

WEEKLY AWARDS: Cornielle was named the ACL's Pitcher of the Week on September 6, 2021. He also won the Midwest League Pitcher of the Week Award on September 11, 2023.

BACK IN 2022: Cornielle was 9-7 in 22 games – 19 starts – with a 3.19 ERA and 124 strikeouts over 101-2/3 innings pitched for the Carolina Mudcats this season before joining the Timber Rattlers on August 23. He was second in the Carolina League in strikeouts and third in the Carolina League in ERA before his promotion to Wisconsin. Cornielle was 1-0 in three starts with Wisconsin and allowed four runs with six walks and 21 strikeouts over 17-1/3 innings pitched.

LAST SEASON: Cornielle was 1-3 in twenty games – eighteen starts – for Wisconsin. He walked 34, struck out 92, and compiled a 4.55 ERA in 89 innings pitched for the Rattlers.

LAST START: Cornielle beat Peoria <u>at home on April 6</u>. He allowed two runs on four hits with two walks and three strikeouts over five innings.

VS. SOUTH BEND (2023): Cornielle went 0-1 in two starts against the Cubs last season. He allowed eleven runs on eight hits with six walks and nine strikeouts over 4-2/3 innings.

SOUTH BEND STARTING PITCHER:

RHP LUIS DEVERS: The Chicago Cubs signed Devers as an International Free Agent out of the Dominican Republic on July 19, 2017

TWO SUMMERS: Devers pitched for Chicago's #2 affiliate in the Dominican Summer League in 2018 and 2019. He was 5-10 with a 2.63 ERA in 28 games – 27 starts. He had 109 strikeouts and 33 walks in 119-2/3 innings in the DSL.

BEFORE SOUTH BEND: Devers started his 2021 season with the ACL Cubs and was 2-4 with a 3.33 ERA and 54 strikeouts over 51-1/3 innings in twelve games – eleven starts – before a promotion to Myrtle Beach at the end of the season. Devers pitched two times in relief for the Pelicans in 2021. Devers started this season with the Pelicans. He was 9-3 with a 2.58 ERA in fifteen games – fourteen starts. Devers had 75 strikeouts and fourteen walks in 66-1/3 innings before earning a promotion to South Bend on July 4, 2022.

HEADING UP AROUND THE BEND: Devers was 4-0 with a 1.05 ERA and 47 strikeouts over 51-1/3 innings in eleven games – eight starts for the Cubs last season. He also made two starts with no record during the Cubs playoff run in 2022. Devers started the 2023 season on the 60-day IL of the Tennessee Smokies. He was sent to South Bend and activated on June 6, 2023. Devers spent the rest of last season with South Bend and went 4-5 with a 5.11 ERA in fifteen games – fourteen starts. He walked 32 and struck out 62 in 56-1/3 innings pitched for the Cubs in 2023.

LAST START: Devers won against Quad Cities at home on September 9, 2023. He allowed a run on a hit with two walks and six strikeouts over five innings.

VS. WISCONSIN: Devers has allowed one run in four appearances against the Timber Rattlers over the 2022 and 2023 seasons. In 2022, Devers had no record in two games – one start – while allowing one run on four hits over eight innings. In 2023, made two starts versus Wisconsin, pitched ten scoreless innings, allowed three hits, and won both starts. In his four games against the Rattlers, Devers has walked three and struck out twenty over eighteen innings.
