ABOUT LAST NIGHT: The Wisconsin Timber Rattlers beat the Quad Cities River Bandits 3-2 at Modern Woodmen Park. Wisconsin scored a run in the third on an RBI single by Ernesto Martinez Jr and added insurance runs on a two-run home run by Eric Brown Jr in the eighth. Stiven Cruz pitched five scoreless innings and three Wisconsin relievers held on to close out the game for Wisconsin's fourth win in a row.

CRUZ CONTROL: Cruz gave up a lead-off single to Javier Vaz in the bottom of the first inning. Cruz retired the next fourteen batters in a row before walking River Town and allowing a single to Kale Emshoff in the bottom of the fifth. Cruz ended the inning by striking out Shervyen Newton. The Wisconsin right-hander walked one and struck out eight in his five scoreless innings.

WELCOME BACK: Alexander Cornielle returned to the mound for the first time since June 4 and pitched 2-1/3 innings in relief. He allowed one run on one hit and two

GOING DEEP: Brown's homer was his third of the season and his first since May 23 at Cedar Rapids. Brown is on a five-game hitting streak and has reached base in all six games he has played since returning to the lineup on June 22.

TERENCE THE TERRIFIC: Terence Doston singled in the eighth and scored on Brown's homer. Doston is on a seven-game hitting streak, his longest streak of the season. He is 10-for-22 (.455) during the streak. SHEAR THE SHEEP: Tanner Shears entered the game in the bottom of the ninth with the Rattlers up 3-2 and the tying run at first. ABOUT QUAD CITIES: The River Bandits are the Midwest League affiliate of the Kansas City Royals. The current version of Davenport Professional Baseball club started in 1960 as the Midwest League affiliate of the Milwaukee Braves. Quad Cities has affiliated with several MLB teams: The California Angels (1962-1978 and 1985-1992), the Chicago Cubs (1979-1984), the Houston Astros (1993-1998 and 2013-2019), the Minnesota Twins (1999-2004), and the St. Louis Cardinals (2005-2012). The team became the Quad City River Bandits in 1992. They changed their name to the Swing of the Quad Cities from 2004 through 2007 before changing to Quad Cities River Bandits in 2008. Quad Cities won Midwest League pennants in 1968, 1971, 1979, 1990, 2011, 2013, and 2017. They were the High-A Central League champions in 2021. Notable alumni of Quad Cities: Carlos Correa, Joe Mauer, Josh Hader, Billy Wagner, Shawon Dunston, Justin Morneau, and Brett Phillips.

ABOUT THE ROYALS: The Kansas City Royals have been Quad Cities' parent club since 2021. They left the Midwest league and an affiliation with Kane County at the end of the 2012 season. The Royals had previously been in the Midwest League with Waterloo (1969-1976), Appleton (1987-1992), Rockford (1993-94), Springfield (1995), Lansing (1996-1998), Burlington (2001-2010), and Kane County (2011-2012).

PROSPECTING IN THE SERIES: MLB Pipeline places five active Rattlers on their list of Brewers Top 30 Prospects: Jacob Misiorowski (#4), Eric Brown Jr (#6), Robert Moore (#8), Eduardo García (#19), and Matthew Wood (#24). Hendry Mendez (#13) and Joseph Hernandez (#25) are currently on Wisconsin's IL. MLB Pipeline has six active River Bandits on their list of Kansas City prospects: Gavin Cross (#1), Cayden Wallace (#4), Carter Jensen (#8), Mason Barnett (#16), Luinder Avila (#28), and David Sandlin (#30).

PITCHING MATCHUP

WISCONSIN SCHEDULED STARTING PITCHER:

RHP TYLER WOESSNER: Drafted by the Milwaukee Brewers in the sixth round of the 2022 draft out of Central Arizona College.

WHAT A SEASON: Woessner went 11-2 with a 3.55 ERA in nineteen games - eighteen starts - during his final season at CAC. He walked 34 and struck out 122 in 96-1/3 innings pitched for the Vaqueros.

PITCHING INTO THE FINALS: Central Arizona College advanced to the 2022 NJCAA College World Series in Grand Junction, Colorado. Woessner was the winning pitcher in the game that got CAC into the Championship game as he allowed three runs and struck out eight over seven innings in the Vaqueros' 7-4 win over Walters State Community College on June 3 2022. Central Arizona College won the National Title the next day with a 4-2 win over Cowley County Community College

NORTH TO ALASKA: Woessner pitched in three games - one start - for the Mat-Su Miners of the Alaska Baseball League in 2021. He had no record, walked three, and struck out four over seven innings.

FIRST YEAR AS A BREWER: Woessner started his pro career with the Brewers Gold affiliate in the Arizona Complex League and made three appearances - two starts - with eleven strikeouts over six scoreless innings. Woessner also made one start for the Carolina Mudcats at the end of the 2022 Carolina League season.

LAST START: Woessner lost to Lansing at home on June 23. He allowed three runs on five hits with a walk and a strikeout over six innings. The Timber Rattlers lost 4-2.

VS. QUAD CITIES: Woessner is 1-0 in two starts - April 22 on the road and May 17 at home – against the River Bandits this season. He has allowed two runs on seven hits with five walks and twelve strikeouts over 10-1/3 innings in his games against Quad Cities.

QUAD CITIES SCHEDULED STARTING PITCHER:

RHP ADRIAN ALCANTARA: The Royals signed Alcantara as an International Free Agent out of the Dominican Republic on March 3,

ORIGIN STORY: Alcantara pitched in the Dominican Summer League in 2017 and in the Arizona League in 2018. He had 66 strikeouts and 44 walks over 78-2/3 innings pitched in his first two seasons.

I REMEMBER THOSE TEAMS: In 2019, Alcantara made one start in the Pioneer League for Idaho Falls and twelve appearances – ten starts – for Burlington in the Appalachian League. He was 3-4 with a 2.57 ERA and 61 strikeouts over 56 innings pitched. Alcantara was named a Postseason All-Star in the Appalachian League and Baseball America named him to their Rookie Level Postseason All-Star Team.

COLUMBIA EXHIBITION: Alcantara was 5-9 with a 5.33 ERA in 24 games - 20 starts - for the Columbia Fireflies in 2021. He had 98 strikeouts and 30 walks in 96-1/3 innings.

WHAT HAPPENED SINCE THEN? In 2022, Alcantara made 22 appearances - sixteen starts - for Quad Cities and two starts for Northwest Arkansas in the Texas League. He was 7-5 with the Bandits and 1-0 with the Naturals. Alcantara combined for an ERA of 4.95 and 130 strikeouts in 116-1/3 innings last season. In 2023, he is 2-3 with a 3.64 ERA, eighteen walks, and 27 strikeouts over 29-2/3 innings in ten games - five starts - between Columbia, Quad Cities, and Northwest Arkansas.

LAST START: Alcantara had a no decision against Peoria at home on June 21. He allowed one run on four hits with three walks and four strikeouts over five innings.

VS. WISCONSIN: Alcantara was 1-0 in four appearances - two starts with no record against Wisconsin in 2022. He has allowed thirteen runs - eleven earned - on twenty hits with nine walks and eighteen strikeouts over 16-2/3 innings pitched against the Rattlers last year.
