ABOUT LAST NIGHT: The Cedar Rapids Kernels beat the Wisconsin Timber Rattlers 10-6. The Kernels scored four runs in the first and added single runs in the second, third, fourth, and fifth to build a 7-2 lead. Both teams had thirteen hits last night. Cedar Rapids was 6for-17 with runners in scoring position and the Rattlers were 3-for-12 with runners in scoring position.

OPPORTUNITY KNOCKED: Wisconsin trailed 4-0 after the top of the first. Then, they loaded the bases with no outs in the bottom of the first inning on two walks and a single. However, Kernels starting pitcher Ty Langenberg escaped the inning with three straight strikeouts to keep the Rattlers off the scoreboard.

MULTI-MEN: Blake Burke and Marco Dinges both had three hits last night. Dinges is 6-for-8 in his last two games. Eduardo Garcia, Juan Baez, and Jadher Areinamo all had two hits in the game.

STAYING HOT: Garcia doubled, homered, and walked last night. He leads Wisconsin in doubles (14) and homers (8) in 2025. Garcia is also on the longest active on-base streak of the season for the Rattlers at 18 games. He is 23-for-67 (.343) with five homers, seven doubles, nine walks, thirteen stolen bases, 23 runs, and twelve RBI during the streak. Blake Burke's 25-game on-base streak is the only Timber Rattler on-base streak longer than Garcia's this season.

WORTHY OPPONENT: Kaelen Culpepper went 2-for-5 last night. Wisconsin held him hitless on April 4. He has at least one hit in each of his last eight games against the Rattlers. For the season, Culpepper is 13-for-34 (.382) with three homers, eleven RBI, and an OPS of 1.194 in nine games against Wisconsin.

ABOUT CEDAR RAPIDS: The current franchise began its existence in 1949 as the Cedar Rapids Rockets, an unaffiliated team in the Central Association. They moved to the Three-I League as the Cedar Rapids Indians, an affiliate of Cleveland in 1950. They were affiliated with the Milwaukee Braves from 1954 through 1962. Cedar Rapids has been called the Braves, Red Raiders, Cardinals, Astros, Giants, and Reds until they became the Kernels in 1993. That was the same year the California Angels became the parent club of the Kernels. That affiliation remained through the 2012 season. Cedar Rapids has been affiliated with the Minnesota Twins since 2013. The Kernels made the Midwest League playoffs every year they have been affiliated with the Twins from 2013 through 2023, including a 2023 Midwest League Championship. That streak ended last year when the Kernels missed the playoffs. Notable alumni include Mike Trout, Byron Buxton, and Milwaukee Brewers Pitching Coach Chris Hook. Hall of Famers John McGraw (1891 Canaries), Lou Boudreau (1938 Raiders), Ted Simmons (1967 Cardinals), and Trevor Hoffman (1991 Reds) played for earlier pro teams in Cedar Rapids.

ABOUT THE TWINS: Minnesota has a long history of in the Midwest League. They started out with Wisconsin Rapids (1964-1983) and moved to Kenosha (1984-1992) and to Fort Wayne (1993-1998) as the franchise moved. Minnesota has also been with Quad Cities (1999-2004) and Beloit (2005-2012) before their current affiliation with Cedar Rapids Kernels started in 2013.

PROSPECTING IN THE SERIES: MLB Pipeline places five Rattlers on their list of Brewers Top 30 Prospects: Bishop Letson (#14), Blake Burke (#17), Jadher Areinamo (#23), Juan Baez (#26), and Manuel Rodriguez (#29).

Charlee Soto (#8), Billy Amick (#14), and Khadim Diaw (#29) are currently on the Cedar Rapids

WISCONSIN STARTING PITCHER:

RHP JARON DeBERRY: The Milwaukee Brewers selected DeBerry in the third round of the 2024 draft out of Dallas Baptist University.

JC: DeBerry pitched the 2021 season at Northern Oklahoma-Enid and was 5-1 with a 4.10 ERA in fourteen games – twelve starts. In 2022, he was at Grayson College with a 4-0 record, a 3.27 ERA, and 60 strikeouts in 41.1IP.

SUMMER JOBS: DeBerry was with Duluth in the Northwoods League in 2022 and Cowlitz in the West Coast League in 2023. He combined to go 4-0 with a 1.85 ERA and 37 strikeouts over 39 innings playing in the Summer Leagues.

DBU: DeBerry was 10-2 with a 4.11 ERA in two seasons with Dallas Baptist. He had 124 strikeouts in 124-1/3 innings. He was a First Team All-Conference USA selection in his final season. In his last start with the Patriots, DeBerry shutout Arizona over six innings as Dallas Baptist beat the Wildcats in the Tucson Regional of the 2024 NCAA Tournament.

BEFORE WISCONSIN: DeBerry made his pro debut with three starts for the Carolina Mudcats before joining Wisconsin on May 20. He had no record, allowed one run, walked one, and struck out thirteen in 8-2/3 innings with the Mudcats.

LAST START: DeBerry had a no decision against Peoria at home on May 31. He allowed two runs on five hits with two walks and three strikeouts over 3-1/3 innings.

VS. CEDAR RAPIDS: DeBerry has never pitched against Cedar Rapids prior to this evening. Tonight is also his first appearance against an affiliate of the Minnesota Twins.

CEDAR RAPIDS STARTING PITCHER:

RHP CHASE CHANEY: The Minnesota Twins signed Chaney as a minor league free agent on December 12, 2024.

ORIGIN STORY: Chaney was selected by the Los Angeles Angels in the 16th round of the 2018 draft out of Mountain View High School in Lawrenceville, Georgia. Chaney made it as high as Rocket City in the Double-A Southern League at the end of the 2023 season and all of 2024. He elected Free Agency on November 4, 2024.

TRASH PANDA: Chaney was 7-11 with a 4.30 ERA in 26 games – 25 starts – for Rocket City in 2024. He walked 44 and struck out 103 in 113-2/3 innings.

LAST START: Chaney allowed a run on six hits with a walk and a strikeout over six innings to earn the win against Lake County on May 31 at home
