ABOUT LAST NIGHT: The Quad Cities River Bandits beat the Wisconsin Timber Rattlers 10-1 at Neuroscience Group Field. Carter Jensen went 3-for-5 with a homer in the third to give the River Bandits a 1-0 lead. Spencer Nivens hit a three-run homer in the top of the fourth to put Quad Cities up 4-0. The River Bandits outhit Wisconsin 11-4. Frank Mozzicato allowed one run over five innings for the win. Oscar Rayo pitched four scoreless innings for the save.

OFF TARGET: Wisconsin pitchers issued ten walks on Friday night to set a new single-game high for the season

LONG DISTANCE: Quad Cities has hit twelve of their 43 homers this season against the Timber Rattlers.

GOING DEEP: Jesús Chirinos hit a solo home run with two outs in the bottom of the fifth inning for Wisconsin's only run. Chirinos has four homers on the season and has hit a home run in his last two games. The Rattlers have hit nine of their 25 home runs in 2024 against the River Bandits.

HE GETS ON BASE: Dylan O'Rae went 1-for-4 on Friday to extend his current on base streak to nineteen games. Since the streak started on May 17, O'Rae is 19-for-65 (.292) with seventeen runs scored and fourteen walks for an on base percentage of .459. O'Rae is tied with Jefferson Rojas of South Bend for the longest active on-base streak in the Midwest League. **DEBUT:** Catcher Victor Torres made his Timber Rattlers debut as a pitcher. He got the final two outs in

the top of the ninth inning. STANDINGS CHECK: Wisconsin's lead in the West Division over the Cedar Rapids Kernels stayed at 2-1/2 games when the Kernels lost at Great Lakes on Friday

ABOUT QUAD CITIES: The River Bandits are the Midwest League affiliate of the Kansas City Royals. The current version of Davenport Professional Baseball club started in 1960 as the Midwest League affiliate of the Milwaukee Braves. Quad Cities has affiliated with several MLB teams: The California Angels (1962-1978 and 1985-1992), the Chicago Cubs (1979-1984), the Houston Astros (1993-1998 and 2013-2019), the Minnesota Twins (1999-2004), and the St. Louis Cardinals (2005-2012). The team became the Quad City River Bandits in 1992. They changed their name to the Swing of the Quad Cities from 2004 through 2007 before changing to Quad Cities River Bandits in 2008. Quad Cities won Midwest League pennants in 1968, 1971, 1979, 1990, 2011, 2013, and 2017. They were the High-A Central League champions in 2021. Notable alumni of Quad Cities: Carlos Correa, Joe Mauer, Josh Hader, Billy Wagner, Shawon Dunston, Justin Morneau, and Brett Phillips.

ABOUT THE ROYALS: The Kansas City Royals have been Quad Cities' parent club since 2021. They left the Midwest league and an affiliation with Kane County at the end of the 2012 season. The Royals had previously been in the Midwest League with Waterloo (1969-1976), Appleton (1987-1992), Rockford (1993-94), Springfield (1995), Lansing (1996-1998), Burlington (2001-2010), and Kane County (2011-2012).

PITCHING MATCHUP

WISCONSIN STARTING PITCHER:

RHP YUJANYER HERRERA: The Milwaukee Brewers signed Herrera as an International Free Agent on August 17, 2019 out of Venezuela

STARTING IN ARIZONA: Herrera made his professional debut in the Arizona Complex League in 2021 as he pitched for Milwaukee's Blue and Gold affiliates. He was 3-3 with a 9.00 ERA in eleven games - four starts in 2021. Herrera walked 38 and struck out 37 over 35 innings. He also began the 2022 season in Arizona with a 2-3 record and a 5.36 ERA in eleven games - eight starts - before a move to Carolina in August of that

TIME IN CAROLINA: Herrera pitched for the Carolina Mudcats at the end of the 2022 season, the entire 2023 season, and the start of this season. He was 8-5 with a save and a 4.54 ERA in 30 games - thirteen starts - with 66 walks and 101 strikeouts over 111 innings pitched for the Mudcats.

PROMOTION TIME: Herrera made four relief appearances for the Mudcats in 2024 and was 3-0 with a 2.12 ERA. He walked six and struck out 27 in

LAST START: Herrera allowed a run on one hit with four walks and five strikeouts over six innings to pick up the win against Fort Wayne at home on June 1. The only run he allowed was a solo homer by Griffin Doersching.

VS. QUAD CITIES: Hererra had a no decision at Modern Woodmen Park on May 10. He allowed two runs on five hits with three walks and five strikeouts over 4-1/3 innings.

QUAD CITIES STARTING PITCHER:

RHP HENRY WILLIAMS: The Kansas City Royals acquired Williams and Jesus Rios from the San Diego Padres in exchange for Scott Barlow in a trade on August 1, 2023. MLB Pipeline ranks Williams as the #27 prospect in the Kansas City system. Baseball America places him at #29 in the Royals organization.

ORIGIN STORY: The Padres selected Williams in the third round of the 2022 draft out of Duke.

AM I BLUE? Williams was 3-3 with a 3.65 ERA in eight games - six starts - for Duke in 2021. He did not pitch for the Blue Devils in 2022 due to Tommy John Surgery.

GO JUMP IN A LAKE: Williams began his pro career with the Lake Elsinore Storm in the California League in 2023. He was 1-5 with a 5.74 ERA in twelve starts. Williams walked 21 and struck out 40 in 42-

FIREFLIES: Williams made five starts for Columbia, Kansas City's Carolina League affiliate, after the trade. He was 2-1 with a 3.38 ERA, thirteen walks, and 23 strikeouts over 24 innings pitched.

LAST START: Williams earned the win against South Bend at home on June 1. He pitched six shutout innings, allowed three hits, walked one, and struck out six.

VS. WISCONSIN: Williams lost to Wisconsin at Modern Woodmen Park on May 11. He allowed a run on two hits with a hit batsman, three walks, and seven strikeouts over six innings.
