ABOUT LAST NIGHT: The Quad Cities River Bandits beat the Wisconsin Timber Rattlers beat 2-1 at Modern Woodmen Park. Bishop Letson struck out eight without a walk over five scoreless innings as the Wisconsin starting pitcher. He left the game with a 1-0 lead, but the Bandits tied the game with a run in the sixth. Bryan Gonzalez gave Quad Cities the lead with a two-out, RBI double in the eighth.

THE BISHOP: Letson set a new single-game high as a pro for strikeouts with eight last night. He allowed three hits, but nothing after a two out single in the second inning as he retired the final ten batters, including seven of the last ten Bandits he faced.

WHERE DO THEY RANK? Wisconsin pitchers lead the Midwest League in strikeouts with 75 through the first seven games of the season. They are tied with the Hudson Valley Renegades of the South Atlantic for third in the High-A classification. Only the Spokane Indians of the Northwest League (85) and Brooklyn Cyclones of the SAL (80) have more strikeouts this season, set a new single-game high as a pro for strikeouts with eight last night. He allowed three hits, but nothing after a two out single in the second inning as he retired the final ten batters, including seven of the last ten Bandits he faced. JOINING THE HIT PARADE: Luis Castillo snapped an 0-for-11 streak to start the season with a lead-off double

in the top of the second inning. IN FRONT: Jadher Areinamo doubled to start the Wisconsin fourth inning. Juan Baez drove in Areinamo when he singled on the tenth pitch of the next at bat.

THE LITTLE THINGS: Quad Cities tied the game against reliever Anthony Flores in the sixth when Carson Roccaforte drew a lead-off walk, stole second, stole third, and scored on an RBI single by Sam Kulasingam through the draw-in infield. Flores retired the first two batters in the bottom of the eighth, but Kulasingam kept the inning alive with a weak infield single. Then, Gonzalez doubled to the corner in left to drive in the go-ahead run.

ABOUT QUAD CITIES: The River Bandits are the Midwest League affiliate of the Kansas City Royals. The current version of Davenport Professional Baseball club started in 1960 as the Midwest League affiliate of the Milwaukee Braves. Quad Cities has affiliated with several MLB teams: The California Angels (1962-1978 and 1985-1992), the Chicago Cubs (1979-1984), the Houston Astros (1993-1998 and 2013-2019), the Minnesota Twins (1999-2004), and the St. Louis Cardinals (2005-2012). The team became the Quad City River Bandits in 1992. They changed their name to the Swing of the Quad Cities from 2004 through 2007 before changing to Quad Cities River Bandits in 2008. Quad Cities won Midwest League pennants in 1968, 1971, 1979, 1990, 2011, 2013, and 2017. They were the High-A Central League champions in 2021. Notable alumni of Quad Cities: Carlos Correa, Joe Mauer, Josh Hader, Billy Wagner, Shawon Dunston, Justin Morneau, and Brett Phillips.

ABOUT THE ROYALS: The Kansas City Royals have been Quad Cities' parent club since 2021. They left the Midwest league and an affiliation with Kane County at the end of the 2012 season. The Royals had previously been in the Midwest League with Waterloo (1969-1976), Appleton (1987-1992), Rockford (1993-94), Springfield (1995), Lansing (1996-1998), Burlington (2001-2010), and Kane County (2011-2012).

## PITCHING MATCHUP

#### WISCONSIN STARTING PITCHER:

RHP CHANDLER WELCH: The Milwaukee Brewers selected Welch in the sixth round of the 2024 draft out of Tulane University.

**CATCH A GREEN WAVE:** Welch pitched three seasons at Tulane. He was 15-13 with three saves and a 5.42 ERA in 67 games – 29 starts in college. Welch had 204 strikeouts over 199-1/3 innings with Tulane. As a junior – his final season of college baseball, Welch was 7-4 with a 4.65 ERA. In his final collegiate start, Welch was the starting pitcher for Tulane against Oregon State in the NCAA Regional at Corvallis on May 31, 2024. He allowed six runs on seven hits with two walks and a strikeout over four innings against the Beavers.

**CHAMPIONS:** Tulane won the AAC Conference Tournament in Welch's sophomore and junior seasons.

**LET'S GET IT STARTED:** Milwaukee assigned Welch to Carolina on September 8, 2024 and he made his pro debut for the Mudcats against Delmarva. He was transferred to Wisconsin and made a relief appearance in the playoffs against Lake County.

**LAST START:** Welch had a no decision against Cedar Rapids at home on April 6. He allowed four runs on seven hits with a walk and a strikeout over three innings.

VS. QUAD CITIES: Welch has never faced the River Bandits prior to this evening. Tonight is also the first time he will pitch against an affiliate of the Kansas City Royals.

#### **QUAD CITIES STARTING PITCHER:**

**LHP HUNTER PATTESON:** The Kansas City Royals selected Beam in the 5<sup>th</sup> round of the 2022 draft out of the University of Central Florida.

**NOPE:** The Chicago Cubs picked Patteson in the 35<sup>th</sup> round of the 2019 draft. He elected to go to Central Florida.

**SIR HUNTER:** In three seasons at UCF, Patteson was 6-3 with a save and 4.32 ERA. He had 118 strikeouts over 100 innings pitched in college. Patteson also pitched for Peninsula in the Coastal Plain League in 2020 and Brewster in the Cape Cod League in 2021.

**LAST SEASON:** Patteson started 2024 with Columbia, the Carolina League affiliate of the Royals and was 3-4 with a save and a 3.27 ERA in eleven games – ten starts – before a promotion to Quad Cities on June 10. He was 3-4 with a 5.75 ERA in thirteen games – five starts with the River Bandits. Patteson walked nineteen and struck out 91 in 91 innings over both stops in the Kansas City system last year.

**LAST START:** Patteson had a no decision at Peoria on April 6. He allowed two unearned runs on three hits with five walks and three strikeouts over 4-2/3 innings.

**VS. WISCONSIN:** Patteson made two relief appearances – <u>August 10</u> and <u>August 31</u> – against the Timber Rattlers in 2024. He was 2-0 and allowed four hits with five strikeouts over six scoreless innings without allowing a walk in those two games against Wisconsin.
