ABOUT LAST NIGHT: [The Peoria Chiefs beat the Wisconsin Timber Rattlers 7-5 at Dozer Park](#). Peoria scored five runs in the first inning and added two more runs in the second to take a 7-0 lead. Wisconsin rallied on a two-run homer by Jesús Chirinos in the sixth and a three-run homer by Je'Von Ward in the eighth. The comeback fell short, and the Rattlers lost for the eighth time in the last nine games to drop to a season low seven games under .500.

DOWN EARLY: The opponents have scored first in each of the last nine Wisconsin games. Opponents have scored in the first inning in four of the last nine games.

SLOW START: Nathan Church hit a lead-off homer in the first inning for the Chiefs. Peoria had two on with two outs with a 1-0 lead before expanding their advantage on a two-run double by Osvaldo Tovalin and a two-run home run by Tyler Reichenborn.

THIS GUY: Tovalin also added a two-out, RBI single in the second inning to give Peoria a 7-0 lead. Tovalin is 12-for-32 (.375) with four doubles, a triple, a homer eight RBI and eight runs scored in nine games against Wisconsin this season.

GOING DEEP THOUGHTS: Ward's home run last night was his first since August 12, 2021. He had missed the final four weeks of that season and the entire 2022 season before returning to action in 2023. The home run by Chirinos was his second of the season. He has hit both homers against the Chiefs. Wisconsin has seventeen home runs as a team and eleven of those homers are in nine games against Peoria.

WELCOME BACK: Eric Brown Jr reached base three times on Thursday with a single, a double, and a walk. Brown is 3-for-8 in the two games since he returned to the lineup since he was hit in the face by a pitch against Beloit on April 26. In his last four games, Brown has been on base ten times in his last fifteen plate appearances.

ABOUT PEORIA: The Peoria Chiefs were in the Three-I League from 1953-1958 before the team folded. They were a St. Louis Cardinals affiliate from 1953-1957 and a New York Yankees affiliate in 1958. The Chiefs re-entered organized baseball when the Danville franchise moved to Peoria after the 1982 season. They were named the Peoria Suns and were affiliated with the California Angels for 1983 and 1984 with a change to the Chiefs nickname for 1984 followed by an affiliation switch to the Chicago Cubs for the 1985 season. Peoria became the Cardinals Midwest League affiliate for the first time in 1995, switched back to the Cubs in 2005, and went back to the Cardinals in 2013. The Chiefs won a Midwest League title in 2002. They made the Midwest League Championship Series in 2018 but lost to Bowling Green. Patrick Anderson is in his second year as Peoria's manager. Notable former Chiefs include Greg Maddux, Mark Grace, Albert Pujols, and Yadier Molina.

ABOUT THE CARDINALS: St. Louis had several different Midwest League affiliates before settling back in Peoria in 2013. They were in Cedar Rapids from 1965-1972 before leaving the league until returning to the league to affiliate with the Springfield, Illinois team from 1982 through 1993. St. Louis spent one year with the Madison Hatters before their first affiliation with Peoria from 1995 through 2004. The Cardinals left Peoria for Quad Cities from 2005 through 2012.

[MLB Pipeline](#) has five active Peoria players on their list of Cardinals prospects: Cooper Hjerpe (#6), Jimmy Crooks (#15), Ian Bedell (#24), Dionys Rodriguez (#26), Victor Scott II (#27), and Zane Mills (#30). Tink Hence (#3), Austin Love (#19), and Inohan Paniagua (#17) are on Peoria's IL.

WISCONSIN SCHEDULED STARTING PITCHER:

RHP TYLER WOESSNER: Drafted by the Milwaukee Brewers in the sixth round of the 2022 draft out of Central Arizona College.

WHAT A SEASON: Woessner went 11-2 with a 3.55 ERA in nineteen games – eighteen starts – during his final season at CAC. He walked 34 and struck out 122 in 96-1/3 innings pitched for the Vaqueros.

PITCHING INTO THE FINALS: Central Arizona College advanced to the 2022 NJCAA College World Series in Grand Junction, Colorado. Woessner was the winning pitcher in the game that got CAC into the Championship game as he allowed three runs and struck out eight over seven innings in the Vaqueros' 7-4 win over Walters State Community College on [June 3, 2022](#). Central Arizona College won the National Title the next day with a 4-2 win over Cowley County Community College.

NORTH TO ALASKA: Woessner pitched in three games – one start – for the Mat-Su Miners of the Alaska Baseball League in 2021. He had no record, walked three, and struck out four over seven innings.

FIRST YEAR AS A BREWER: Woessner started his pro career with the Brewers Gold affiliate in the Arizona Complex League and made three appearances – two starts – with eleven strikeouts over six scoreless innings. Woessner also made one start for the Carolina Mudcats at the end of the 2022 Carolina League season.

LAST START: Woessner [lost to Beloit at home on April 28](#). He allowed three runs on eight hits over six innings. Woessner walked two and struck out three in the game. All three runs he allowed in the game came in the third inning with two of the runs coming after two outs. The Rattlers offense was shut out on two hits in the game.

VS. PEORIA: Woessner is 2-0 against the Chiefs this season with wins at home on [April 11](#) and [April 16](#). He allowed four runs – two earned – on seven hits with three walks and thirteen strikeouts over ten innings in the two starts against the Chiefs during Wisconsin's first homestand.

PEORIA SCHEDULED STARTING PITCHER:

RHP ZANE MILLS: The St. Louis Cardinals drafted Mills out of Washington State University with their fourth-round selection in the 2021 draft.

LET'S GO COUGARS: Mills went 5-5 with a 4.15 ERA and 83 strikeouts in 80-1/3 innings pitched in thirteen starts in his final season at Washington State. He was named Pac-12 Pitcher of the Week twice in 2021.

IT'S COMPLEX: Mills made seven relief appearances for the Florida Complex League affiliate of the Cardinals after signing his professional contract. Mills allowed a run on four hits with no walks, two hit batsmen, and nine strikeouts over 7-2/3 innings pitched.

PALM READER: Mills started 2022 with the Palm Beach Cardinals in the Florida State League. He was 1-2 with a 3.48 ERA in seven starts with seven walks and 35 strikeouts over 41-1/3 innings before his promotion to Peoria on May 23. Mills was 4-6 with a 4.03 ERA in nineteen starts for the Chiefs after his promotion.

LAST START: Mills [lost at South Bend on April 29](#). He allowed four runs on six hits with two walks and three strikeouts in three innings.

VS. WISCONSIN: Mills was 0-2 in three starts – [May 31](#), [June 5](#), and [September 3](#) – against the Timber Rattlers last season. He allowed seven runs – six earned – on twelve hits with three walks and fifteen strikeouts over 14-2/3 innings pitched against Wisconsin last season. Mills had a no decision at Wisconsin on [April 12, 2023](#). He gave up four runs on six hits with two walks and four strikeouts over five innings.
