INDY BITS

ABOUT LAST NIGHT: Matt Gorski powered the Indianapolis Indians to a 6-2 victory against the Toledo Mud Hens on Friday night at Victory Field, tallying his sixth career multi-home run game and kicking off a four-run sixth inning that propelled Indy to its first series victory of the season. With the game knotted at 1-1 in the sixth inning, Gorski drove in the eventual game-winning run with a double to bring around Nick Solak. The Indians continued their big inning as Liover Peguero roped a two-run double down the left field line and traded places with Eli Wilson two batters later After some small ball provided the Mud Hens with a 1-0 lead in the bottom of the fourth, Gorski deposited his first home run of the night 400 feet over the left field fence to tie the game. His second home run, third hit and third RBI of the night in the seventh inning padded the lead for the Indians. Toledo attempted a comeback against Jarod Bayless in the top of the ninth, loading the bases and cashing in one run. However, Bayless stranded the bases loaded with a trio of strikeouts to end the frame. The outing also capped off an impressive 4.1 one-run innings from the bullpen, spurred by Eddy

COMEBACK KIDS: After overcoming another deficit last night, the Indians earned their seventh comeback win of the season. The squad won four consecutive home games for the first time since winning five straight games at Victory Field from Sept. 1-13, 2024. Four of the team's six home wins this season came via extra-inning walk-off plate appearances. The Indians walked off for the fourth time in April on Friday, tying a Victory Field high for most walk-off wins in the month. The squad improved to 5-0 in extra innings on the campaign that night, with one road win in 10 innings on April 13 at Louisville. Indy also improved to 6-1 in one-run games this season on Friday.

SOLAK ECLIPSE: Nick Solak extended his team-high hitting streak to 11 games yesterday, tying for the longest active hitting streak in Triple-A. It is also tied for third best active run in the minors. Solak has a hit in each game he's played this season, going 2-for-3 with one walk and one run in last night's contest. It was his third time reaching base safely three-plus times in a single game on the campaign. He is hitting .357 (15-for-42) with two doubles, two home runs, eight RBI, three walks, eight runs and three stolen bases this season. He has struck out just seven times on the campaign and only thrice in his past 30 plate appearances. On Wednesday, he posted his first multi-steal game since taking two bags June 18, 2022, with Round Rock vs. Sugar Land. He is hitting .600 (6-for-10) with RISP in 2025, which is the second-best mark in Triple-A.

GLITZY GORSKI: Matt Gorski tallied 10 total bases in last night's contest, marking the most in a single game by an Indian this season. He went 3-for-4 with one double, two home runs, three RBI and three runs. It was his sixth multi-homer game of his career and first since May 21, 2024, at lowa. It was the first multi-homer game by an Indy player since Liover Peguero left the yard twice on Aug. 23, 2024, at Columbus. He has posted a hit in five of his past six games and has one-plus hit in 12 of his 16 games on the campaign. He has driven in one-plus run in five of his last six games and 10 of 16 overall. In 10 games at Victory Field, Gorski is hitting .368 AVG (14-for-38) with a 1.114 OPS. Gorski delivered the win on Friday with a walk-off double, going 2-for-4 with two RBI and one run.

BUBBA ON THE BUMP: Bubba Chandler turned in his longest outing of the season last night, tossing 4.2 innings with two hits, one run, one walk and five strikeouts. In 11 career starts with Indianapolis, Chandler is 4-0 with a 1.81 ERA (11er/54.2ip) and 77 strikeouts. He has struck out eight-plus batters in five of those starts and six-plus in eight. He has not allowed more than four baserunners in a contest on the campaign and has allowed three or less in three straight starts.

HOLDY ON REHAB: Pirates right-handed pitcher Colin Holderman began a rehab assignment with Indianapolis last night, tossing a scoreless seventh inning en route to the Indians fourth straight win. Holderman was placed on the 15-day injured list on April 6 with a right knee strain. In 12 career games with Indianapolis, he is 0-0 with a 4.63 ERA (6er/11.2ip) with eight hits, four walks, two hit batters and 14 strikeouts. Opponents are hitting just .195 (8-for-41) in this span. He began the season on Pittsburgh's Opening Day roster, going 0-0 with a 9.64 ERA (5er/4.2ip), four walks and six strikeouts in five games. He has appeared in 127 games for Pittsburgh since 2022, going 4-9 with a 4.04 ERA (5er/4.2ip), 112 hits, 56 walks and 126 strikeouts.

TONIGHT'S MATCHUP: The Indians seek a fifth consecutive win over Toledo after capturing their first series victory of the season in last night's contest. Another win would mark their longest winning streak against the Mud Hens since winning seven straight from May 3-31, 2023. Taking the mound for the Indians is right-hander Braxton Ashcraft, who is set to make his fifth start of the season after allowing three runs (two earned) across 4.0 in Tuesday's series opener. It marked his first career start against Toledo. Opposite Ashcraft is right-hander Matt Manning. Manning tossed 4.0 innings on Tuesday, allowing three runs with four hits, four walks and one strikeout. In five career starts against Indy, he has a 1-0 record and 4.66 ERA (10er/19.1ip) with 19 hits, 12 walks, one hit batter, six home runs and 17 strikeouts.

ON THIS DATE IN 1955: Indianapolis defeated the Cleveland Indians 12-10 in an exhibition game at old Victory Field. Center fielder Rocky Colavito and catcher Earl Averill each hit home runs for Indianapolis and Hank Aguirre earned the win.

Braxton Ashcraft: The right-hander and Pittsburgh's No. 6 prospect according to MLB Pipeline.

Opening Day Starter: Ashcraft made his second career Opening Day start on March 28 at St. Paul, last doing so on June 14, 2019, with Class-A short season West Virginia.

Last Outing: Ashcraft did not factor into the decision in Tuesday's series opener, tossing 4.0 innings with six hits, three runs (two earned), three walks and three strikeouts

Against the Mud Hens: Ashcraft made his lone career start opposite Toledo on Tuesday.

Prospectus: Ashcraft entered the 2025 season rated as Pittsburgh's No. 6 prospect according to MLB Pipeline and No. 4 according to *Baseball America*. Since being drafted by the Pirates in 2018, No. 4 is his highest ranking according to *BA*, elevated from No. 10 last season.

Miscellaneous: Ashcraft was drafted by Pittsburgh in the second round (51st overall) of the 2018 First-Year Player Draft out of Robinson High School (Waco, Texas). He had his contract first selected by Pittsburgh on Nov. 14, 2023.
