LAST ACTION: [The Wisconsin Timber Rattlers beat the West Michigan Whitecaps 5-3 in the conclusion of a game that was suspended on Saturday night at Neuroscience Group Field.](#) The Timber Rattlers broke a 1-1 tie with four runs in the bottom of the fifth inning. Sunday's regularly scheduled game was canceled.

GET OUT THE BROOMS: The Timber Rattlers swept the five-game series from the Whitecaps. West Michigan scored five runs in the series. Wisconsin has won six games in row for the first time this season.

IS THAT A LOT? THAT SEEMS LIKE A LOT?

Heading into the four-day all-star break, both teams used six pitchers on Sunday. Both starters pitched an inning on Saturday. Wisconsin had Patricio Aquino and Alexander Cornielle both pitch two innings with Devin Williams, Tyler Wehrle, Steven Cruz, and Chase Costello each working an inning.

ON ASSIGNMENT: Williams struck out the side in order on fourteen pitches in the sixth inning in his first live action on the mound since going on Milwaukee's Injured List at the end of Spring Training.

GOOD WEEK: Cornielle earned the win with two perfect innings on Sunday. He was 2-0 in two games against the Whitecaps last week. Cornielle allowed two hits and struck out nine over seven innings in the series with West Michigan.

TAKING OFFENSE: Wisconsin scored four runs on five hits in the fifth inning on Sunday. Eduardo Garcia and Tayden Hall had RBI singles with Felix Valerio adding a two-run double in between those run scoring hits.

KEEP ON CLIMBING: The Timber Rattlers are 26 games over .500 for the first time since they were 71-45 on August 12, 2001. The 2001 Timber Rattlers finished that season 84-52 (32 games over .500) for the best record in Rattlers history.

KEEP ON RUNNING: Wisconsin stole two bases on Sunday to give them 171 steals this season. The 2001 Rattlers has the franchise record of 245 stolen bases.

ABOUT CEDAR RAPIDS: The current franchise began its existence in 1949 as the Cedar Rapids Rockets, an unaffiliated team in the Central Association. They moved to the Three-I League as the Cedar Rapids Indians as an affiliate of Cleveland in 1950. They were affiliated with the Milwaukee Braves from 1954 through 1962. Cedar Rapids has been called the Braves, Red Raiders, Cardinals, Astros, Giants, and Reds until they became the Kernels in 1993. That was the same year the California Angels became the parent club of the Kernels. That affiliation remained through the 2012 season. Cedar Rapids has been affiliated with the Minnesota Twins since 2013. The Kernels have made the Midwest League playoffs every year they have been affiliated with the Twins, including a Midwest League Championship last season. Notable alumni include Mike Trout, Byron Buxton, Trevor Hoffman, Brewers Pitching Coach Chris Hook, and Ted Simmons. Hall of Famers John McGraw (1891 Canaries) and Lou Boudreau (1938 Raiders) played for earlier pro teams in Cedar Rapids.

ABOUT THE TWINS: Minnesota has a long history of in the Midwest League. They started out with Wisconsin Rapids (1964-1983) and moved to Kenosha (1984-1992) and to Fort Wayne (1993-1998) as the franchise moved. Minnesota has also been with Quad Cities (1999-2004) and Beloit (2005-2012) before their current affiliation with Cedar Rapids Kernels started in 2013.

PROSPECTING IN THE SERIES: [MLB Pipeline](#) places five active Rattlers on their list of Brewers Top 30 Prospects: Luis Lara (#8), Luke Adams (#15), Jader Areinamo (#21), and Patricio Aquino (#28). [MLB Pipeline](#) has four active Kernels on their list of Minnesota prospects: Gabriel Gonzalez (#6), Ricardo Olivar (#20), Darren Bowen (#27), and Rayne Doncon (#28). C.J. Culpepper (#9) and Danny DeAndrade (#14) are currently on the IL.

THAT CHAMPIONSHIP SEASON: Cedar Rapids is the reigning Midwest League Champion. The Kernels beat the Peoria Chiefs in Game Three of the best-of-three Western Division Finals and the Great Lakes Loons in Game Three of the best-of-three Championship Series to claim their first Midwest League pennant since 1994. The Kernels were 82-50 during the 2023 regular season to finish last year with the best record in the Midwest League.

RHP STIVEN CRUZ: Signed by Milwaukee as an International Free Agent out of Nicaragua on July 2, 2019.

DELAYED START: Cruz began his pro career with the Brewers-1 affiliate in the Dominican Summer League in 2021. He was 3-3 with a 1.37 ERA and 73 strikeouts over 52-2/3 innings pitched in twelve games – eleven starts.

MUDDY WATERS: Cruz started the 2022 season with the Carolina Mudcats in the Carolina League. He went 3-5 with a 4.60 ERA in fifteen starts for Carolina. Cruz walked 18 and struck out 89 over 72-1/3 innings pitched.

ON TO WISCONSIN: Cruz joined the Timber Rattlers on August 16, 2022. He made four starts with the Rattlers and allowed one run on six hits with six walks and twenty strikeouts over nineteen innings pitched for a 1-1 record with a 0.47ERA. In 2023, Cruz spent the entire season with the Rattlers and was 7-6 with a 6.90 ERA in 24 games – 19 starts.

IT'S A MAJOR AWARD: Cruz beat Lansing at home on August 24, 2022. He allowed a hit with a walk and seven strikeouts over six scoreless innings in the game. Cruz was named the Midwest League Pitcher of the Week on August 29 for this game.

LAST APPEARANCE: Cruz earned a hold on [July 13](#) at home against West Michigan. He hit a batter over a scoreless, hitless inning.

LAST START: Cruz had a no decision against Dayton at home on [August 9, 2023](#). He allowed two runs on four hits with two walks and three strikeouts over three innings.

VS. CEDAR RAPIDS: Cruz allowed a run on three hits with no walks and a strikeout over 1-2/3 innings pitched as a reliever against the Kernels at home on [April 17, 2024](#). In 2023, Cruz was 1-2 with a save in four appearances – two starts – against Cedar Rapids. He allowed 13 runs – 12 earned – on 17 hits with 12 walks and 15 strikeouts in 14 innings versus the Kernels in 2023.

CEDAR RAPIDS STARTING PITCHER:

LHP CHRISTIAN MACLEOD: The Twins selected MacLeod in the fifth round of the 2021 draft out of Mississippi State.

TWO YEARS IN STARKVILLE: MacLeod was 4-0 in four starts with a 0.86 ERA during the abbreviated 2020 season with the Bulldogs. He went 6-6 in nineteen starts in 2021. In his time at Mississippi State, MacLeod had 148 strikeouts over 103-2/3 innings pitched.

THOSE TWO TIMES IN OMAHA: MacLeod was the starting pitcher twice in the 2021 College World Series. He allowed four runs on five hits in 1-1/3 innings against Virginia on June 22, 2021 and six runs on two hits in 2/3 of an inning against Vanderbilt on June 28, 2021.

THERE CAN BE ONLY ONE: MacLeod made one appearance in the Florida Complex League after signing with the Twins in 2021. He would undergo Tommy John Surgery in March of 2022 and missed the entire 2022 season. In 2023, MacLeod made two starts for Fort Myers in the Florida State League before joining the Kernels in May. He went 5-2 with a 4.13 ERA in 15 games – 14 starts – with Cedar Rapids last season.

LAST START: MacLeod had a no decision at Beloit on [July 13](#). He allowed two runs on five hits with a walk and eleven strikeouts over 5-2/3 innings.

VS. WISCONSIN (2023): MacLeod was 1-1 in three starts against Wisconsin last season. He had a no decision against the Timber Rattlers in Cedar Rapids on [May 28](#), beat the Rattlers in Wisconsin on [July 29](#), and lost to Wisconsin at Cedar Rapids on [August 16](#). He allowed eleven runs on fourteen hits with four walks and eight strikeouts over ten innings against Wisconsin in 2023.
