ABOUT LAST NIGHT: [The Beloit Sky Carp beat the Wisconsin Timber Rattlers 5-0 at ABC Supply Stadium.](#)

Karson Milbrandt struck out ten, walked one, and allowed one hit over five scoreless innings as the starting pitcher for the Sky Carp to earn the win. Travis Smith, the Wisconsin starter, allowed a run on four hits with a walk and three strikeouts in 5-1/3 innings. Aiva Arquette went 2-for-4 with a run scored, a stolen base, and a two-RBI double. Wisconsin has held to three hits in the game and struck out a total of sixteen times.

NOT OK: Milbrandt struck out six consecutive Rattlers as he retired the side in order in the second and third innings. Luis Peña had a two-out single in the first inning for Wisconsin. Milbrandt retired the next ten batters before walking Marco Dinges in the fifth inning. Peña was the only Rattler in the lineup to not strikeout.

ZERO: The Timber Rattler was shutout for the sixth time this season with last night's loss. They have been shutout three times this month.

ERROR-FREE: Wisconsin was not charged with an error last night. That snapped a streak of nine consecutive games in which the defense committed an error. The last errorless game by the Rattlers before last night was on August 6 at Peoria.

DOUBLE PLAYS: Wisconsin turned two double plays last night. The Rattlers have 109 double plays this season and lead the Midwest League. The Everett AquaSox of the Northwest League have 112 double plays and are the only team in High-A with more twin killings than the Rattlers.

INTO THE FIRE: Josh Adamczewski, the Milwaukee Brewers #13 prospect, made his Midwest League debut last night for the Timber Rattlers as the designated hitter in the cleanup spot. Adamczewski went 0-for-4 with two strikeouts.

END OF THE LINE: Jesús Made's hitting streak ended at nine games as he was 0-for-4 with a strikeout last night.

ABOUT BELOIT: The Beloit Sky Carp changed their name from Snappers after the 2021 season. This is Beloit's fourth season as an affiliate of the Miami Marlins. Beloit started as the Beloit Brewers in 1982 as the Midwest League affiliate of Milwaukee. They changed their name to the Beloit Snappers for the 1995 season. The Snappers affiliation with Milwaukee ended after the 2004 season. They were affiliated with the Minnesota Twins (2005-2012) and the Oakland Athletics (2013-2019) over their final seasons in the Midwest League. The Snappers said "Goodbye" to Pohlman Field on July 11, 2021 and moved into ABC Supply Stadium on August 3, 2021. Angel Espada is in his first season as the manager of the Sky Carp. Bill Hall, Prince Fielder, Rickie Weeks, Chris Bosio, Greg Vaughn, Joey Meyer, BJ Surhoff, Tim Dillard, Mitch Stetter, and Matt Chapman played in Beloit.

ABOUT THE MARLINS: The Florida/Miami Marlins have lots of history in the Midwest League. The Marlins' first Low-A affiliate was the Kane County Cougars from 1993 through 2002. Josh Beckett, Adrian Gonzalez, Dontrelle Willis, Miguel Cabrera, and former Timber Rattlers manager Matt Erickson all played for the Cougars in that timespan. The Marlins returned to the Midwest League in 2019 to affiliate with the Clinton LumberKings. The Marlins landed in Beloit after MLB reset the affiliations for 2021.

WISCONSIN STARTING PITCHER:

RHP MANUEL RODRIGUEZ: The Milwaukee Brewers signed Rodriguez as an International Free Agent out of Mexico on April 5, 2022.

WHIRLWIND: Rodriguez had a very busy 2022. After signing with Milwaukee in April, he began his professional career in the Dominican Summer League in June and went 1-5 with a 4.54 ERA in twelve games – five starts. Later in the year he pitched for Mexico in the U-18 World Cup of Baseball. Rodriguez went 1-1 in the tournament with a win over Australia and a loss to the Netherlands.

PLAYOFF EXPERIENCE: Rodriguez has pitched in the postseason in each of the last two seasons. He made a relief appearance for the ACL Brewers in the Arizona Complex League Semifinal Game in 2023 and was the starter in Game Two of the Carolina League Playoffs for the Mudcats against Fredericksburg.

CHECK THE RATING: MLB Pipeline moved Rodriguez into their Top 30 list of Brewers Prospects at #30 after Yophery Rodriguez was traded to Boston on April 7, 2025 and up to #29 when Isaac Collins graduated from the list on April 19, 2025. In the July 25, 2025 update, Rodriguez was back at #30, but he dropped off the Top 30 after the most recent update. *Baseball America* listed Rodriguez as the #25 prospect in the Milwaukee System in their 2025 *Prospect Handbook*.

LAST START: Rodriguez lost to Great Lakes at home on [August 13](#). He allowed six runs on seven hits – including two home runs – with a walk and four strikeouts over four innings.

VS. BELOIT: Rodriguez has no record in two starts – [July 1](#) at ABC Supply Stadium and [July 6](#) at Neuroscience Group Field – against the Sky Carp this season. He has allowed a run on four hits with a walk and four strikeouts over five innings.

BELOIT STARTING PITCHER:

RHP NOBLE MEYER: The Miami Marlins selected Meyer in the first round of the 2023 draft out of Jesuit High School in Portland, Oregon. Meyer was picked with the tenth overall selection.

ON THE CHARTS: Meyer is rated as the #10 prospect in the Miami Organization by MLB Pipeline. *Baseball America* places Meyer as the #9 prospect in the Marlins system.

BACK TO THE FUTURE: Noble Meyer represented the Marlins on the National League team in the 2024 Futures Game at Globe Life Field in Arlington, Texas on [July 13](#). Meyer was the winning pitcher after pitching a scoreless, hitless second inning with a walk and two strikeouts.

HOW WE GOT HERE: Meyer made his pro debut in 2025 with five brief starts between the Florida Complex League and the Jupiter Hammerheads of the Florida State League. He was 0-1 with a 4.09 ERA and fifteen strikeouts over eleven innings pitched as a pro in 2023. Meyer started the 2024 season with Jupiter where he was 2-2 with a 2.68 ERA and 43 strikeouts over 34 innings pitched in eight starts before his promotion to Beloit on May 28. As a member of the Sky Carp last season, Meyer was 0-5 with a 5.18 ERA in eleven games – ten starts. He walked 32 and struck out 42 in 40 innings.

LAST START: Meyer lost to South Bend at home on [August 13](#). He allowed two runs on three hits with five walks and two strikeouts over three innings.

VS. WISCONSIN: Meyer had a no decision against the Rattlers at Neuroscience Group Field on [May 14, 2025](#). He allowed a run on a hit and three walks with two strikeouts over two innings. Meyer was 0-1 in two starts against the Rattlers in 2024 as he allowed three runs on three hits with eight walks and nine strikeouts over 8-1/3 innings.
