ABOUT LAST NIGHT: [The Peoria Chiefs beat the Wisconsin Timber Rattlers 3-2 at Dozer Park.](#)

Wisconsin had a 2-1 lead heading into the bottom of the eighth inning. Moises Castillo hit a home run with one out to tie the game and Chandler Redmon hit a home run with two outs to put the Chiefs up 3-2. Wisconsin had the tying run at second with one out in the top of the ninth, but a pair of strikeouts ended the game.

THE PITCHING FILE: Dylan File was added to the Wisconsin roster on a rehab assignment and made the start last night. File allowed a run on two hits and two walks with three strikeouts over 2-1/3 innings pitched.

THE GRAY COMPANY: Joe Gray Jr. tied the game 1-1 when he hit his first Timber Rattlers home run. The solo shot happened in the top of the top of the fifth. Gray also walked twice and stole a base in the game.

SECOND WARD: Je'Von Ward had two hits and an RBI last night. He drove in the go-ahead run with his single in the top of the sixth. Ward's multi-hit game last night was his twelfth of the season.

ODYSSEY OF HOMERS: In 23 games between Wisconsin and Peoria this season, the teams have combined for 55 home runs. The Chiefs have hit 32 and the Rattlers have hit 23. Peoria has homered in ten straight games in the series and in nine straight games against Wisconsin at Dozer Park.

DOWN TO THE WIRE: Eight of the 23 games between Wisconsin and Peoria have been decided by one run. The Rattlers are 2-6 in one-run games against the Chiefs. Last night was also seventh time Peoria has beat Wisconsin in their final at bat of the game.

THAT'S JUST WEIRD: Connor Lunn was the starting pitcher for the Chiefs last night. In four starts against Wisconsin this season he is 1-0 with three no decisions. In each of his no decisions against the Rattlers, he left on the hook for the loss. In all three of his no decisions, the Chiefs rallied to win in their last at bat.

ABOUT PEORIA: The Peoria Chiefs were in the Three-I League from 1953-1957 before the team folded. They were a St. Louis Cardinals affiliate from 1953-1956 and a New York Yankees affiliate in 1958. The Chiefs re-entered organized baseball when the Danville franchise moved after the 1982 season. They were named the Peoria Suns and were affiliated with the California Angels in 1983.

They changed their name to the Chiefs and their affiliation to the Chicago Cubs for the 1984 season. They became a Cardinals affiliate for the first time in 1995, switched back to the Cubs in 2005, and went back to the Cardinals in 2013. The Chiefs won a Midwest League title in 2002.

Chris Swauger is back as the manager of the Chiefs this year. Swauger managed the Chiefs in 2017 and 2018 when Peoria was in the Midwest League. The Chiefs made the Midwest League Championship Series but lost to Bowling Green in the Finals under Swauger in 2018. Notable former Chiefs include Greg Maddux, Mark Grace, Albert Pujols, and Yadier Molina.

ABOUT THE CARDINALS: St. Louis had several different Midwest League affiliates before settling in Peoria in 2013. They were in Cedar Rapids from 1965-1972 before leaving the league until returning to Springfield from 1982 through 1993. St. Louis spent one year with the Madison Hatters before their first time with Peoria. The Cardinals left Peoria for Quad Cities from 2005 through 2012.

PROSPECTING IN THE SERIES: [MLB Pipeline](#) puts six Rattlers on their list of Brewers Top 30 Prospects: Carlos Rodríguez (#14), Hayden Cantrelle (#16), Nick Kahle (#20), Thomas Dillard (#22), Dylan File (#26), and David Hamilton (#27). [MLB Pipeline](#) has two current Chiefs on their list of St. Louis prospects: Jordan Walker (#6) and Jhon Torres (#7). Ian Bedell (#11) is on the Peoria IL.

WISCONSIN STARTING PITCHER:

RHP VICTOR CASTAÑEDA: The Brewers signed Castañeda as a Minor League Free Agent off the reserve list of Toros de Tijuana from the Mexican League on July 4, 2017.

TORO! TORO! Castañeda was 3-1 with a 3.00 ERA over nine games – four starts – for Tijuana in 2017 as an 18-year-old.

FROM MEXICO TO MONTANA: Castañeda was 2-6 with a 5.13 ERA in fourteen games – eight starts for Helena in the Pioneer League in 2018. He walked fifteen and struck out 40 in 47-1/3 innings pitched last season.

WELCOME TO WISCONSIN: Castañeda was assigned to the Rattlers on May 20, 2019. He was 4-2 with six saves in 32 appearance – one start – with Wisconsin. Castañeda walked 14 and struck out 53 in 44 innings pitched during the 2019 season with the Rattlers.

THE SEASON WAS NOT OVER: Castañeda was assigned to the Glendale Desert Dogs for the 2019 Arizona Fall League by the Brewers at the end of the Wisconsin season. He was 3-1 with a 1.99 ERA, six walks, and 29 strikeouts over 22-2/3 innings pitched in six games – five starts – for the Desert Dogs. Castañeda was named the AFL Pitcher of the Week on September 25, 2019.

AWARD WINNING: Castañeda was named the High-A Central League Pitcher of the Week on May 31 for his performance [at Cedar Rapids on May 28](#). He allowed two hits, walked one, and struck out eight over 6-2/3 scoreless innings in the game.

LAST START: Castañeda [beat the Chiefs on July 13](#) at Dozer Park. He allowed one run on four hits over five innings. Castañeda struck out nine to set a new single-game high as a professional.

VS. PEORIA (2021): Castañeda is 1-1 in four starts against the Chiefs this season. He has allowed ten runs on fourteen hits with eleven walks and fifteen strikeouts over fourteen innings against Peoria in 2021.

PEORIA STARTING PITCHER:

RHP WILFREDO PEREIRA: The Cardinals signed Pereira as an International Free Agent out of Panama on March 19, 2016.

TWO SEASONS IN THE DOMINICAN: Pereira spent 2016 and 2017 in the Dominican Summer League. He was 2-1 with a 2.27 ERA in eighteen relief appearances in 2016. Pereira was 1-7 with a 3.16 ERA in twelve games – ten starts – during the 2017 season

TWO STOPS: Pereira appeared in both the Dominican Summer League and the Gulf Coast League in 2018. He combined to go 3-4 with a 4.73 ERA in thirteen appearances – nine starts.

2019: Pereira split time between the Appalachian League and the Midwest League in 2019. He was 3-1 with two saves and a 2.44 ERA in those two stops. Pereira had 49 strikeouts and 13 walks in 51-2/3 innings between Johnson City and Peoria in 2019.

IN THE BEFORE TIMES: Pereira made sixteen relief appearances this season prior to a start at Cedar Rapids on July 7. He had only made one start in eighteen appearances between Johnson City and Peoria in 2019.

LAST START: Pereira lost to the Timber Rattlers at [Dozer Park on July 13](#). He allowed three runs – two earned – on four hits, with a walk, and six strikeouts over five innings.

VS. WISCONSIN (2021): Pereira is 1-4 in six appearances – one start – against the Timber Rattlers this season. He has allowed fourteen runs on fifteen hits with nine walks and seventeen strikeouts in 17-1/3 innings pitched against Wisconsin in 2021.
