ABOUT LAST NIGHT: The Wisconsin Timber Rattlers beat the Peoria Chiefs 5-4 at Dozer Park. Eduarqui Fernández, went 3-for-4 with a run scored, two doubles, and three RBI for the Timber Rattlers. Terence Doston broke a 4-4 tie with a two-out, RBI single in the top of the sixth.

BACK AND FORTH AFFAIR: The Chiefs scored a run in the bottom of the first for a 1-0 lead. Fernández put the Rattlers up 3-1 with a three-run double in the top of the third. Peoria rallied with a run in the third and two runs in the fifth to take a 4-3 lead. Jheremy Vargas tied the game in the top of the sixth with an RBI grounder to set the stage for Doston to put the Rattlers in front.

YEOMAN'S WORK: Reliever Brian Fitzpatrick took over in the bottom of the sixth inning and retired the first six batters he faced. The Chiefs had two infield singles in the eighth inning, but Fitzpatrick got out of the inning with the lead. In the ninth, Fitzpatrick retired the first two batters he faced before giving up an infield single to Won-Bin Cho and turning the game over to Will Childers.

FIRST! Childers earned his first professional save when Cho was thrown out trying to steal second base by Wisconsin catcher Ramón Rodríguez to end the game. Childers is 1-0 with a save in 1-1/3 innings on just fourteen pitches during this series at Peoria

BETTER MAKE IT FIVE: Fernández and Luis Lara both moved their current hitting streaks for five games last night. Fernández is 10-for-18 and Lara is 6-for-20 during the streak.

ABOUT PEORIA: The Peoria Chiefs were in the Three-I League from 1953-1958 before the team folded. They were a St. Louis Cardinals affiliate from 1953-1957 and a New York Yankees affiliate in 1958. The Chiefs re-entered organized baseball when the Danville franchise moved to Peoria after the 1982 season. They were named the Peoria Suns and were affiliated with the California Angels for 1983 and 1984 with a change to the Chiefs nickname for 1984 followed by an affiliation switch to the Chicago Cubs for the 1985 season. Peoria became the Cardinals Midwest League affiliate for the first time in 1995, switched back to the Cubs in 2005, and went back to the Cardinals in 2013. The Chiefs won a Midwest League title in 2002. They made the Midwest League Championship Series in 2018 but lost to Bowling Green. Patrick Anderson is in his third year as Peoria's manager. Notable former Chiefs include Greg Maddux, Mark Grace, Albert Pujols, Yadier Molina, Nolan Gorman, and Victor Scott II.

ABOUT THE CARDINALS: St. Louis had several different Midwest League affiliates before settling back in Peoria in 2013. They were in Cedar Rapids from 1965-1972 before leaving the league until returning to the league to affiliate with the Springfield, Illinois team from 1982 through 1993. St. Louis spent one year with the Madison Hatters before their first affiliation with Peoria from 1995 through 2004. The Cardinals left Peoria for Quad Cities from 2005 through 2012.

PROSPECTING IN THE SERIES: MLB Pipeline places five active Rattlers on their list of Brewers Top 30 Prospects: Luis Lara (#8), Luke Adams (#15), Dylan O'Rae (#20), Jadher Areinamo (#22), and Patricio Aquino (#28). MLB Pipeline has nine active Peoria players on their list of Top 30 Cardinals prospects: Cooper Hjerpe (#6), Leonardo Bernal (#7), Won-Bin Cho (#9), Brycen Mautz (#20), Zach Levenson (#22), Pete Hansen (#26), Joshua Baez (#29), and William Sullivan (#30).

THE CHIEFS SO FAR: Peoria is 7-13 to start the season. The Chiefs avoided a six-game sweep at Quad Cities with a win on Sunday afternoon over the River Bandits at Modern Woodmen Park. The Chiefs begin a twelve-game road trip on Tuesday with a six-game series at Cedar Rapids followed by a six-game series at Beloit.

PITCHING MATCHUP

WISCONSIN STARTING PITCHER:

RHP EDWIN JIMENEZ: Milwaukee signed Jimenez as an International Free Agent out of Venezuela on October 11, 2018.

HEADING TO THE CO-OP: Jimenez was assigned to the Dominican Summer League Co-op team shared between Milwaukee and Cleveland for the 2019 season. Jimenez was 1-5 with a 3.05 ERA in twelve games — eight starts. He walked 26 and struck out 32 over 41-1/3 innings in his first professional season.

FROM THE ISLAND TO THE DESERT: Jimenez started the 2021 season with Milwaukee's number two affiliate in the Dominican Summer League. He was assigned to the Brewers Blue affiliate in the Arizona Complex League on August 7, 2021. Jimenez went 1-1 with a 1.72 ERA in five games – four starts – in the DSL and 0-4 with a save and a 5.25 ERA in the ACL. He walked twelve and struck out 48 over 39-2/3 innings combined between his two stops in the system that season.

THE FULL-SEASON JOURNEY: Jimenez was 4-7 in 25 games – seventeen starts – with the Carolina Mudcats in 2022. He had a 4.75 ERA, walked 41, and struck out 104 over 113-2/3 innings pitched in the Carolina League last season. Jimenez started the 2023 season with Carolina and went 2-0 in four games – one start – with five walks and 23 strikeouts over eighteen innings before his promotion to Wisconsin on May 2. Once he was a Timber Rattler in 2023, Jimenez was 7-5 with a 4.50 ERA in 21 games – 15 starts – with 93 strikeouts over 102 innings pitched.

NEAR MISS: Jimenez was named the Midwest League Pitcher of the Week on July 31, 2023 after a taking a no-hitter into the eighth inning against Cedar Rapids on July 30. He earned the award by striking out ten Kernels over 7-1/3 scoreless innings at home. Jimenez walked three and didn't allow a hit until there was one out in the eighth inning.

LAST START: Jimenez earned the win against Cedar Rapids at home on April 21. He allowed two hits, walked one and struck out four over five scoreless innings.

VS. PEORIA (2024): Jimenez was the winning pitcher against the Chiefs at home on April 7. He allowed three runs on seven hits and three walks with four strikeouts over six innings. William Sullivan homered against Jimenez in that dame.

PEORIA SCHEDULED STARTING PITCHER:

RHP INOHAN PANIAGUA: The St. Louis Cardinals signed Paniagua as an International Free Agent out of the Dominican Republic on December 22, 2017.

STARTING IN THE SUMMER: Paniagua made fourteen starts and was 3-3 with a 3.77 ERA for the Cardinals Blue affiliate in the Dominican Summer League during 2018. He had 51 strikeouts in 57-1/3 innings pitched.

OFF TO STATE COLLEGE: In 2019, Paniagua started the season in the New York-Penn League with the State College Spikes where he made two starts before a transfer to the Gulf Coast League. Paniagua made thirteen appearances – eleven starts – in 2019. He was 2-5 with a 6.38 ERA and 47 strikeouts over 49-2/3 innings.

TO THE BEACH AND BACK: Paniagua was a member of the Palm Beach Cardinals in 2021 and started with them in 2022. Paniagua had 107 strikeouts over 99 innings pitched in 2022 before a promotion to Peoria on July 26 of that season. He started 2023 on the injured list, made three rehab starts in the FCL, and rejoined Peoria in early July. He would also pitch for Scottsdale in the Arizona Fall League during this past offseason.

PEORIA NUMBERS: Including this season, Paniagua is 3-6 with a 4.58 ERA in 21 starts for the Chiefs. He has 88 strikeouts over 92-1/3 innings pitched.

LAST START: Paniagua had a no decision in game one of this series with Wisconsin on April 23. He allowed an unearned run on no hits with a hit batsman, three walks, and three strikeouts over four innings.

VS. WISCONSIN: Prior to last Tuesday, Paniagua only other start against the Timber Rattlers was on September 1, 2022 at Dozer Park for a no decision. He allowed three runs on five hits with four walks and five strikeouts in four innings. Darrien Miller and Jeferson Quero both homered off Paniagua.
